Functions of Clinic Committee

- To become and remain acquainted with the operations of the clinic and the services of which such board is constitute
- To act as a channel of communication between management, patients, staff and the community
- To advise the administration on matters generally affecting the management of the clinic
- To concern oneself with the general aspect of employment and other matters of overall interest.
- To make recommendations to management regarding the usage of resources.
- To ensure that no member shall vote upon or take part or be present during discussion of any matter before the committee in which he/she has any interest financially or otherwise.
- To ensure that all matters deliberated at committee meetings are treated with confidentiality
- To assist with fund raising for the clinic and ensure proper utilization of thereof.
- To conduct regular inspections at the clinic
