Acting Centre Manager's Desk

I would like to thank management teams at different levels and staff for the greatest efforts they have invested in improving the quality of our service. We have managed to achieve best results despite all challenges. Our monthly statistics is increasing at a high rate. Average is 25000 per month.

At our strategic planning 2007/8,we committed ourselves in attaining the following objectives in the next three years: To improve the quality of care in order to improve the utilization rate of Primary Health Services within Inanda and surrounding areas. To strengthen good governance in order to advance the involvement of

the community and other critical stakeholders in the planning provision, monitoring and evaluation of operational management system of Inanda CHC. Substantial increase of our head count currently has been noted. This suggest s that we need to improve our service even more to decrease the PHC load at our referral hospitals.

With our service, we must influence our community to prefer PHC service so that our community does not bypass our CHC to seek hospital care inappropriately. We have few interventions that we have implemented this year to improve our PHC service, such as three bedded short stay for children. Last year mobile services were

commenced, now we are at 85% of PHC package. Ark donated a park home and Senior Managers vacated their offices in order to increase clinical space. Ark donated four consultation room which is used for VCT and family planning. To increase access to services, VCT service is now provided seven days a week, 365 days. On Wednesday AIDS and TB patients are served with soup and bread. We have appointed Help desk officer who will coordinate the promotion of Batho Pele and patients right charter under the supervision of the PRO..

Whenever we encounter challenges let us not lose hope and despair. The road of greatness is a hard one, together we will reach our goal which is quality service.

to provide a preventative and restorative programme in future but all lies with the budget. Now we are providing dietetics service which was commissioned last year. We extended dietetics service in the local schools. The social worker, dietician and

other staff members have initiated the vegetable garden and the soup kitchen. The Radiography services includes both X-ray and Ultrasound.

The pharmacy provides a weekday service and laboratory processes sputum for AFB with a TAT of <24 hours. Our TB unit has managed to see 2000 patients per month. The secret to our success is team work. The moral support that we receive from each other motivates us to persevere despite the trying times.

Soup kitchen

Inanda Community Health has started a soup kitchen for its patients. The target areas are ARV's ,TB,VCT and short stay. The soup kitchen started on the 25 of September 2008 and it was the initiation of Social worker and dietician.

Inanda Community Health centre has a partnership with Lindelani support group. ±70 patients are receiving soup and bread always on Wednesday

through our social worker and dietician. We would not make it on our own without the help from our District.

This is a big achievement on the side of the clinic and the community is very much happy with the initiative by the clinic. Most of our TB,ARV's and VCT patients comes to the clinic without having meals in the morning. The centre is trying by all its level best to improve the lives of its patients. Having seen that our patients are struggling in terms of taking their medication the institutional dietician and social worker took the opportunity of initiating soup kitchen from their own pockets.

The management of the centre would like to thank them for their tireless effort for service deliver. The local counselor and advisory board members are pleased with this initiative and they are promising to help the social worker and dietician to improve the service. Even though we are faced with budget constraints but we will fight to our patients. Sisonke sizongoba.
