

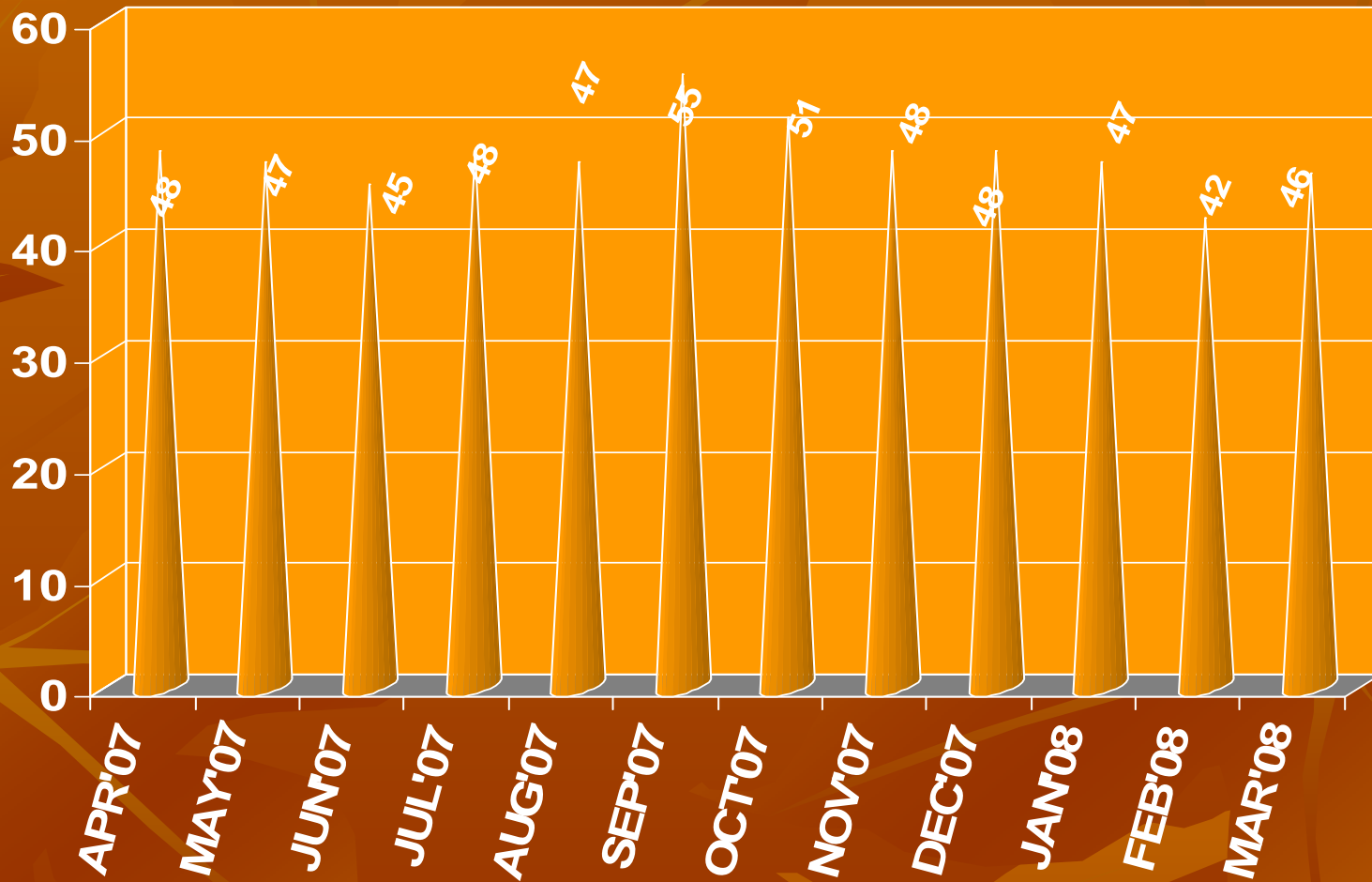

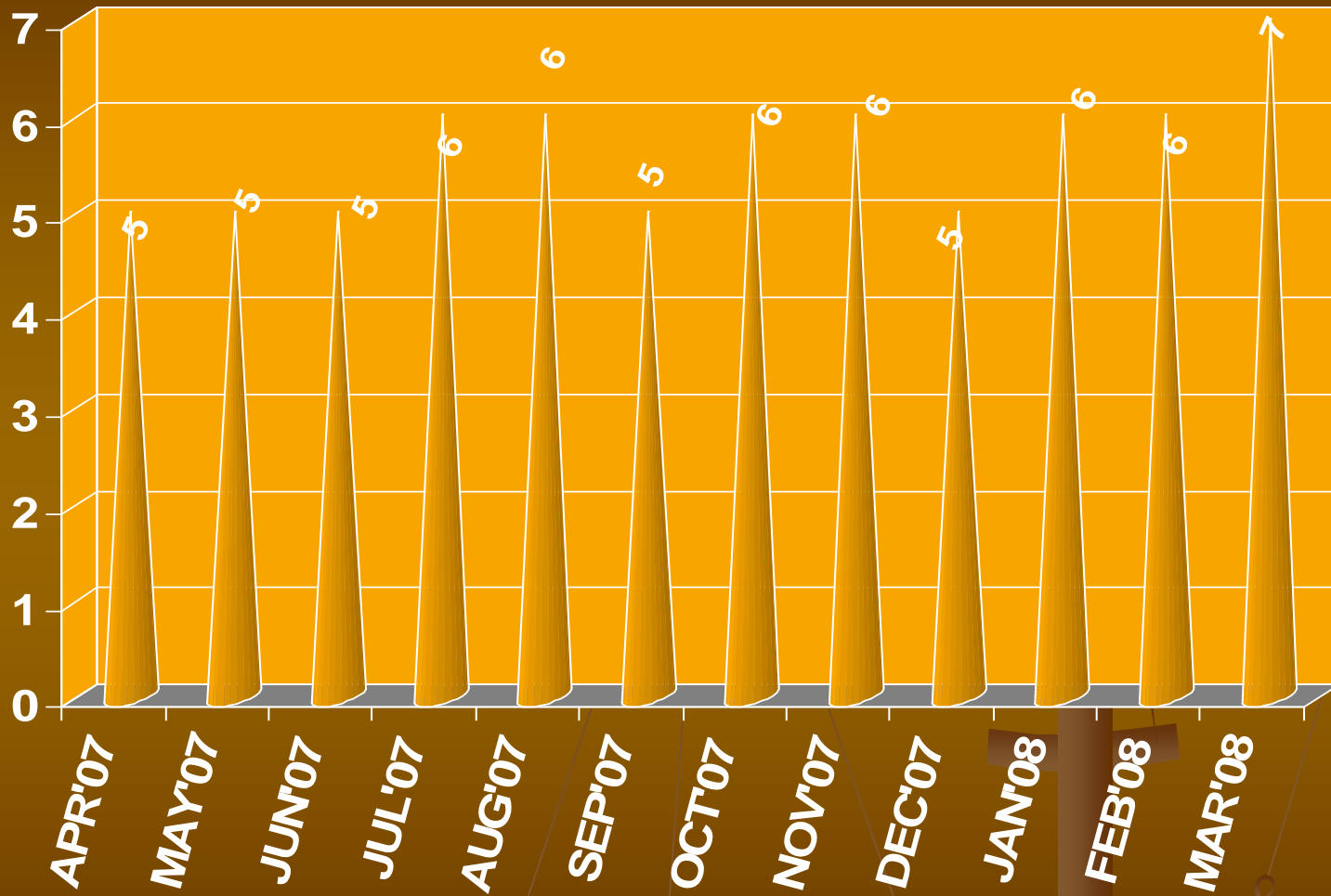

BED OCCUPANCY RATE (BOR)



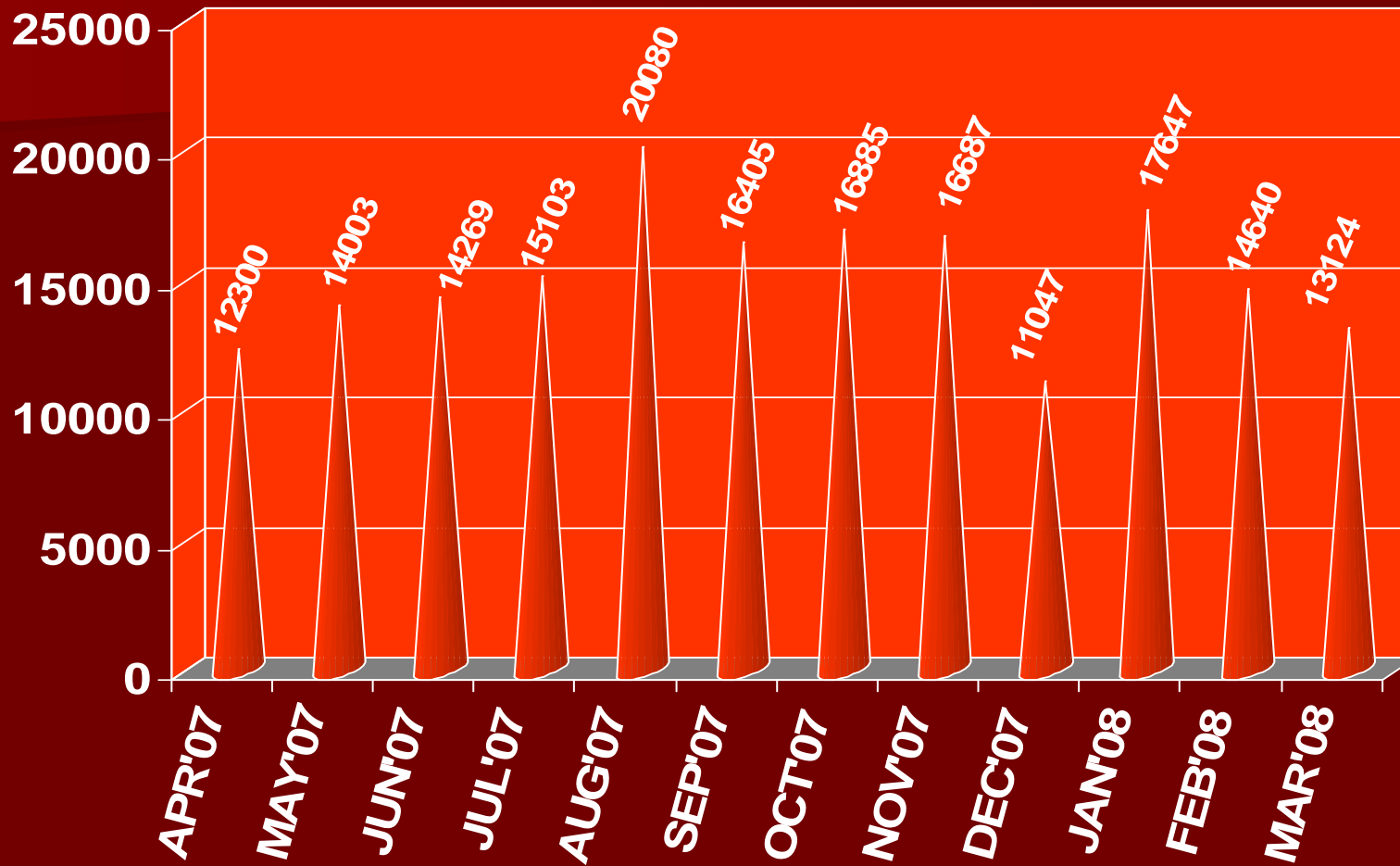
Bed occupancy rate is a ratio of actual patient days to the maximum patient days as determined by usable beds

AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY (ALOS)



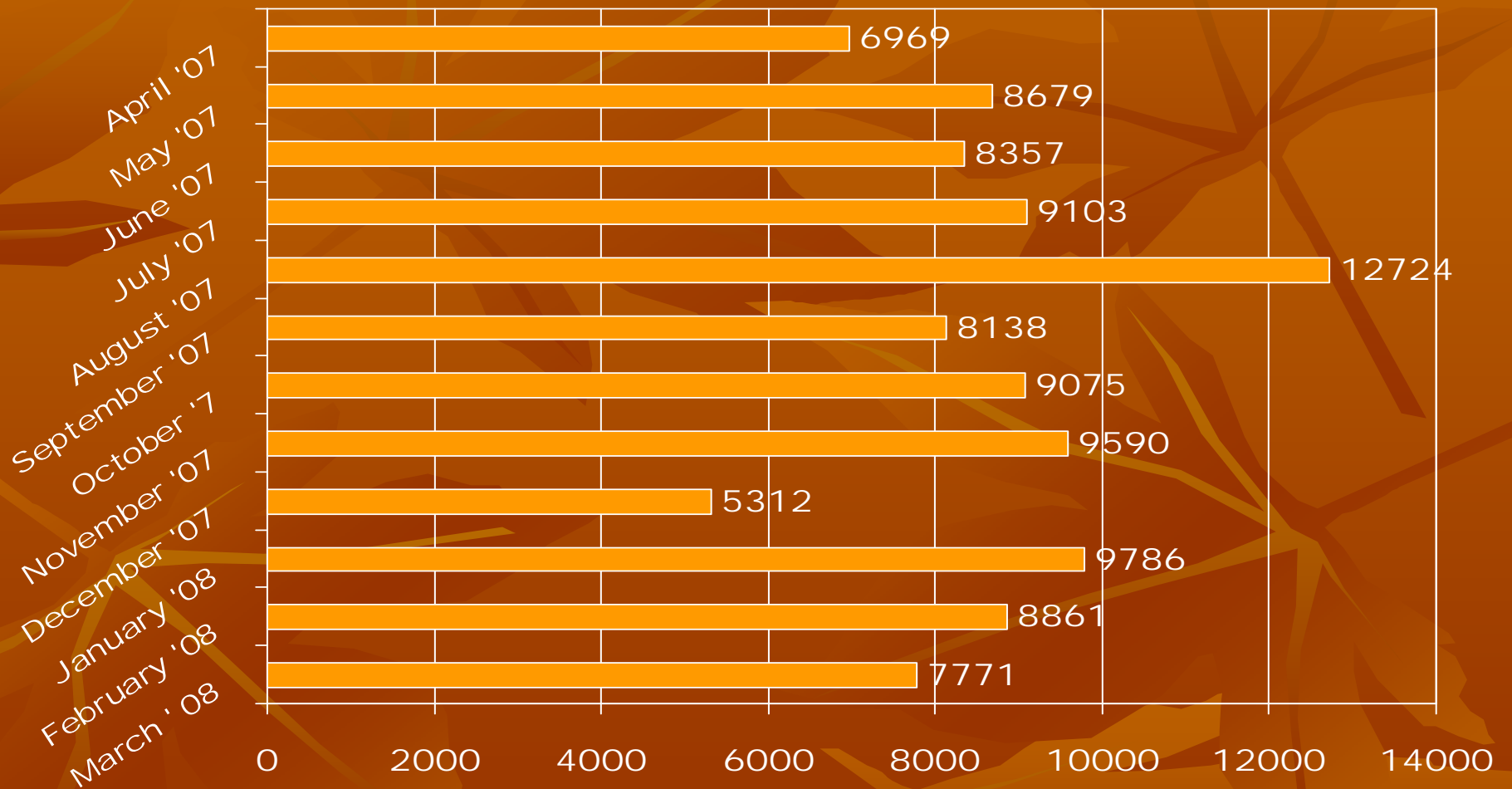
Average Length of Stay is the average number of days that admitted patient spends in the hospital before discharge or death.

TOTAL OPD HEADCOUNT



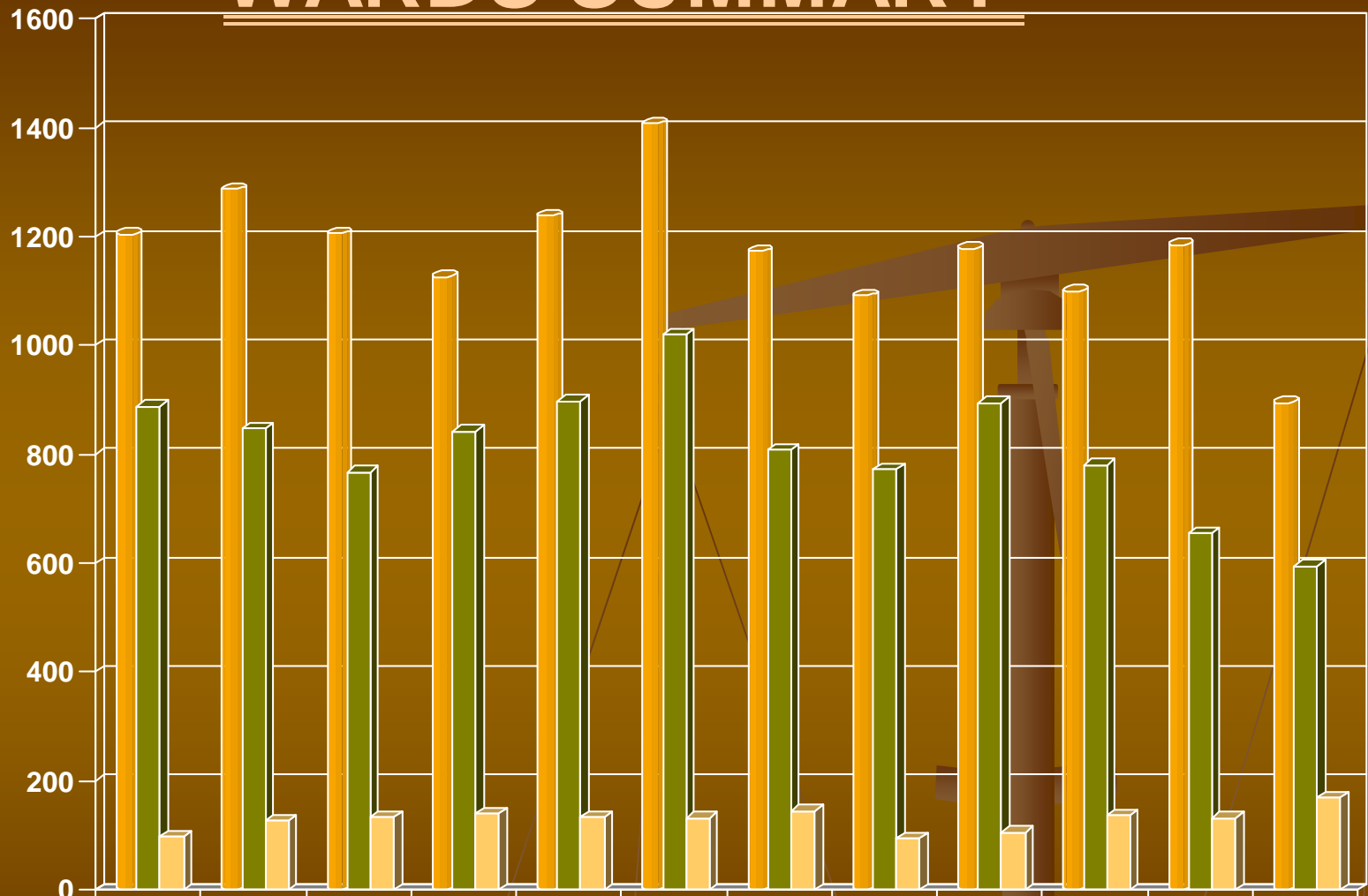
Is the total number of patients attending General OPD and Specialized outpatient clinic

Casualty Headcount



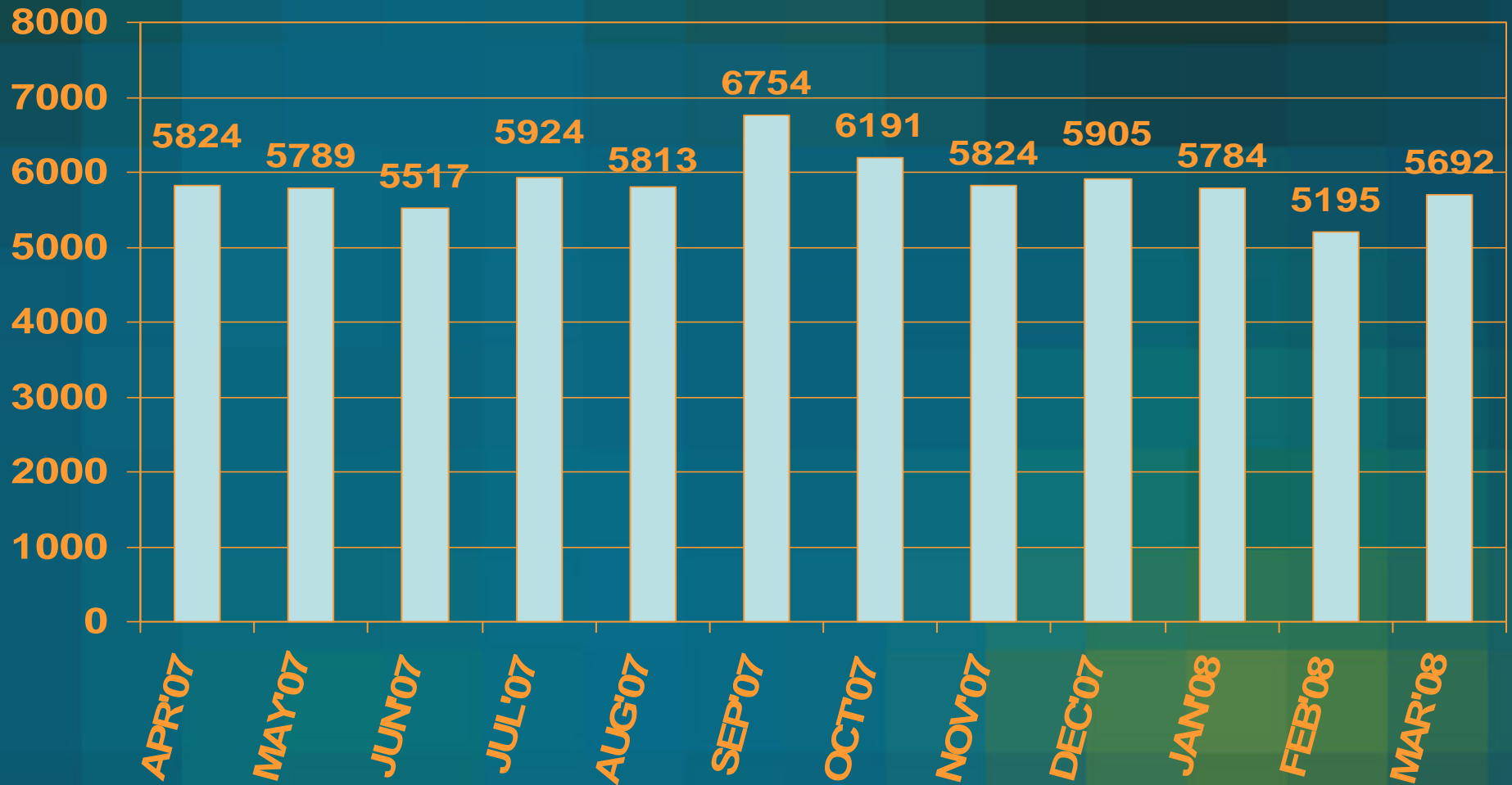
The number of patients attending casualty requiring emergency treatment during the reporting period

