It was a successful day to the Management and to the staff Members at Mseleni Hospital to be trained on fire drilling. Training focused on how to use fire extinguishers. The training was led by UMkhanyakude Disaster Management under UMhlabuyalingana Local Municipality on the 5<sup>th</sup> August 2015 at Mseleni Hospital Recreation hall.



The above topic was the theme of the day and it was a great pleasure that the workshop went well, successfully and it was much productive. This is supported by some lessons that were shared to the staff to know more about types of fire and which fire extinguisher could be used for a certain fire. Staff was also taught about the protocol they should do to report such incident and what they should do immediately after disaster has happened. Fire drilling took place after the training where the staff did practical on what they had been taught.

## New improvement at High Care

There is an Emergency Peritoneal Dialysis process implemented at Mseleni High Care since May 2015. This process helps the emergency patients who suffer severe kidney failure.
