


What is MomConnect?


MomConnect is a National Department of Health initiative. It uses mobile technology to register all pregnancies across South Africa.



Be part of the family – we're here to help you every step of the way. It's simple, free and can work on any phone.



You'll get weekly SMS messages to help you during your pregnancy and until baby turns 1.



Get answers to your baby and pregnancy questions with MomConnect's life guides by dialling *134*550#



Your voice will be heard. You can tell us about the level of service you received at any government facility by dialing *134*550*4#.



What will the MomConnect messages say?

The SMS messages we send will tell you about where you are in your pregnancy and give you updates on how your baby is growing.

Your baby's movements will get stronger and more regular. Your baby won't move all the time. Like you, sometimes he'll just want to rest and sleep.

What will the MomConnect messages say?

The SMS messages will help you with ways to improve your health and your baby's.

HIV+? You are not alone. Lots of pregnant women have it. You can still have a healthy baby. Tell someone you trust or call the helpline on 0800 012 322


What will the MomConnect messages say?

The messages will include important info about your clinic visits, tests and the medicines you'll need during your pregnancy and until baby turns 1.

Your clinic visit is due soon. Get your blood pressure checked. It can be dangerous if it is high you could have a fit, so it is wise to keep an eye on it.

How do I join MomConnect?

During your clinic visit, a nurse will confirm you are pregnant and ask you if you would like to be registered. Don't be afraid to ask questions.



How do I join MomConnect?

If you are unsure about joining and would like to think about it, ask a nurse to help you register on your next visit.



How do I join MomConnect?


You can also help pregnant friends and family* to join on their phones by dialling *134*550#.

What information do I need to join?

You need: Your due date, ID Number, passport number or date of birth, & language*.



^{*} You can choose to join in English, Zulu, Sotho, Xhosa, Setswana or Afrikaans. All your information will be kept safe

What will this cost me?

Nothing. It's free to all moms on any phone and network, across South Africa. You will never be charged for getting or sending SMSs or for dialing into the *134*550# line.



What if I don't want to receive messages anymore?

You can opt-out by simply dialling *134*550*1#. Please tell us why you don't want to receive messages anymore so that we can support you further and improve our service.



What happens after I have my baby?

If you've had your baby, congratulations on being a mother! Reply "baby" to any SMS from MomConnect to start receiving SMSs* about caring for your baby.
