The 5th February 2025 marked the condom distribution day for Mkuze community. Bethesda Hospital HAST Team conducted a campaign, reminding the citizens of Mkuze Town about the importance of wearing protection during sexual intercourse. The campaign started at the Mkuze Taxi Rank with the leadership of the Transport committee in the taxi rank (Mr. Mashibhisa), Store Managers were invited as well as the community as a whole. We had different delegates from the department of health who joined us as part of the campaign. Mkuze is well known for its population, as a busy town with local locations where lot of people ends up leave their rural homes to reside for opportunities. It is within our responsibility as a local hospital to take part in educating and encouraging youth about being protective and also being able to keep up with such environment whilst abstaining from sex.











We have various types of programs aimed at assisting young girls and the community as a whole about such practices.

Abstaining from sex as well as using the protection is a practical habit. One needs to have strong principles of one self how they normally practice intercourse, what principles do they live under, this even goes to the type of partners they want and choose. Its all about self priority once people have learned how to prioritize themselves then they can be able to control partners regarding the use of protection.

Our staff members moved around town, engaging with the force of different stores as well as agencies and banks distributing condoms and encouraging people about safe sex.

As the hospital we have a good rating starting from people who are ART initiated and compliant to their treatment this goes to TB as well. HAST team is doing well when it comes to the management of the HIV/AIDS /TB Outreach program me. It is within our wishes to achieve 95% prevention of the teenage pregnancy, youth diagnosed with HIV as well as the community that is very practical about using condoms. We need more of an educated society even married couples. We are located in the deep rural area where other people down plays such practices because of tradition, belief and culture. We are looking forward to be able to work more with the traditional authorities, and find ways of how the traditional leaders can be educated about these things too so that they will know how to fit them in when assisting people during traditional consultations. We are working towards making this a norm in rural area that condoms must be used and people must love them selves, value them selves this goes to married men too. We are living in an era with many sexual transmitted diseases, we even discovered out breaks like HFMD which gets to be transmitted sexually, also we have other illnesses such as HEPATITIS and many more nowadays self consideration in rural areas is the word to be spread because its all begin with belief and self worth then people can able to choose where and how they choose to be getting involved in romance.

As everyone can see from the above picture the Department of Health has been introducing different types of condoms from the size, to quality and flavor. We have been improving ever since, this is done in order to meet peoples types of satisfaction and willingness to use. The Department of Health ensures free access to condoms for everyone, we find condoms in cans almost anywhere starting from public toilets, hospital entries, pharmacies, shops in order to relieve people from buying condoms even though we have types of condoms that are manufactured and sold privately, those are condoms in the market sold by different brands like DUREX etc.

In hospitals we have staff members designated to take care of the condo cans, checking expiry dates and filling of the cans when run empty for the community's free access to condoms.
