NATIONAL DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH INFRASTRUCTURE VISIT



On May 6th 2024, officials from the National Department of Health visited King Edward VIII Campus and King Edward VIII Hospital as well as the associated CETU for an infrastructure assessment regarding the readiness for the clinical placement of students. King Edward VIII Campus was one of the campuses selected within the KwaZulu-Natal College of Nursing which is one of the 9 Public Nursing Colleges within South Africa. The main purpose of the visit was to assess available infrastructure that is needed to provide high quality nursing education to nursing students which is in line with accreditation by the nursing education and training quality assurers, the SANC and CHE which are guided by the Higher Education Qualifications Sub Frame (HEQSF).
