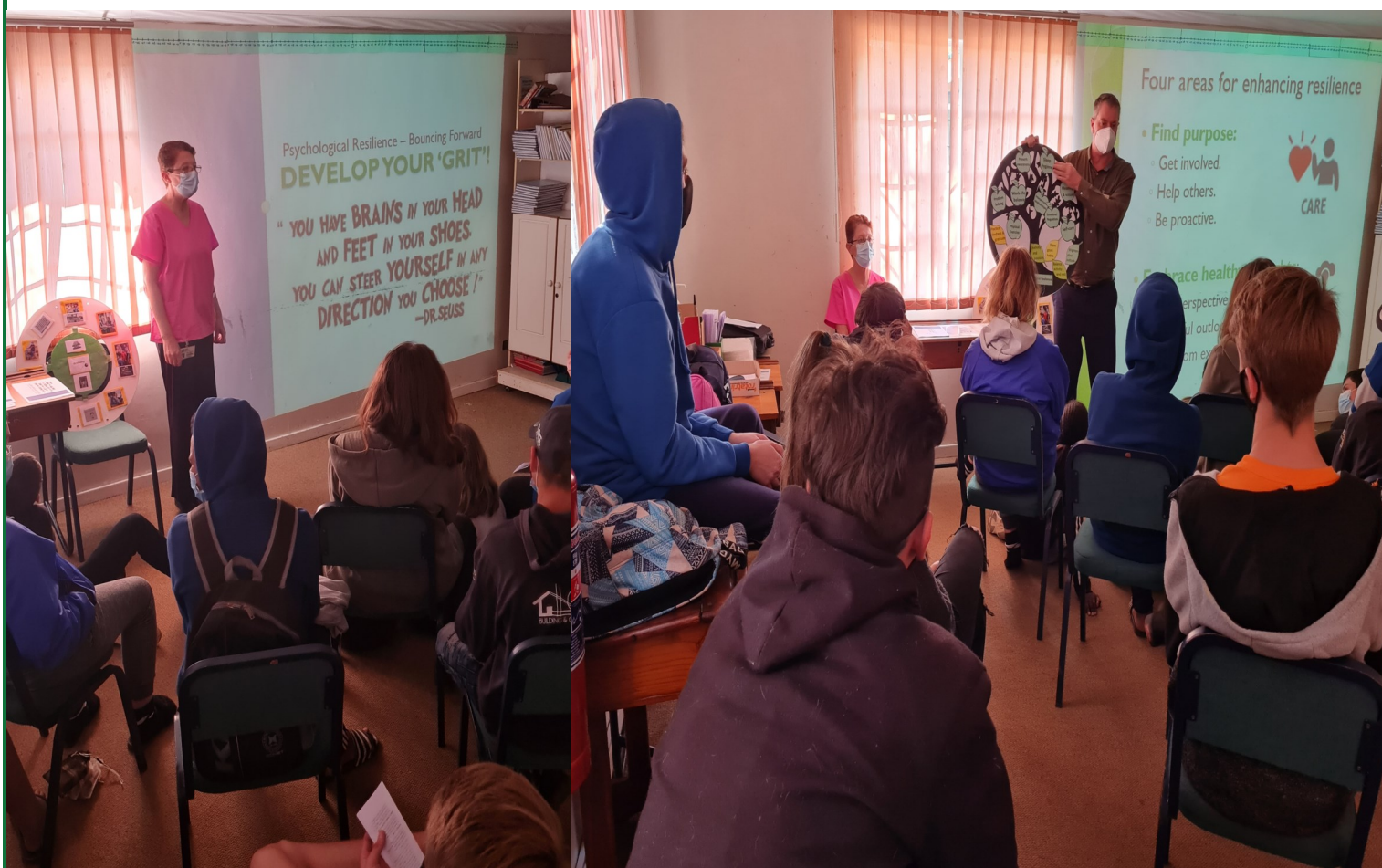


**OUTREACH TO MODERN MINDS SUPPORT AND ENCOURAGEMENT CENTRE

“PSYCHOLOGICAL RESILIENCE – BOUNCING FORWARD”**

What is ‘GRIT’?