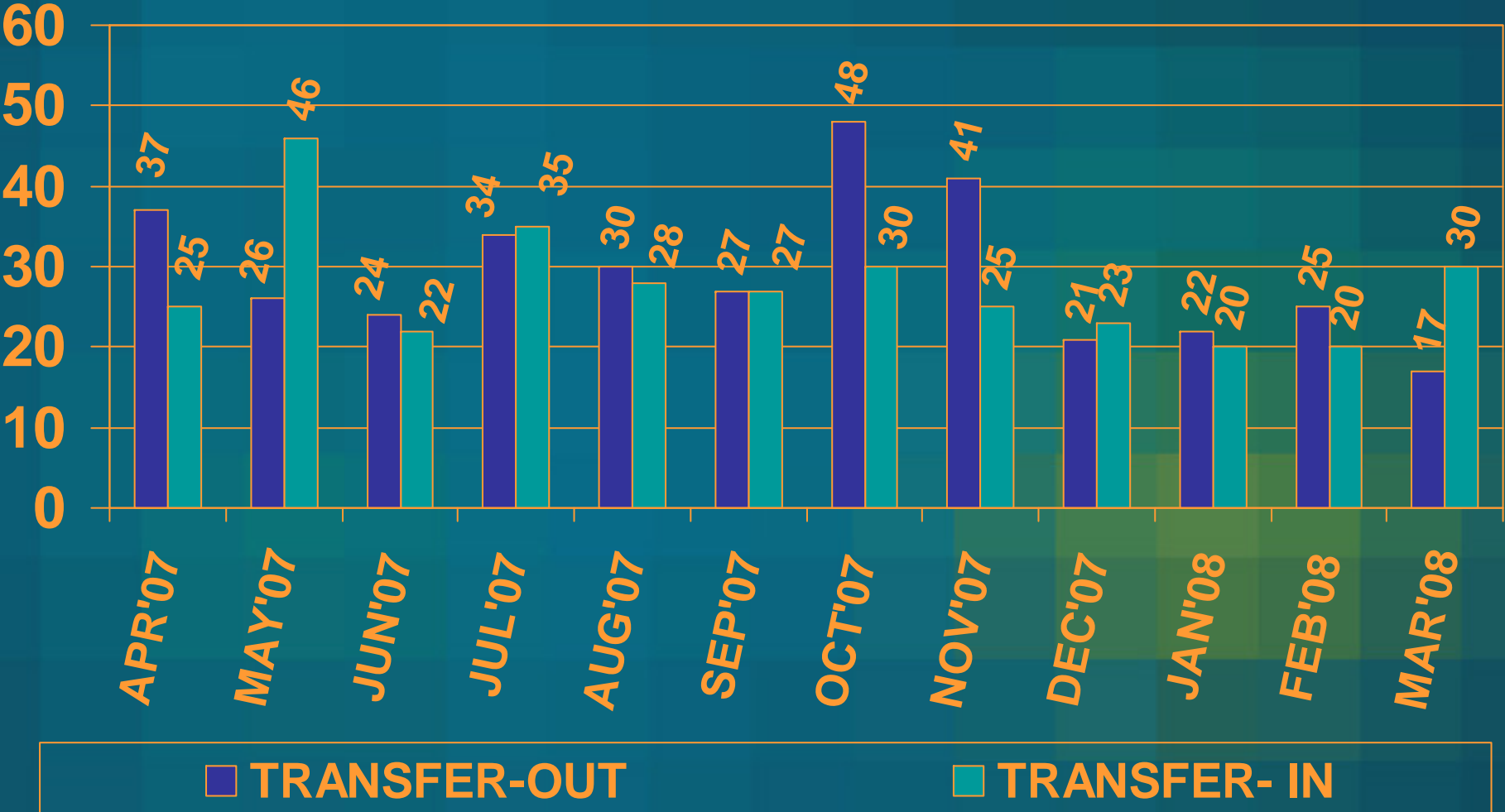

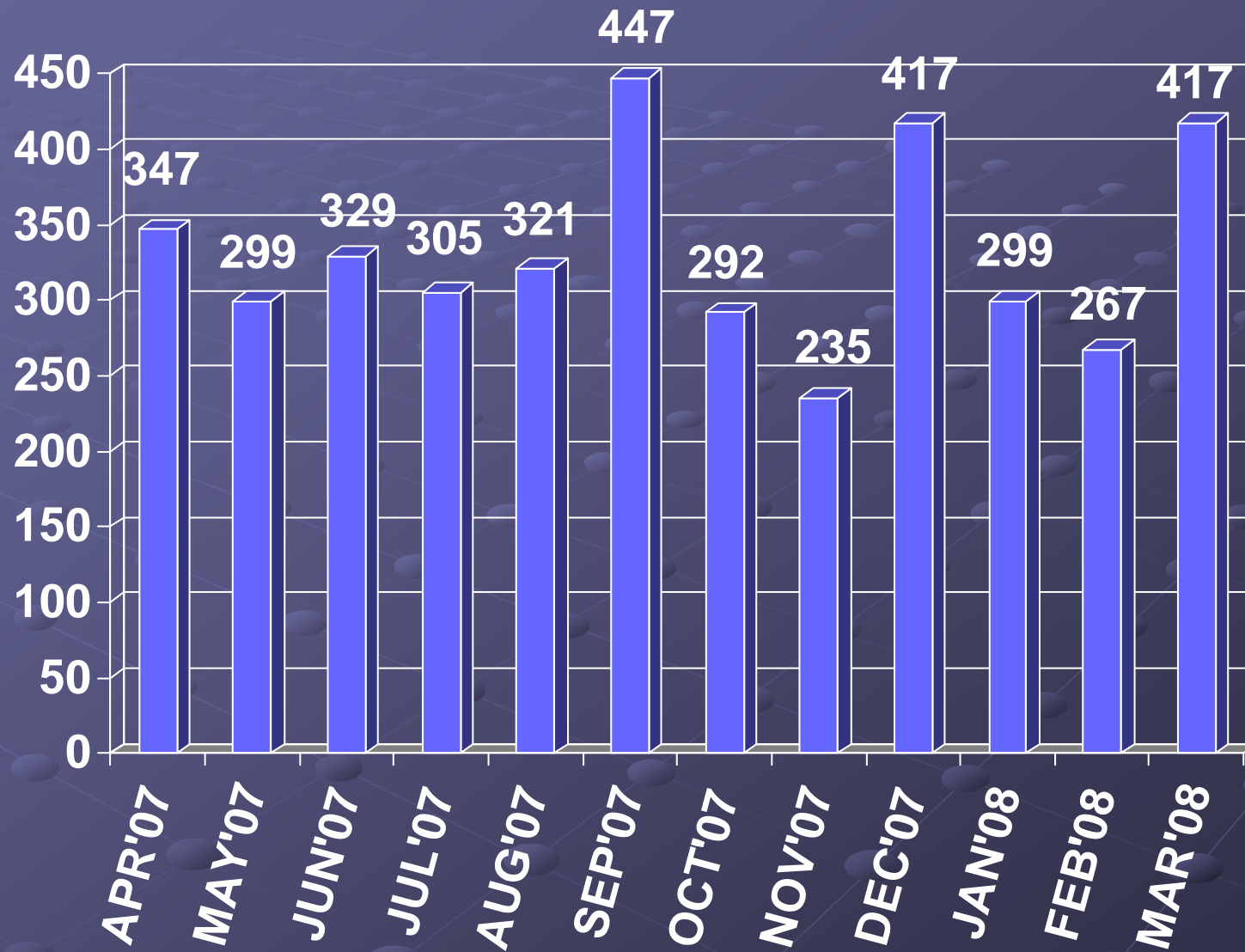


The number of patients that stay overnight in the ward.

