THE QUALITY SURVEY: JUNE 2006 @ MSELENI HOSPITAL




As we have embarked a long way to cover our mysterious encounter.

The project has been extended to other parts of Mseleni Health Ward. Mnqobokazi area has been the Hospital target this year.

ORGANISING

The Social worker renders the service the organization single handedly with the help of Volunteers, some are students at

Tertiary level and student social workers which have been placed by University of Zululand and Durban WESTVILLE.

⇒**D**ental Clinic is a small Department that is responsible for oral health care of the community of Mseleni & the surrounding areas. services provided within the Institution are: Teeth extractions, Teeth fillings, Scaling & polishing, Oral health education.

⇒This department extend the service to staff establishment currently consist of one Dental Therapist & one dental assistant. Therefore the service provided has brought attention to many of the clients that oral health contribute a major part in one's general health.

⇒The service is provided within the hospital during these days: Monday, Wednesday, Thursday but Tuesday & Friday are used for clinic visit. Workers hours from 07:30am to 16h00 pm

NB: TOOTH EXTRACTION is regarded results in unnecessary loss of teeth as an emergency treatment therefore is provided immediately as one visits the clinic, unlike scaling & polishing and filing of teeth where appointment has to be made. Appointments should be made by the one needs treatment.

ARV PROGRAM: MSELENI HOSPITAL

Where we come from

The ART program was started at Mseleni Hospital on the July 19th 2004; we've just finished our second year providing the second chance to those individuals who were at the end stage of HIV/AIDS. We can basically say the program is working very well; we are keeping a "hawk" eye on the system and patients progress, with the experience that we've accumulated so far. It was a bit difficult when we started back in 2004, but now things are a lot better, we know what are the things that we should be on the lookout for, this help us render to our clients the best possible service we can afford. So far in the past two years we've managed to put on to the program a total of 1180 clients on ART program excluding those who died having started ART. Included in this total is 1068 Adults and 112 Children.

ABOUT ART:

Although the ART is not the cure to the HIV, the experience in the program has proven that people infected with HIV and have AIDS live a lot better life when they take ART accordingly than without the ART. The one very important point that one must point out is client's commitment to taking his/her medications as discussed with the health provider. Mseleni Hospital decided to take the service to the people, with the help of indepth knowledge of the community setting and economic state of the society. The ART is obtainable from all 9 clinics under the Mseleni subdistrict.
