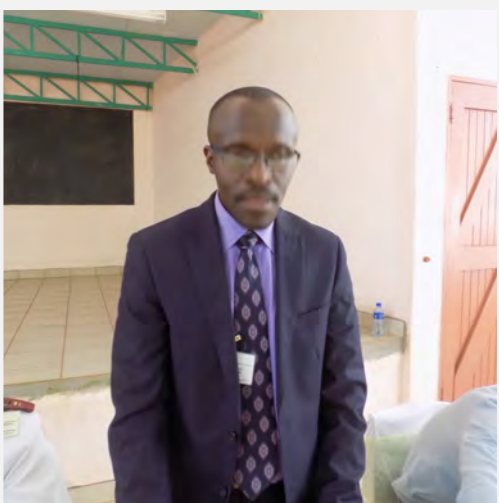
FINANCIAL YEAR END FUNCTION
