MALNUTRITION AWARENESS CAMPAIGN




Parents and their children attending malnutrition campaign

On the 26th of March 2016 Ceza hospital team together with an NGO (HST) visited Empangisweni area community to educate them with malnutrition following many children admitted in Paediatric ward with malnutrition from this area. They were warmly welcomed by traditional leaders and the community was very happy to learn more on how to feed their children with healthy food. On the day children were weighed. Sister Ntshapheka Paediatric ward Operational Manager said that parents must take good care of their kids at all times because at this time and age it is not right for the community to have kids with malnutrition. "Child malnutrition is a serious public health concern; said Sister Ntshapheka. Parents were also told to give their children food with nutrients such as vegetables, milk, fish and white meat to assist in maintaining healthy bodies and decrease malnutrition.