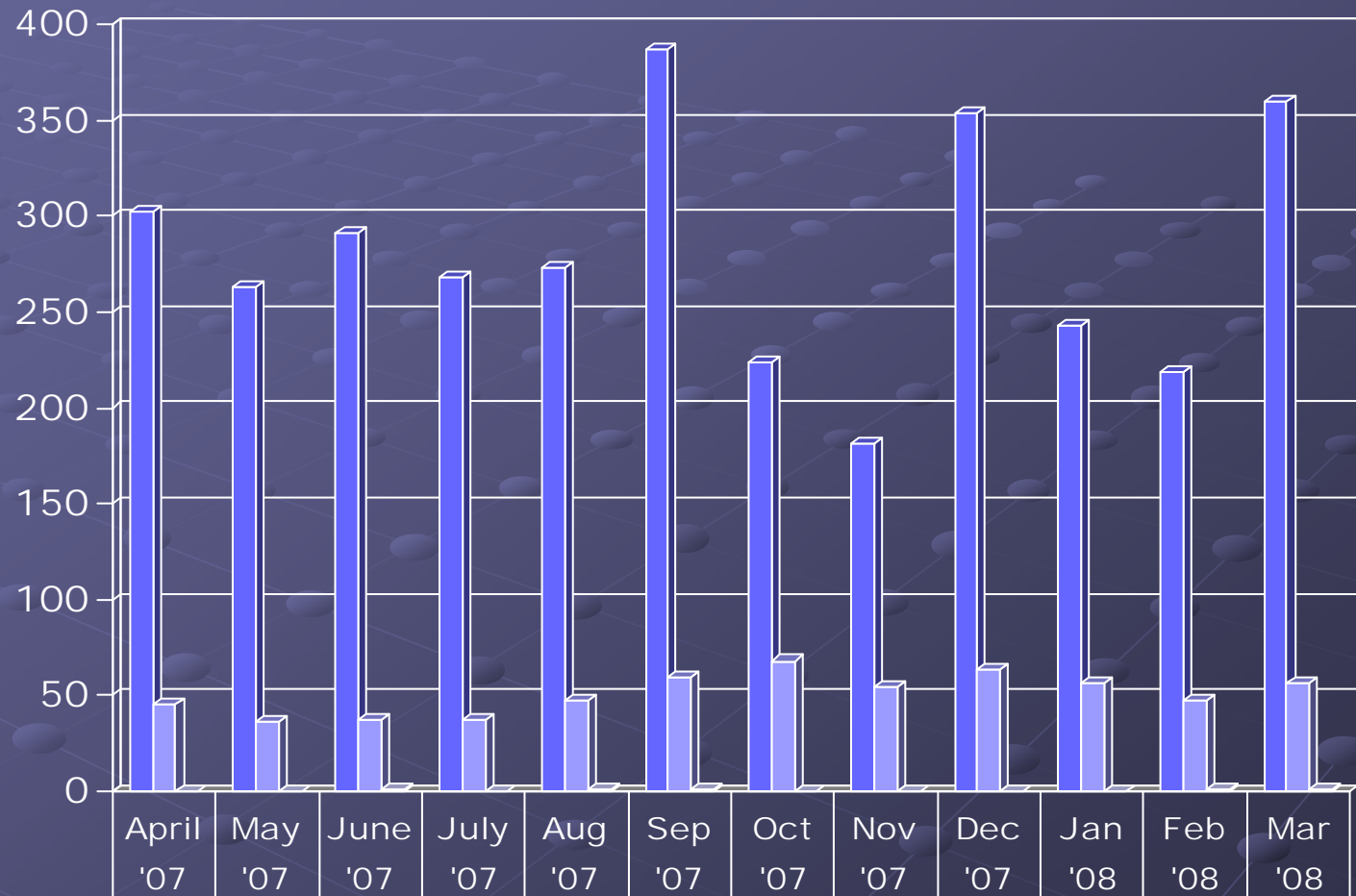
TRANSFER-OUT VS TRANSFER-IN

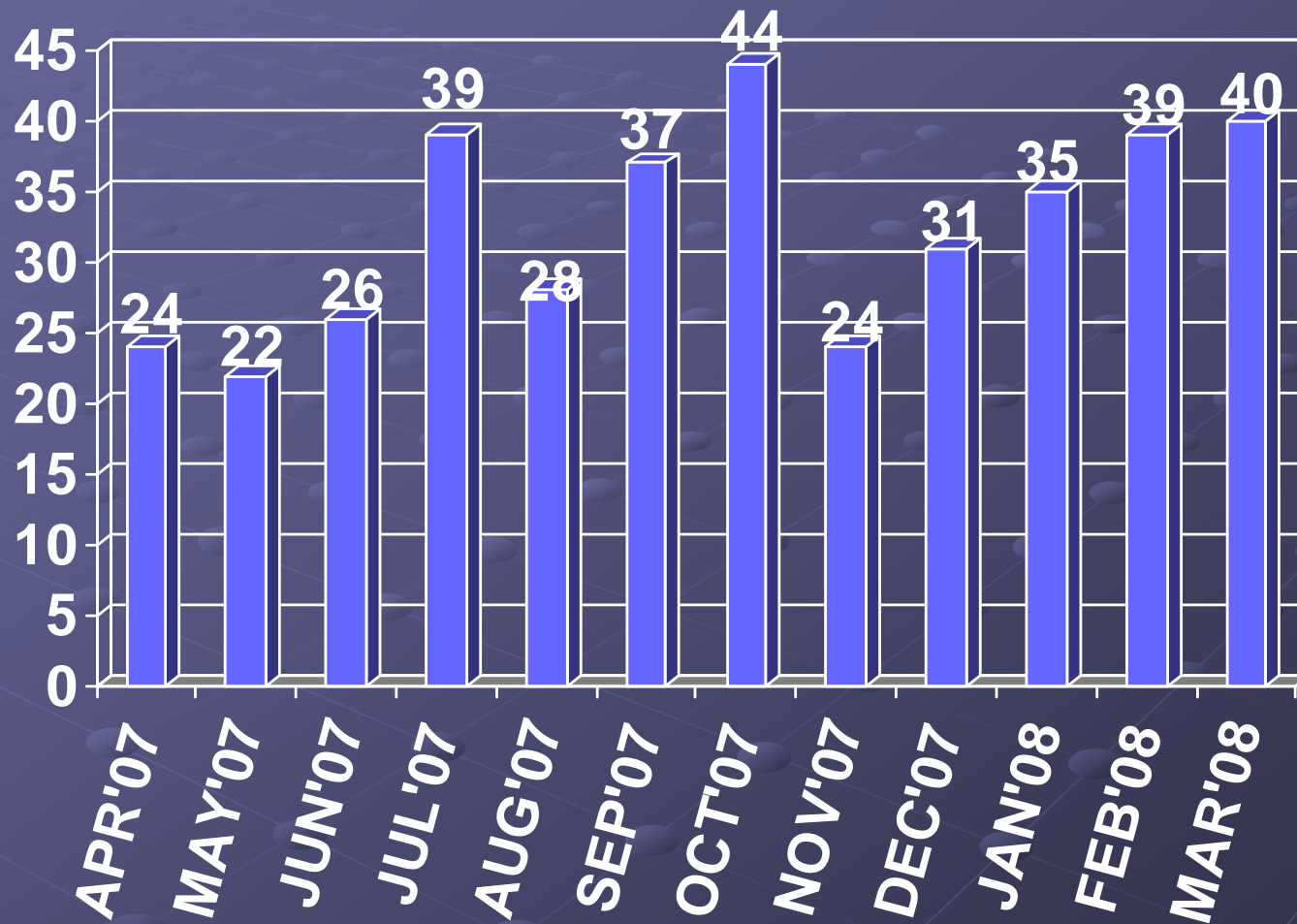

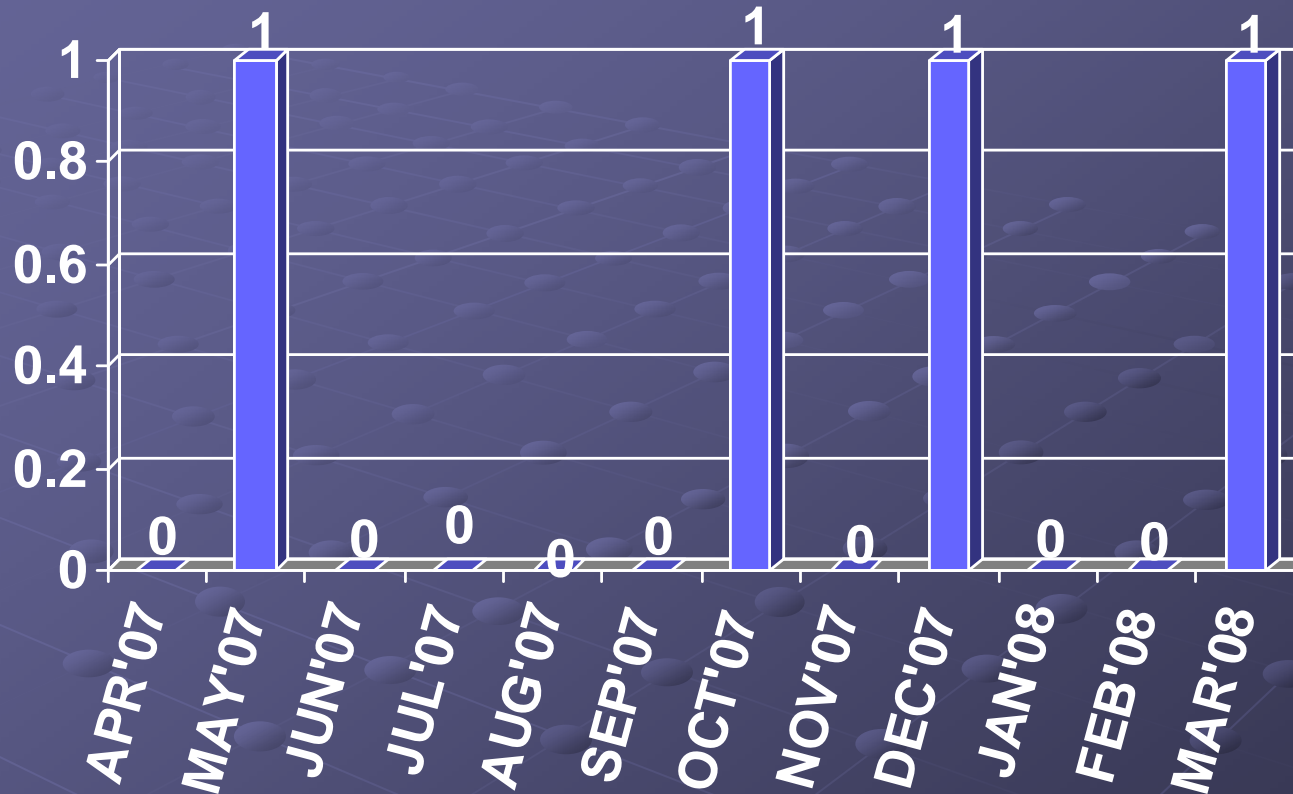

