




INFORMATION ANALYSIS OCTOBER-DECEMBER






Obstetric and Pediatric Ward affects the overall bed occupancy rate which is 80% due to their quality of service. Most of the patients at Obstetric Ward deliver and get discharged the following day. This is due to the effectiveness of ANC clinic.





We are having a high volume of T.B patients therefore we need to add an extra slice in ourbudget in T.B Management as we will require to procure food parcels and medication for T.B patients.



In terms of District Health Plan we targeted to enroll at least 60 people per month on the programme and have manage to refer our eligible clients to ARV clinic and the head count is increasing on daily basis. It shows the effectiveness of our VCT Programme.

One of the strategic objectives of the Social Work Department in this hospital is to undertake school visits to render social services to school children.
