



#### **Foreword**


- Each point of management need to make decisions, planning, controlling, evaluating and developing policies to increase efficiency of health services. Without reliable information this is difficult.

- We appreciate the commitment of hospital staff who contributed in the collection and analysis of information in this report.




This is the total number of clients seen at OPD




Number of clients admitted during the month




This is the number of days spent by admitted clients during the month




This is the number of clients died in the hospital i.e. still births, neonatal deaths, maternal deaths and any other death.




Number of children died under 5 years . i.e. still births, neonatal deaths, deaths under 1 year and deaths under 5 years but older than 1 year.




Death of woman while pregnant until 6 weeks after delivery regardless of cause







Total number of women who delivered




Women delivered who are 34 years of age and older




Women delivered who are less than 18 years of age







Vit A supplement given to all mothers who delivered including mothers of BBAs and still births




Number of items issued to patients




Total number of prescriptions received at the pharmacy including chronic cases




Total tests that are done at the hospital including specimen received from clinics









Number of X-Rays done. One patient can have more than one X-Ray taken