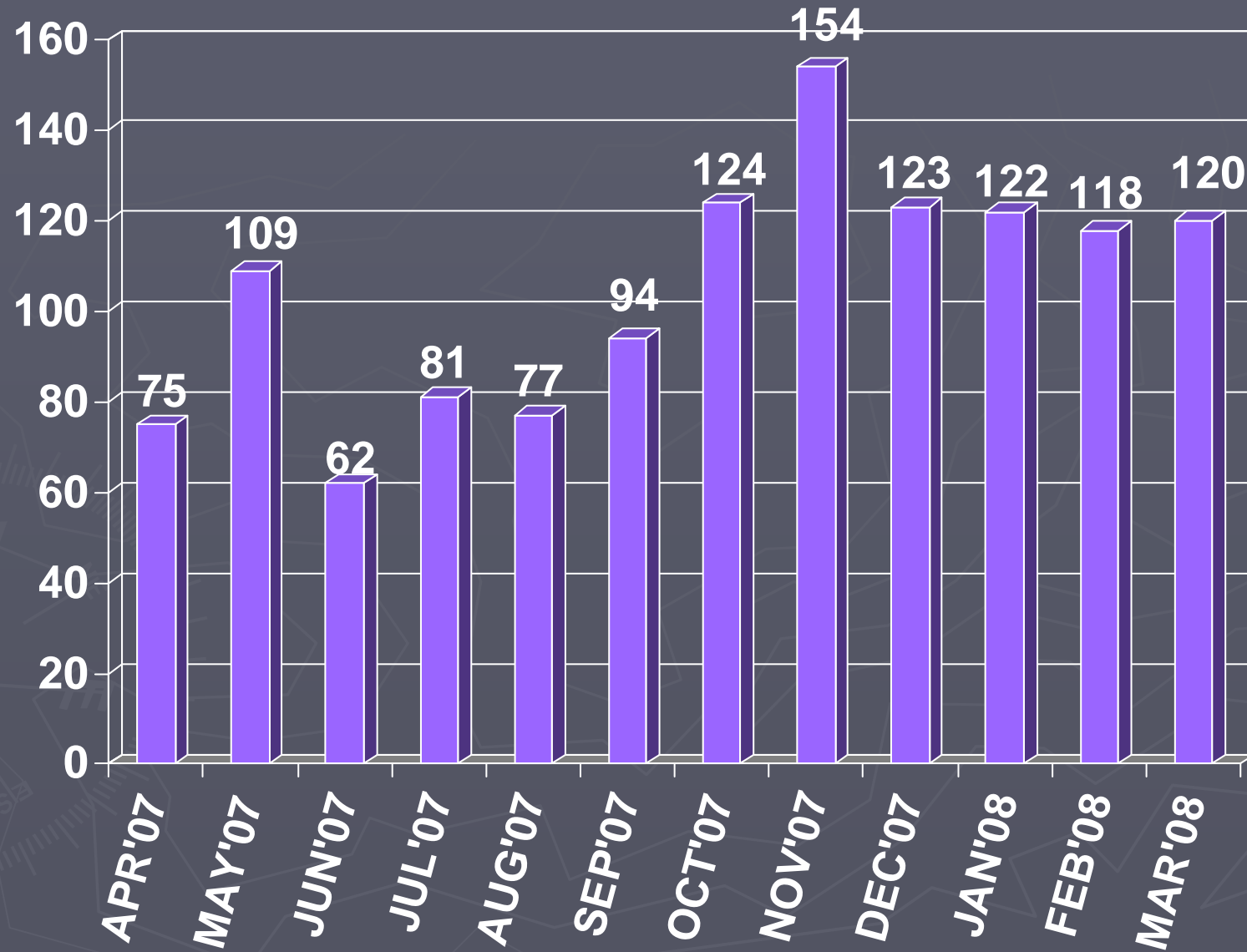

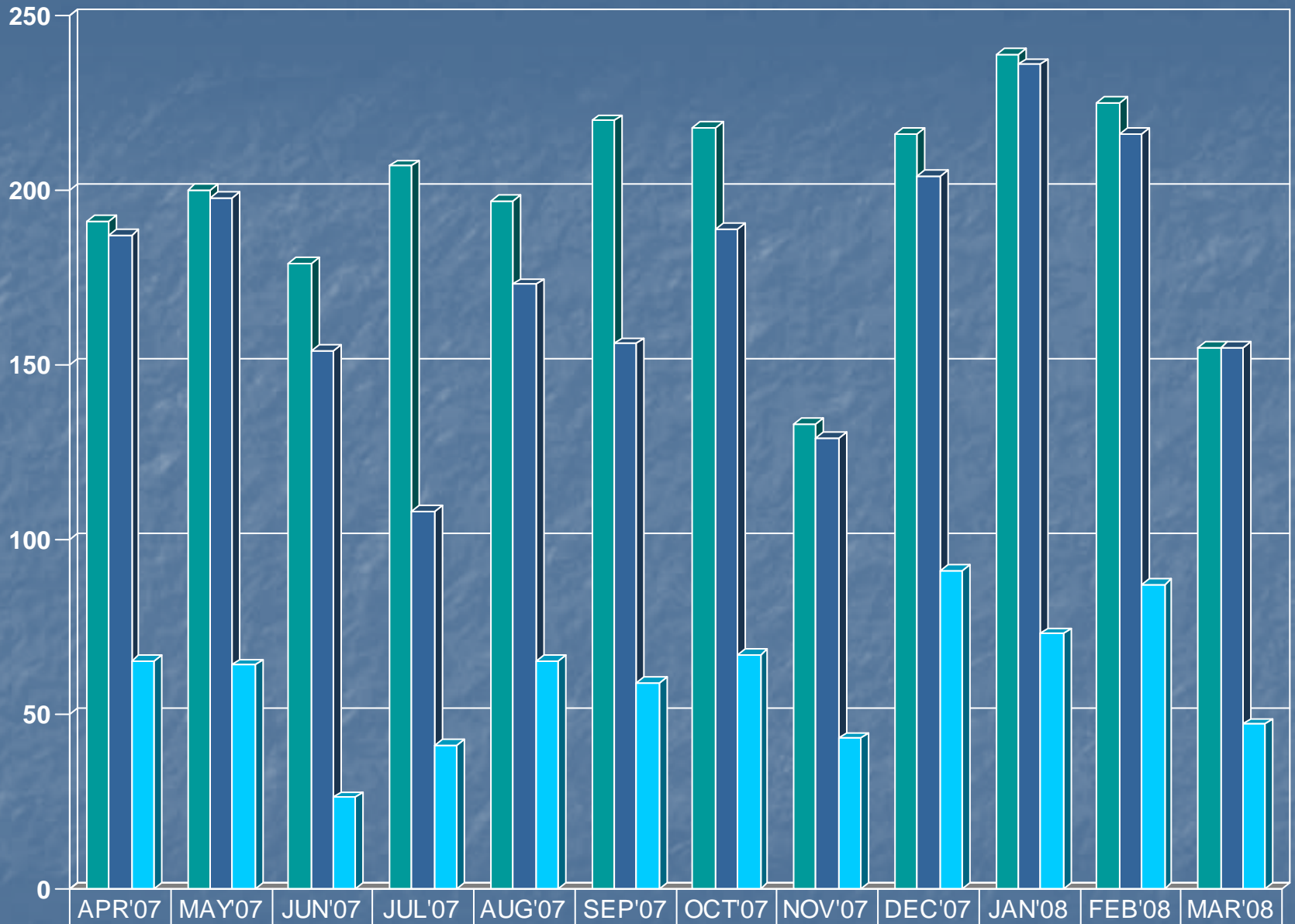

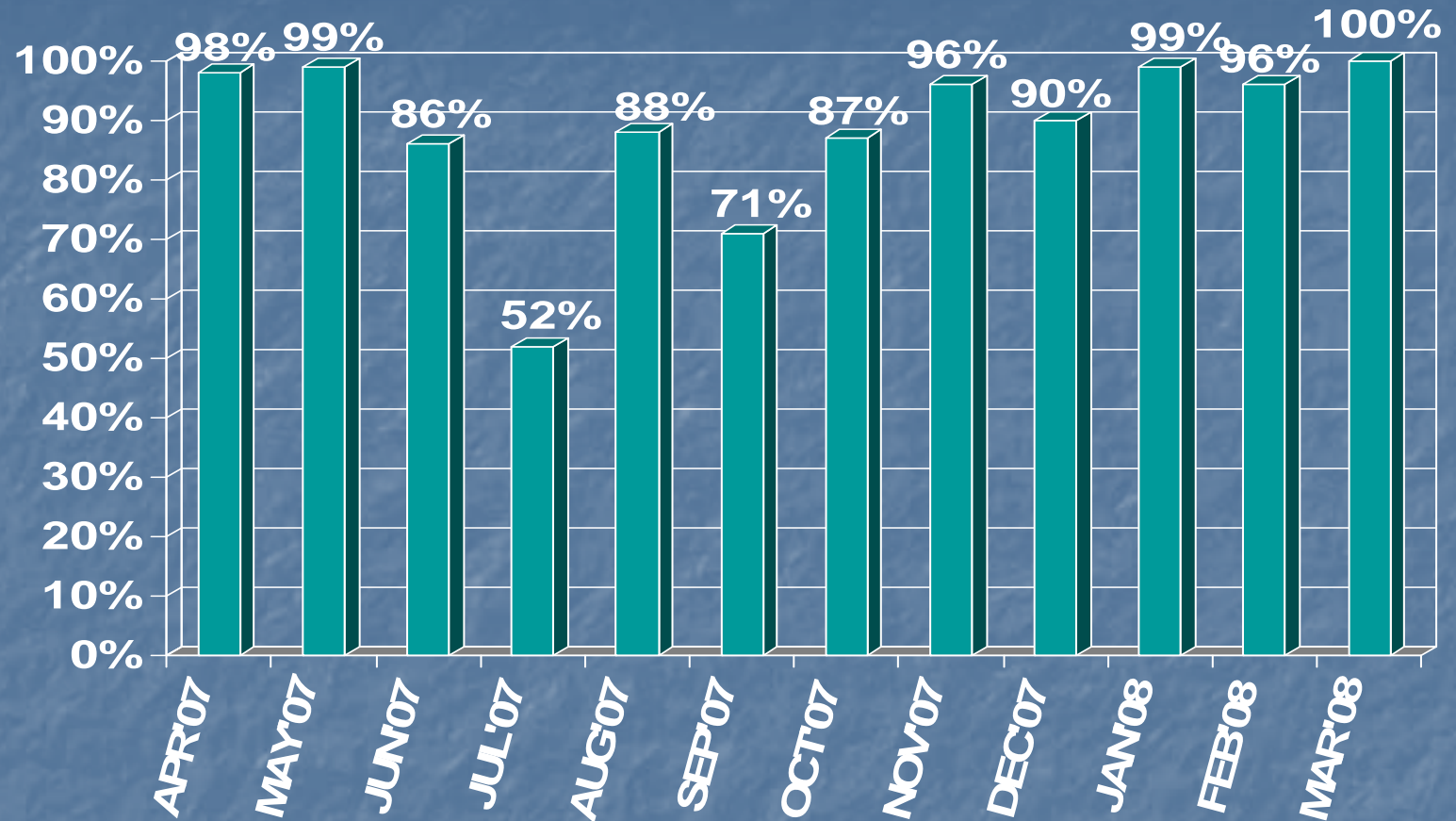

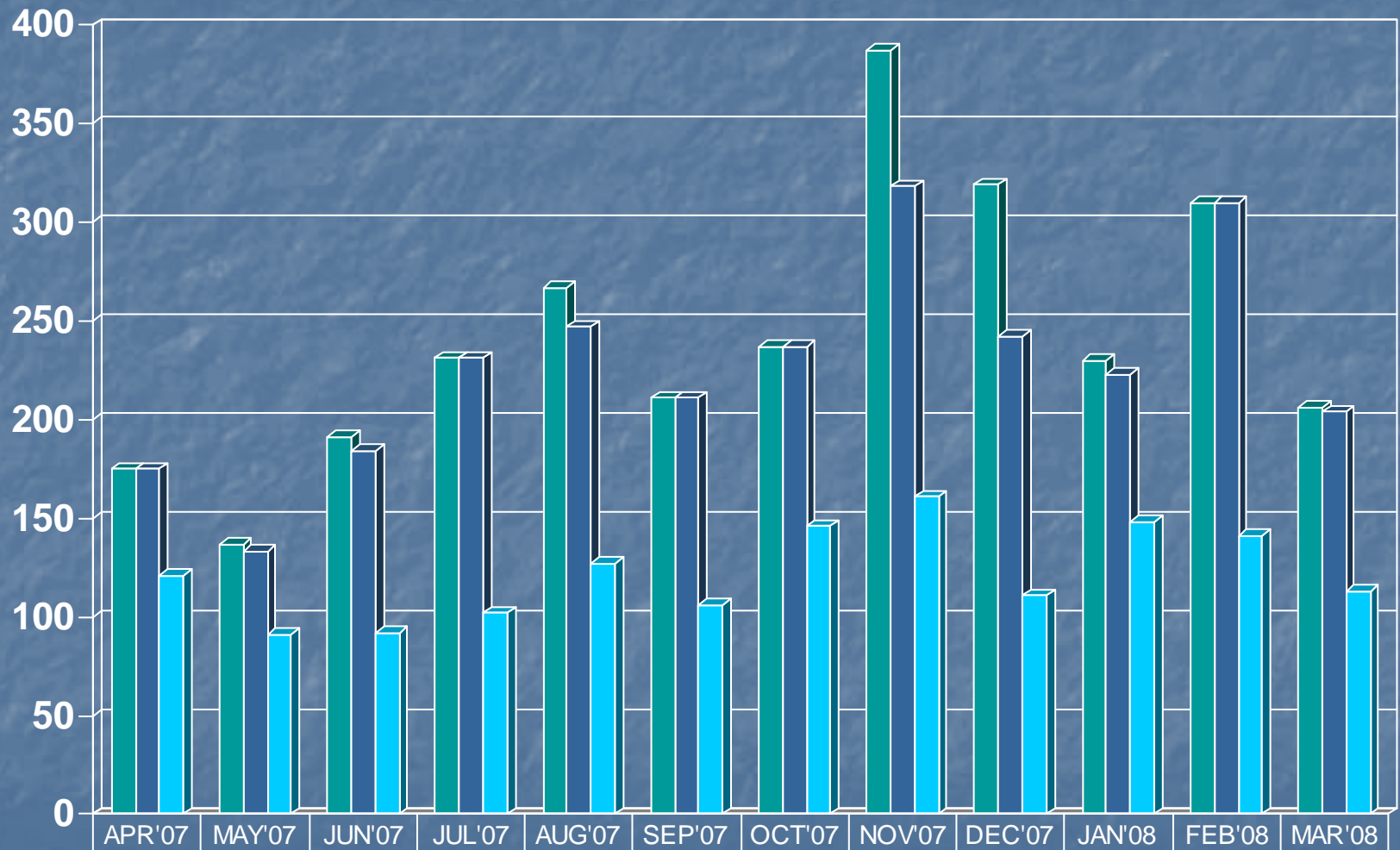

TESTING RATE - (PMTCT)