‘GRIT’ refers to qualities which help people to manage challenges, such as: **Courage** (not the absence of fear, but overcoming it), **Conscientiousness** (being thorough, careful and organised), **Perseverance** (continuing steadfastly towards a goal), **Resilience** (adjusting to life’s ups and downs) and **Passion** (a deep sense of values and purpose).

On the 04 August 2021, the outreach team conducted an Outreach to Modern Minds Support and Encouragement Centre in Ashburton, following on from the pre-visit on 19 May 2021. A lively morning was spent with the 20 high school learners and 5 educators with facilitation of a skills workshop on Psychological Resilience – Bouncing Forward. The programme was enthusiastically received by all. The learners engaged in the ‘GRIT’ concept and gained skills for enhancing their Psychological Resilience. Pamphlets, stress balls and participation certificates were given to each learner. The team consisted of Mrs Freda Harmse (Social Work), Mr David Blackbeard (Clinical Psychology) and Ms Anathi Mazongolo (Psychology student). We thank Mr Graham Nixon and Mrs Dot Nixon, and the educators and learners for helping to make the Outreach a success.

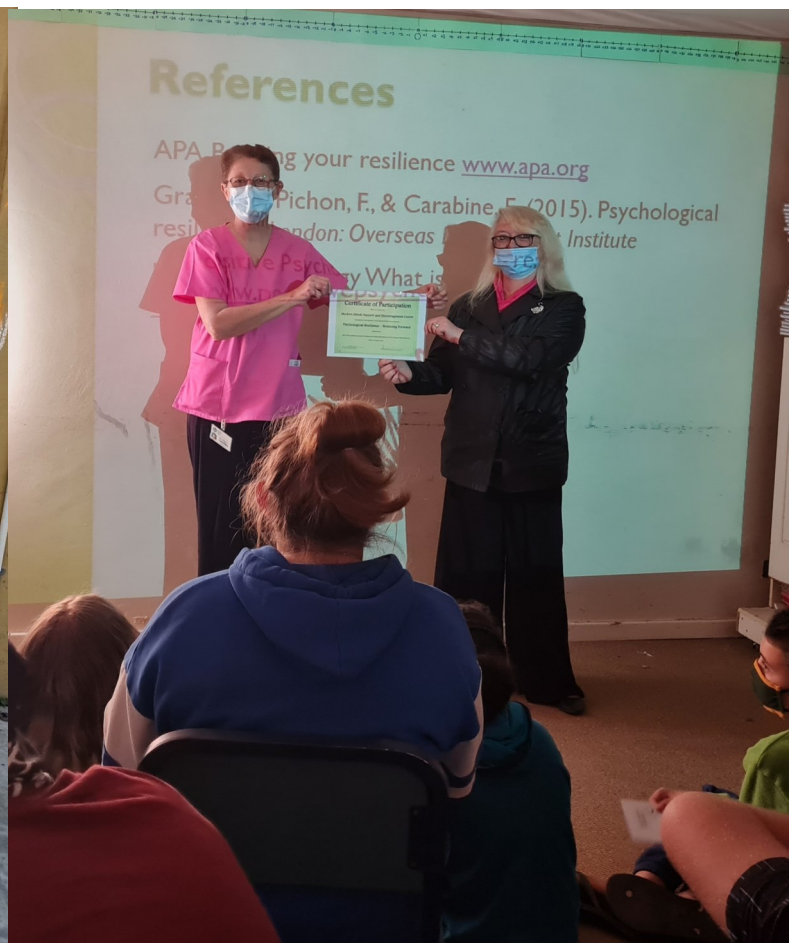

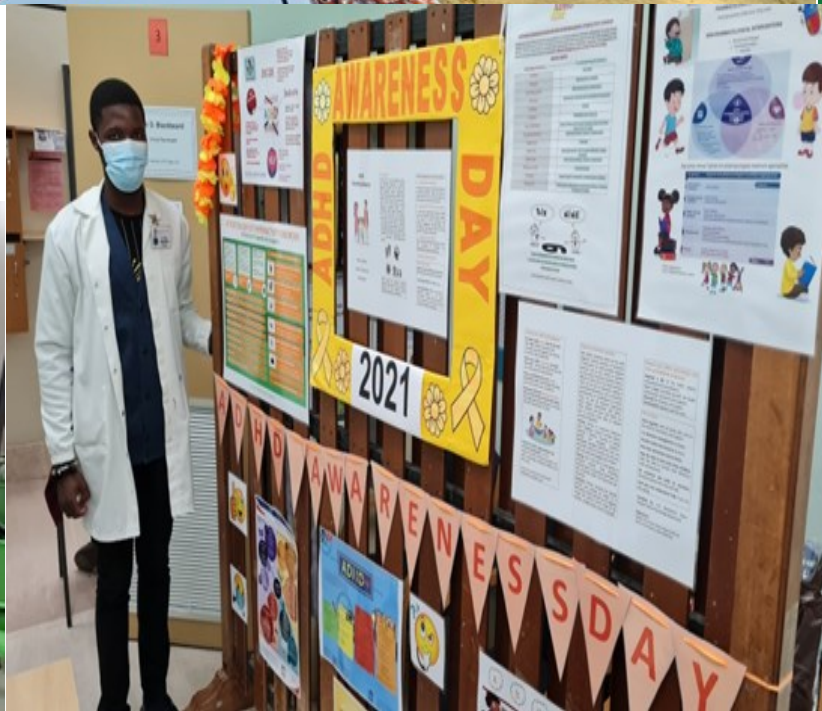

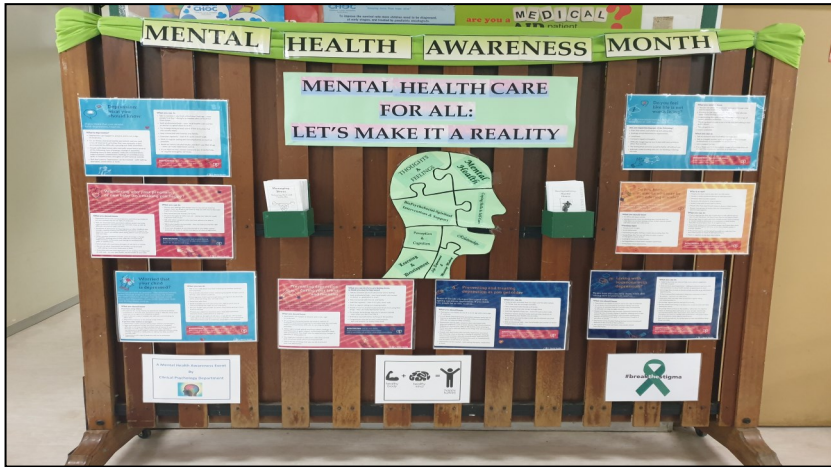

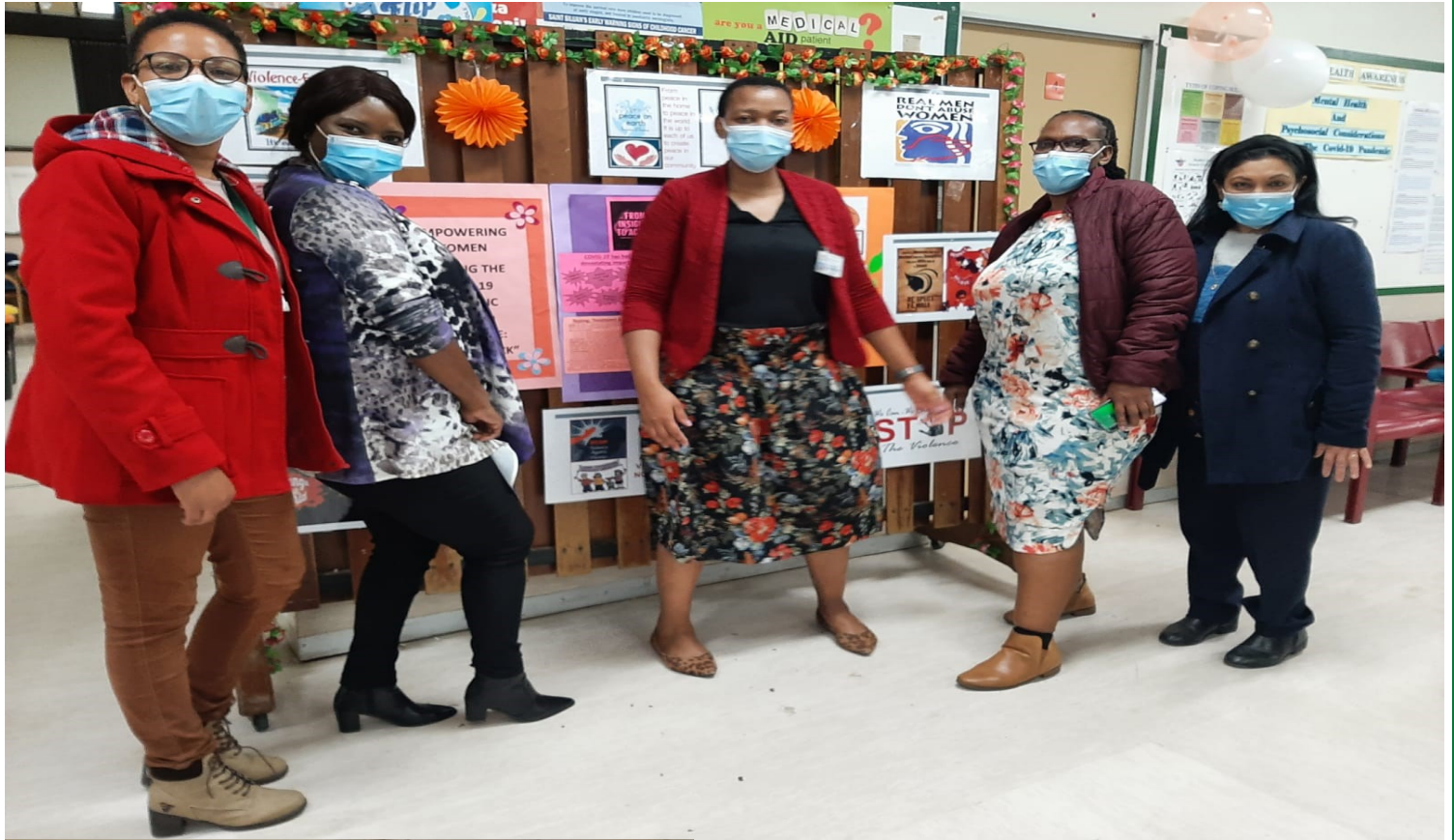
SUBSTANCE ABUSE AWARENESS

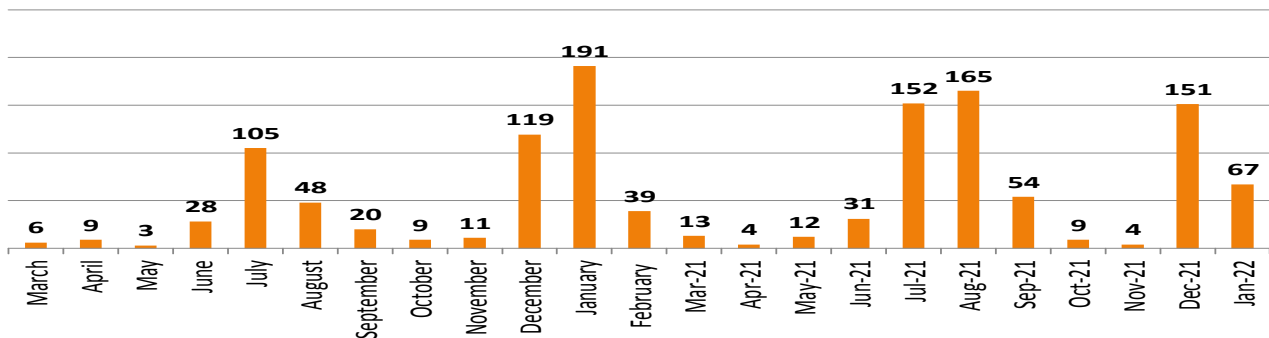

Decisions taken at the ad-hoc JOC meeting on the 05th of April 2022 following the President's address

