MSELENI HOSPITAL WOMEN'S DAY





On Wednesday, 13 August 2025, Mseleni Hospital ladies said "fancy outfit and fascinator "either way they came dressed to the tees ready to celebrate Women's Day, which is officially commemorated on 9 August each year. The day was filled with glam, wisdom, encouragement, and heartfelt conversations aimed at empowering women to rise above challenges and live with purpose. The programme was led with grace and so much entertainment by Mrs P. Kunene who guided the day with warmth and energy.

Dr. L.L Hobe - Nxumalo warmly welcomed everyone and shared a powerful reminder: "Lets go with authority knowing we all have something in our hands and we must use whatever is in our hands to destroy the strongholds holding us back as women." She encouraged us to look up to remarkable women such as Mary Magdalena and Esther from the Bible, whose courage, wisdom, and faith continue to inspire generations.

She also emphasized how deeply God loves us, describing Him as a good Father who cares for His daughters. She encouraged everyone to always lean on Him, walk closely with Him, and boldly ask anything of Him trusting that His heart is for us and His goodness never fails.

Ms Nxumalo took a stand to formally introduce our esteemed guests to our audience. Mrs J.S Mnguni high-lighted the importance of prioritizing our health. She cautioned against doctor shopping in search of a "better" diagnosis, reminding us that once a health concern is identified, we must take responsibility for our own well-being and follow through with the interventions recommended.

Ms Mpume Mbatha spoke candidly about relationships, urging women to be vigilant and avoid financially supporting men. She stressed the need for self-love, mutual support among women, and breaking the cycle of jealousy. "Let us lift each other up, love each other, and be there for one another," she said.

Drawing from biblical principles, Mrs Luther highlighted that God intended marriage to come before the bearing raising of children. She reflected on societal challenges, noting that a lack of discipline, rising violence, and broken family structures are often linked to absent fathers. She encouraged young women to enjoy their youth, make wise choices in selecting a life partner, and never marry simply for the sake of marriage.

Mrs Mhlongo led a touching prayer and paid tribute to the brave women who have stood for justice and equity. She reminded us that we are powerful and strong but above all, we must place our faith in God, trusting that "everything else shall be added unto us" (Matthew 6:33).