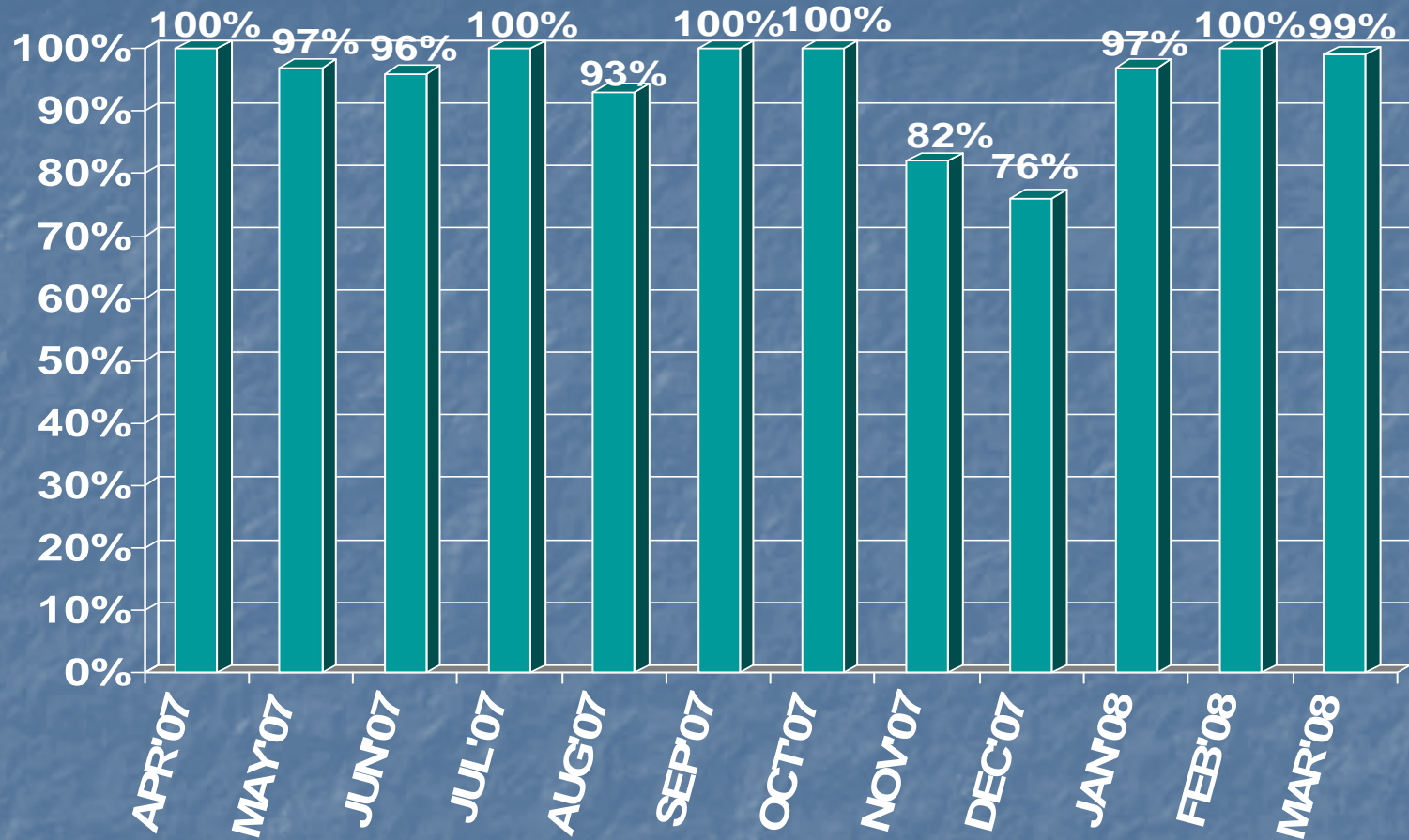

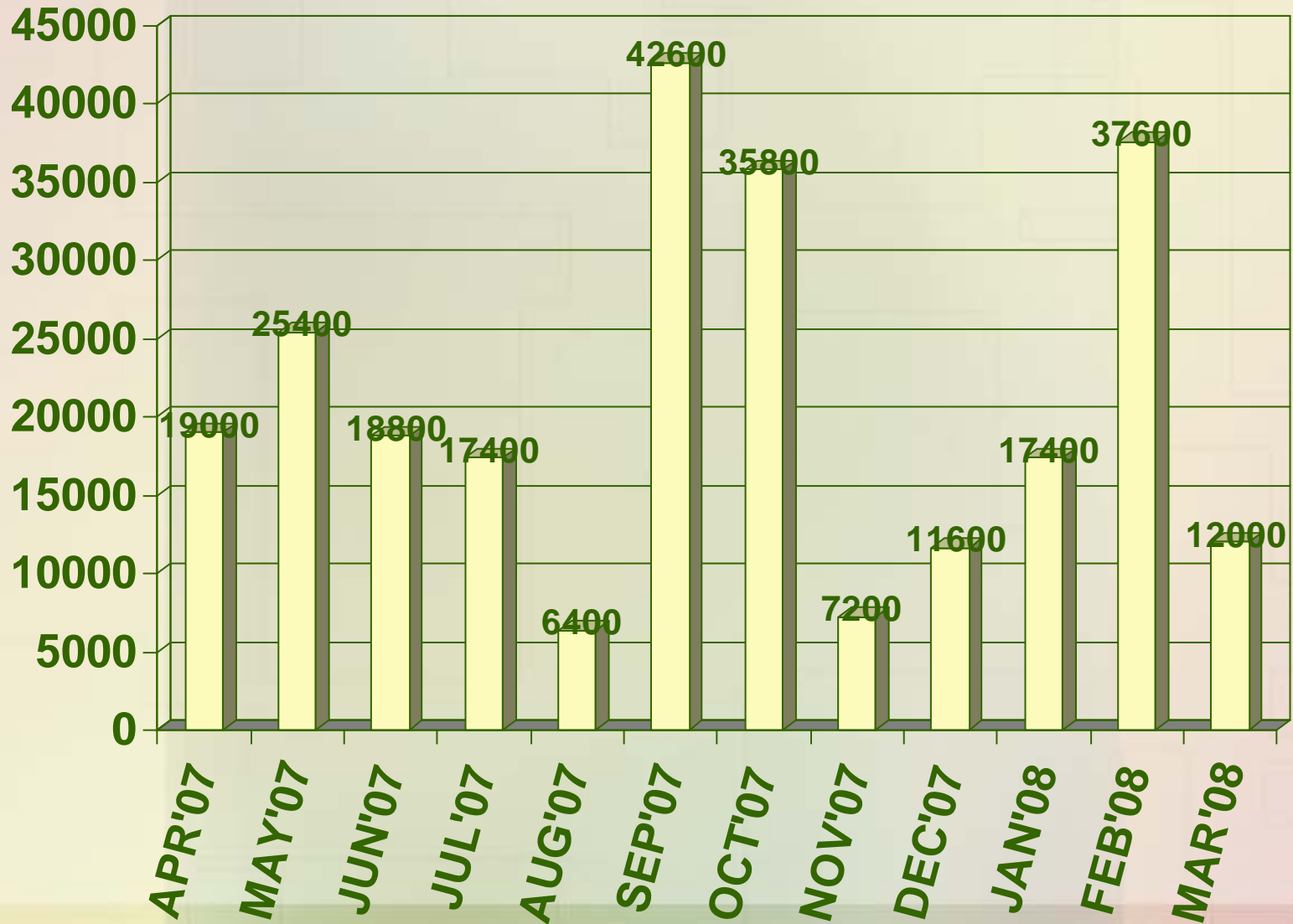

VCT TESTING RATE

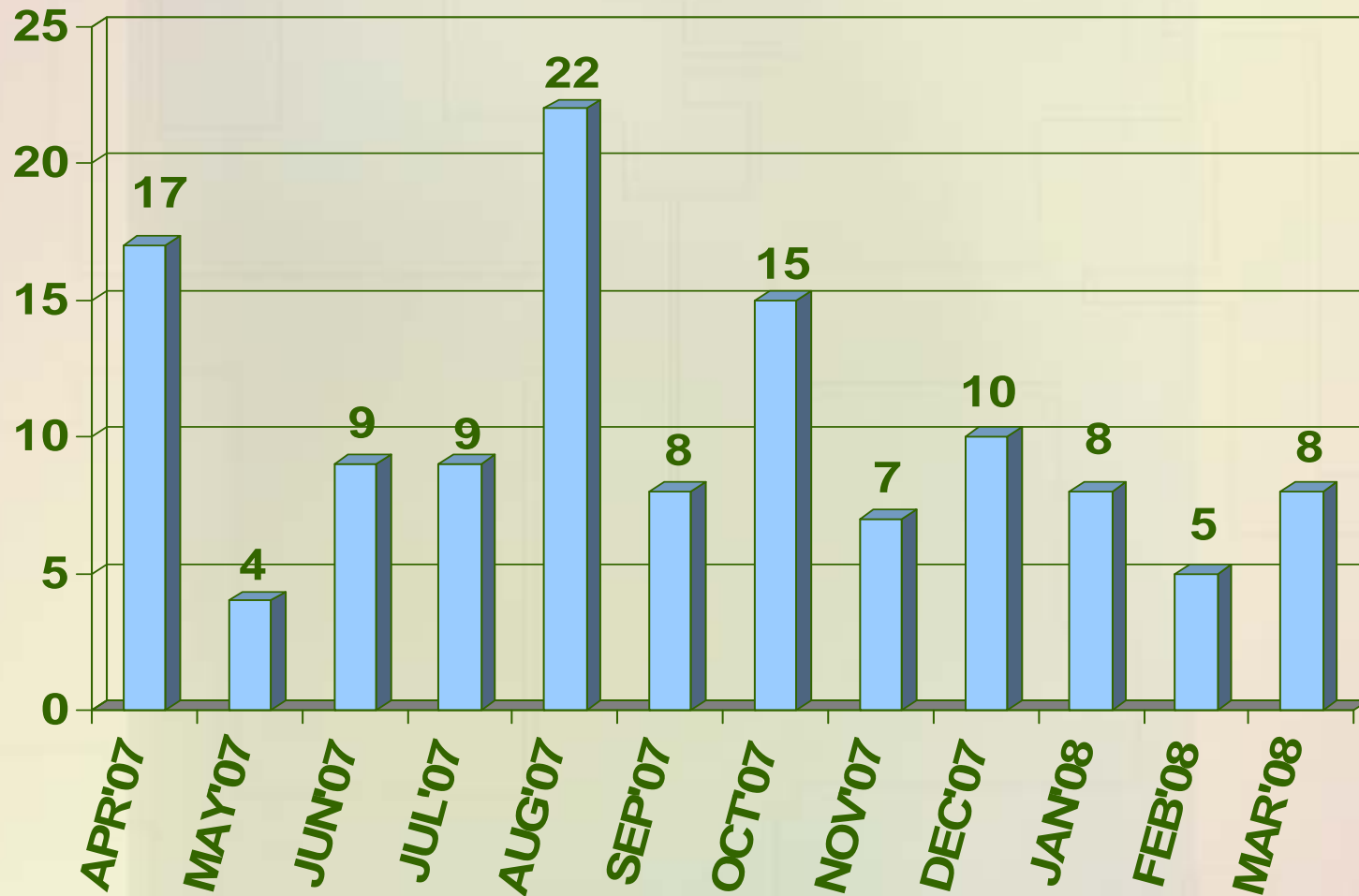