Wearing of masks to continue for all staff, patients, and visitors

Visiting hours to go back to normal

To stop routine testing of patients, only those with symptoms will be tested.

Each Dept. to manage their own patients and reserve a side ward for COVID positive patients

Oncology to team up with Medicine

To treat PUI's in a designated area in each ward possibly a side ward

To use full PPE for highly suspicious patients

Referral patients with symptoms to be directed to Emergency Dept. to do a swab or test

ITS FLU VACCINE SEASON!!!!

Greys Hospital Occupational Health Clinic is offering flu vaccines.

Place: The Occupational Health Clinic,

The vaccine protects against different strains.

Two types of flu viruses cause seasonal flu epidemics: human influenza A and B viruses. Flu vaccines are made each year to protect against the flu viruses that research predicts will be most common that season.

Most flu vaccines protect you from four influenza viruses:

- Influenza A (H1N1) virus
- Influenza A (H3N2) virus
- Two types of influenza B viruses

These are the viruses that most commonly cause an outbreak of the flu each season.

A flu vaccine takes about two weeks to work.

A flu vaccine tells your body to start making proteins to fight flu viruses. It takes about two weeks to develop enough of these proteins to protect you from the flu. That's why it's best to get a vaccine before flu season when a lot of people in your community are likely to have the flu

Flu vaccination makes symptoms less severe if you do get the flu.

The flu vaccine lowers your chances of getting the flu by 40 to 60 percent, so it's possible to get the flu even if you've been vaccinated. However, symptoms are often less severe for people who get a flu vaccine but end up getting the flu.

