Charles Johnson Memorial Hospital held a brief session where Religious leaders were introduced to the hospital staff on 7th March 2018.

Pastor P. Ndlovu also secretary for Nquthu church council was the programme director for the day . The hospital manager, Mrs M.Z. Khanyile shared the purpose of the day which was to introduce religious leaders as accredited by the KZN MEC for health Dr. S.M. Dhlomo.