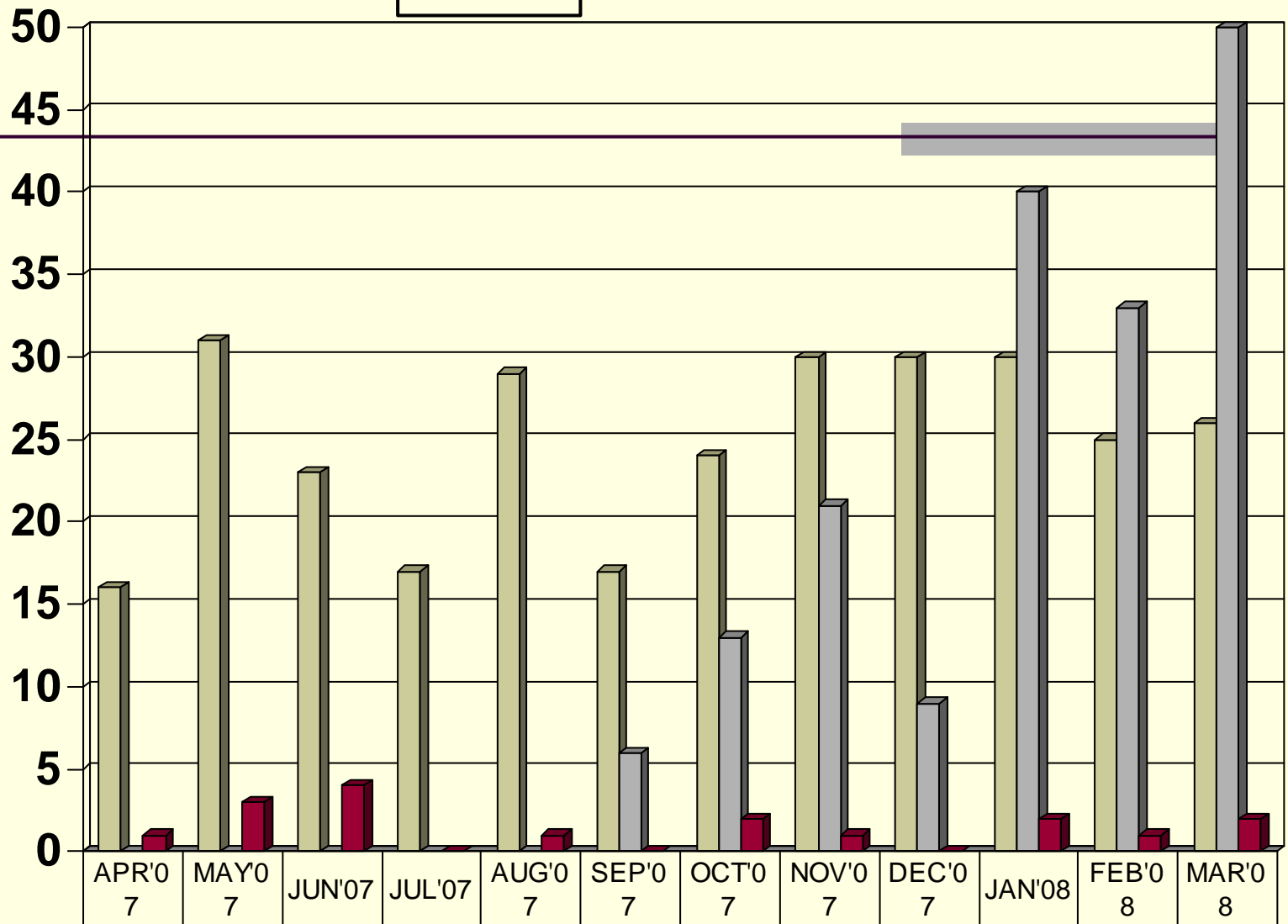


SEXUAL ASSAULT CASE - NEW



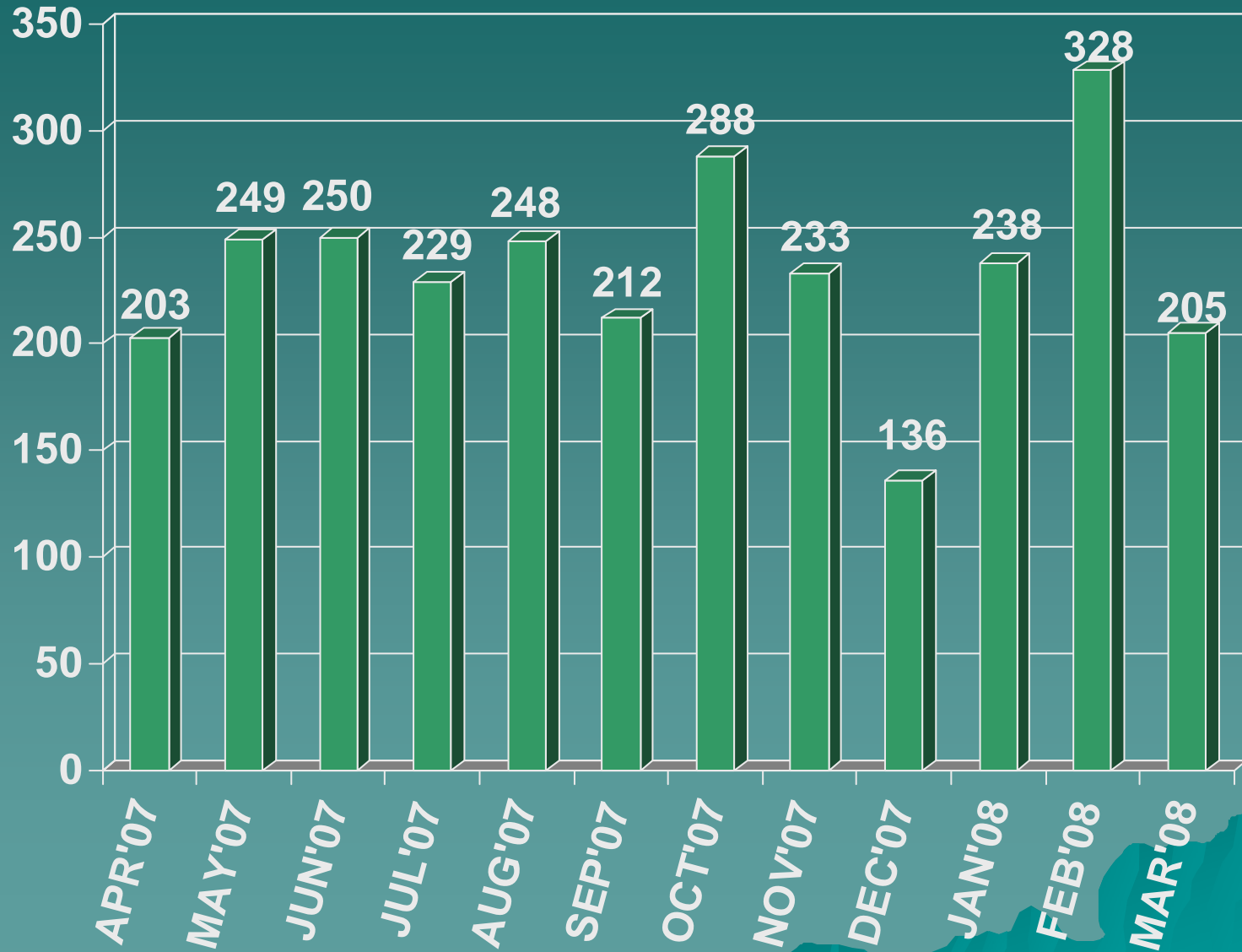

