## BISHOP XABA! HOSPITAL CHAPLAIN INTRODUCING REL-GIOUS LEADERG TO CJM

Charles Johnson Memorial Hospital held a brief session where Religious leaders were introduced to the hospital staff on 7th March 2018.

Pastor P. NdlovuÊalso secretary for Nquthu church councilÊwas the programme director for the day. The hospital manager, Mrs M.Z. Khanyile shared the purpose of the day which was to introduce religious leaders as accredited by the KZN MEC for health Dl.S.M. Dhlomo.

Bishop Xaba chaplain for CJM and Dundee hospital was tasked to introduce all religious leaders present. Bishop Xaba highlighted the roles and responsibilities of all religious leaders when vising the hospital. He emphasized the do and don'ts and they should ensure minimal disturbance to health care workers. Bishop Xaba also emphasized the importance of good communication between religious leaders, the hospital as well as the HCF which is an interdenominational Christian movement within the institution run by staff members.
