DLEBE CLINIC UNDER THE SPOTLIGHT

Dlebe clinic, one of the clinics affiliated under Ceza Hospital has been identified by the department to launch the Health Promoting Campaign. This project will be implemented in few clinics and public schools as a pilot project and after the department has seen its practicality and challenges then it will eventually be introduced to every clinic. For a clinic or institution to be known as a Health Promoting Institution, it will have to have certain facilities in place and will have to comply with certain rules and procedu

res. Dlebe clinic has been presented with a document which explains exactly how the evaluation will be made. In this document, they pose questions ranging from 'does the clinic have the community health profile, how often is it done? Patients waiting times, communication within, the quality of service, the community participation and involvement, signage, support from supervisors and superiors, to things like 'is the clinic

clean, does it have a garden and its condition thereof, so on. A meeting attended by myself (PRO), Mrs T W Buthelezi (Clinic Manager), Dlebe clinic Sister-incharge and its board members looked at the assessment document to find out what are the gaps and how they can be filled, to ensure that by the time of the assessment, the clinic meets all the requirements. Meanwhile, we are also planning the official opening of the clinic by the Health Minister which we hope will take place

early next year. This is a great initiative by the Department to ensure that our clinics and public schools improve their standard of service delivery to better serve their communities. But lots of work still needs to be done to achieve this.

INTRODUCING, HEALTH & SAFETY OFFICER: MR MTC KHUMALO

As per the provision of Health and Safety Act number 85 of 1993, the department has recognized the need to appoint Health and Safety Officers in hospitals to ensure compliance and general safety. I spoke to our new H&S Officer.

Public Relations Officer (PRO): What exactly is your role in this institution? Health & Safety Officer (H&SO): To ensure that employees work under a safe environment by identifying hazard and danger areas and to ensure that all safety regulations as set out by the Act are followed and observed. It also includes inspection of buildings to ensure employees work under safe conditions. I also perform risk assessments, report and follow up incidents and accidents to ensure we take preventative measures in the future.

PRO: Say an accident happens, what are the right procedures to follow while reporting it?

H&SO: After being informed by

the supervisor of that section, I will perform a description of injury, time and place of occurrence and particulars of injured individual. And then I will establish whether the incident was as a result of health, safety or fire related cause. Then establish the cause of the incident whether, it was as a result of negligence, intent or accident from the injured party. Within 24 hours the incident must be reported to the Director of Compensation for

PRO: What Act does it make reference to?

H&SO: Health & Safety Act number 85 of 1993. All personnel performing their duties within the Hospital premises whether government or external private contractors should follow the safety procedures and policies set out by the Act.

It is also important to know and understand evacuation procedures to be followed during emergencies such as fire, bomb treats, gas cylinder leakages etc.

PRO: Lastly, your message?

H&SO: Every employee is responsible for his/her own safety, this can be ensured by following safety standards like wearing the right Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Safety rule is 'Think Before You Act'.

PRO: Sir, thank you for your time, hope your presence will be beneficiary to this hospital.

H&SO: Thank you Musa.