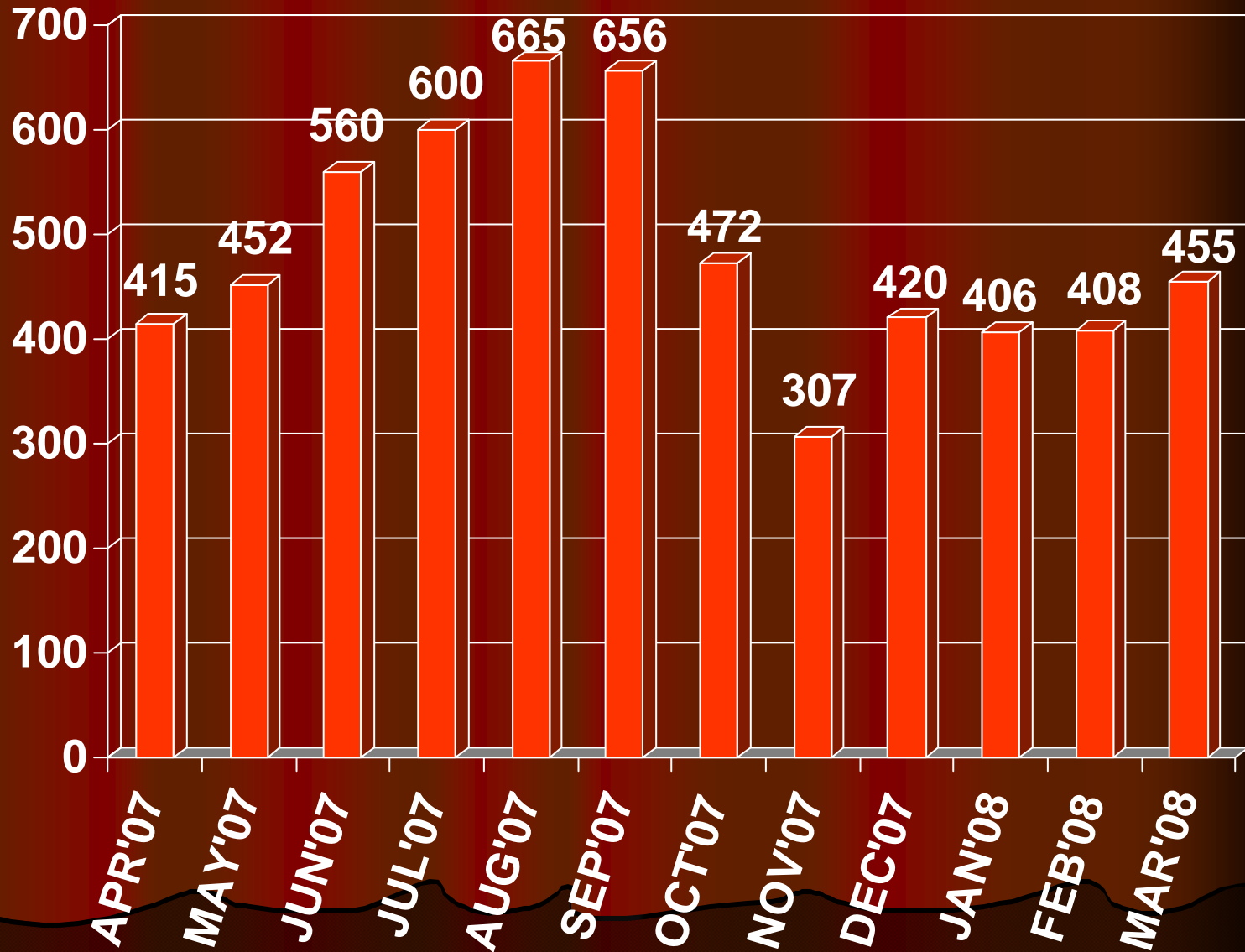

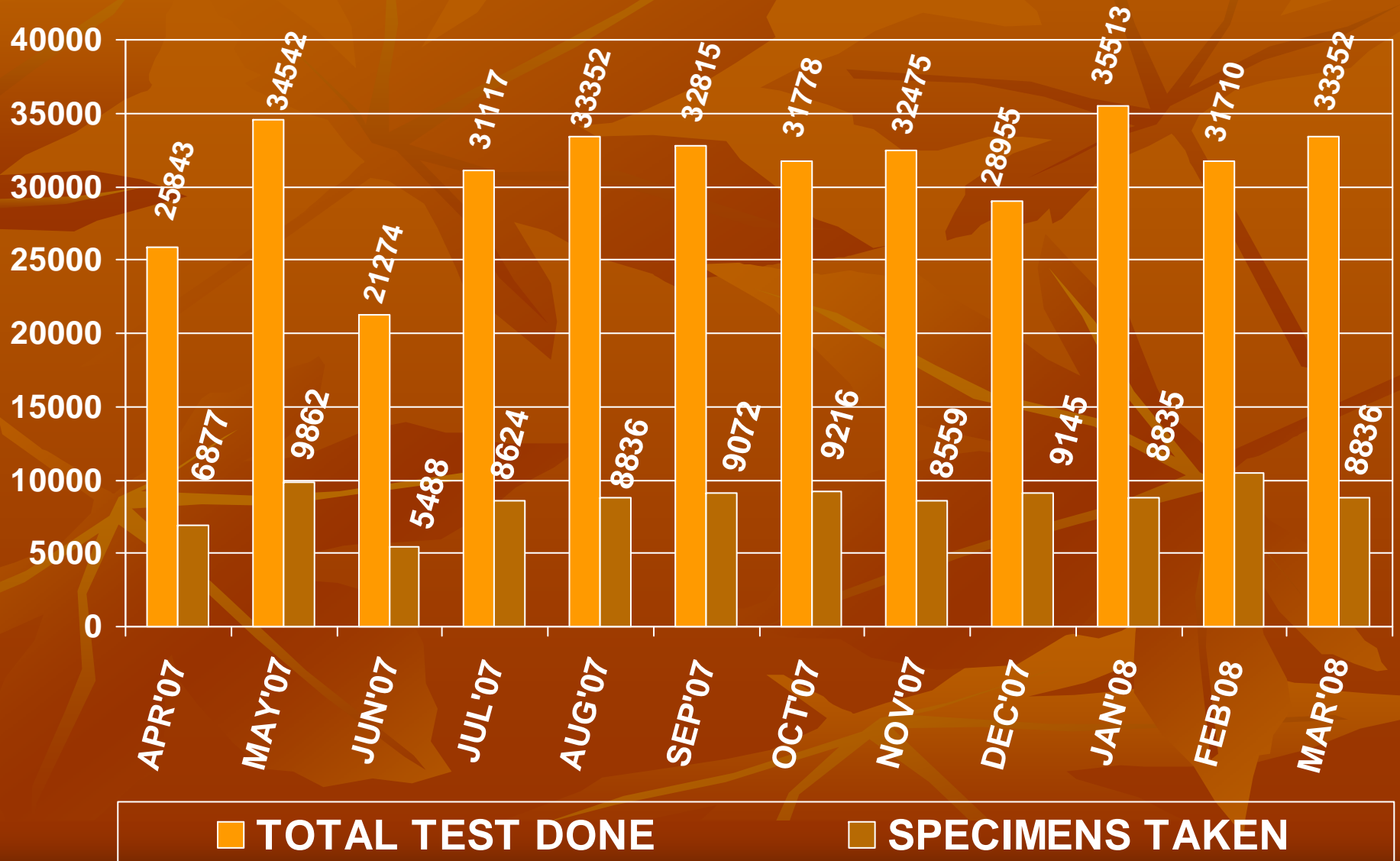

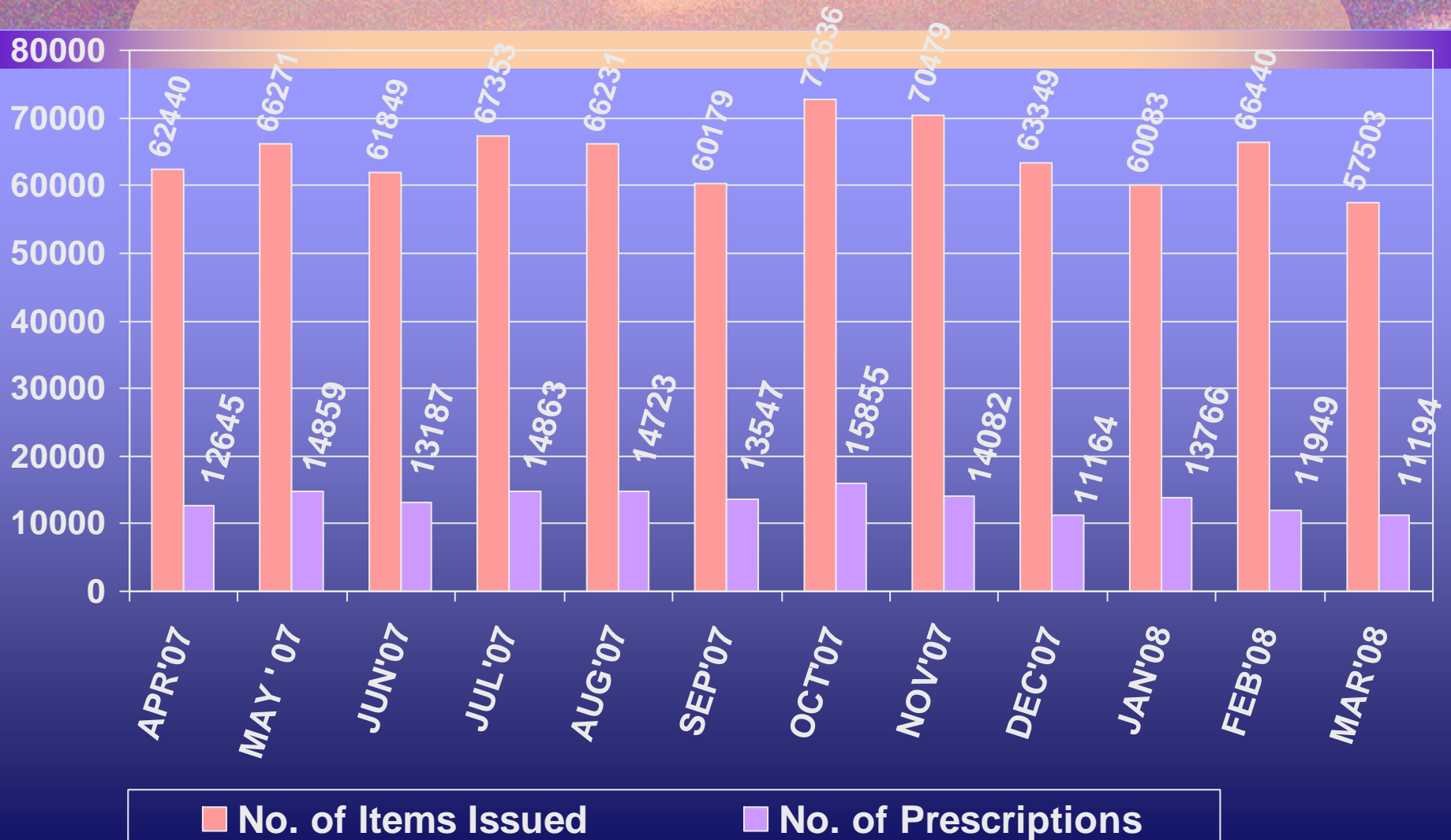


X - RAY DEPARTMENT
