Pro-Clin Hospital Information System Implementation Progress

The Pro-Clin Hospital Information System began at King Edward in January 2017 and since then, huge progress has been made in getting the hospi-

tal working through an electronic system.

This system is used for inter alia patient admin, prescribing, stock control, scanning of files, revenue collection, etc.

Some figures:

In total 144 975 Patients are registered on the system. This is split between 132 122 registered patients under King Edward and 12 853 that have been registered at St Aidans.