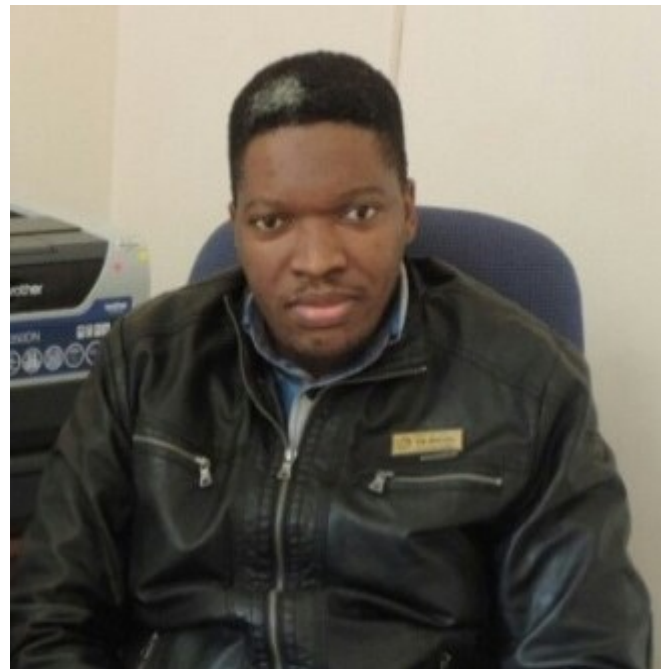

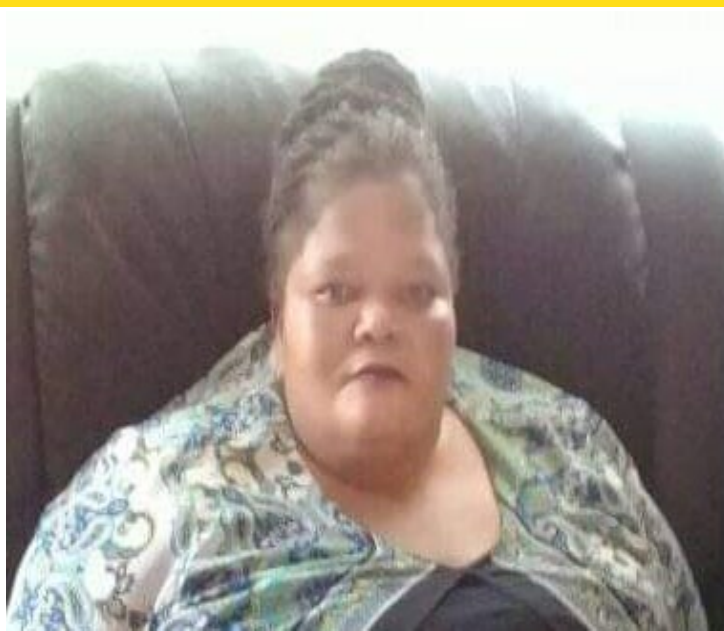

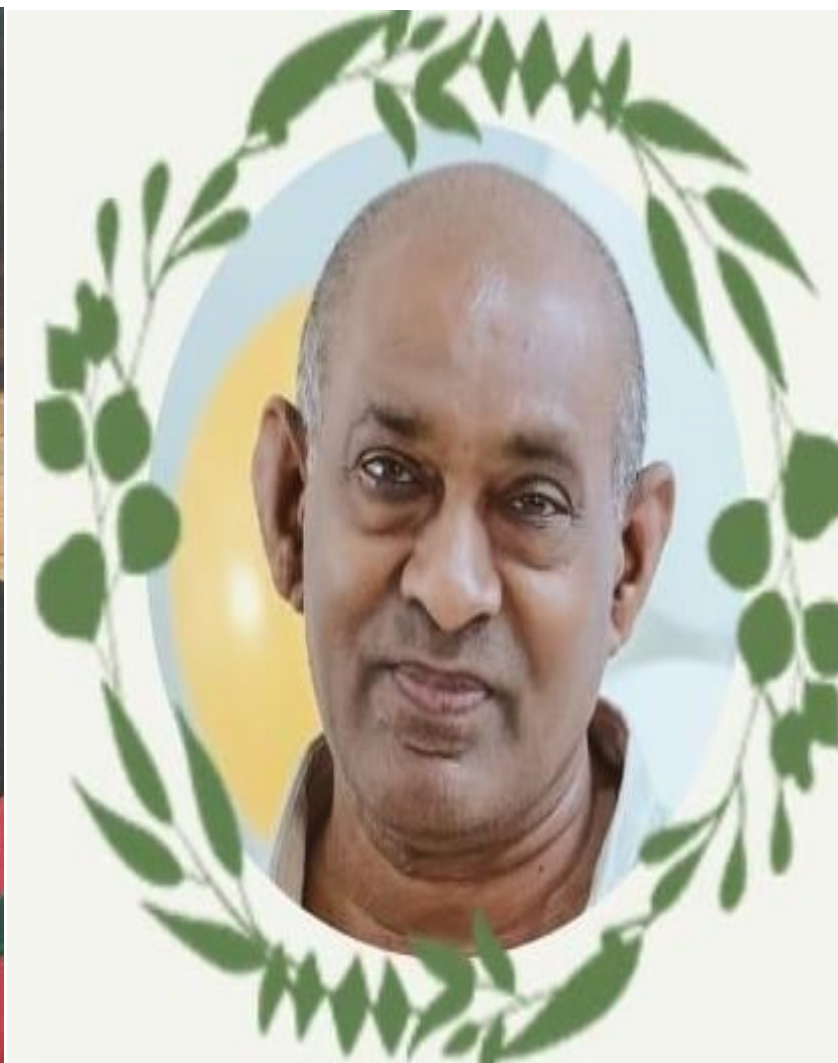
