

BAD ROAD CONDITIONS AT EKOMBE HOSPITAL

We have three Mobile Services, serving very scattered areas of Ekombe. We find ourselves repairing these mobiles on weekly basis with major damages caused by the bad road conditions. To be honest we find it very difficult to work under such conditions. We've been promised by many Head of Departments that our roads will be constructed but up to this far we are still driving our cars in these deep muddy stony roads. Most of us have decided to leave cars in our homes because of the expenses caused by the road damages. But still we are under a lot oppression due to transport problems.

With this we request our Honorable District extended to our Province to give high consideration to these devastating road conditions that keeps our employees in unstable conditions.

Ekombe Staff proceeds by saying: it's not true that we come here to still posts, its not nice to get to know new people at all times.

We enjoy working at Ekombe and we've accepted it as it is and prepared to work towards its development. But when our off duties days come we all get frustrated because of the bad road conditions and transport problems.

That is beyond our power, so we humble request you to do something before it's too late.
