

What it is ?

Hand, Foot and mouth disease is a viral infectious disease.

It causes blisters or sore in or around the mouth, and on the hands, feet and other body parts of the body.

It is not linked to foot– and - mouth disease that affects animals

Who is at Risk?

Hand, foot and mouth disease is common in infant and children. But it can also affect adolescents and occasionally adults

How its spreads:

- 1. Fluid from blisters
- 2. Coughs and sneezes
- 3. Stool/ faeces
- 4. Contaminated surface and objects

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How it is prevented

Avoid contact with an infected person.

Keep your hands clean and ensure children wash their hands often.

Cover your mouth and nose when you cough or sneeze.

Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.

Avoid sharing household items.

Clean and disinfect frequently touched surface and object.

Keep children home from school/daycare if they present symptoms



"If you suspect that you and your family members or child may be having autism spectrum disorder, visit your nearest healthcare facility or provider for screening and assessment to enable them to provide the necessary interventions, or refer where necessary"

In South Africa, the Road to Health Booklet or Clinic Card that is issued to all children at birth helps parents to monitor health and development of each child until the age of 5 years. This also assists I early identification and intervention when a child's development is not in line with the expected developmental milestone.

Parents are encouraged to familiarise themselves with the educational information contained in the Clinic Card.

Although, there is no cure for autism spectrum disorders, some medications are used to help people with ASD function better by treating cooccurring symptoms such as:

- higher energy levels
- Inability to focus
- Self-harming behaviour including head banging or hand biting.

Treatment can also help mange co-occurring mental health problems, such as anxiety or depression, and physical conditions such as seizures.

Symptoms of autism

Symptoms and causes of autism may differ from child to child, but some common symptoms include:

- difficulty with social interaction
- Delayed speed and language skills, repetitive behaviours.

Autism is primarily caused by nature (a genetic disorder), but the severity of autism can be influenced by nurture (environmental factors).
