## CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE JOZINI CHC STAFF SERVE BEYOND THEIR CALL OF DUTY ON SAVING PEOPLE'S LIFE

**T**he new facility Jozini CHC has proven beyond reasonable doubt to be a the center of excellence. This was confirmed by the good job done by the staff members who were on duty when a 20year old pupil was brought to the facility from one of the nearest schools after being injured. The incident happened on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of January 2019 around 09h:00 in the morning.

The young boy was fast tracked and attended at high care unit (Casualty ward). He was transferred to Ngwelezane Regional Hospital after being assessed and well managed in the facility.

Acknowledgements went to the staff members who were able to manage the patient and called the paramedic rescue helicopter on time. The team effort and interventions they made saved the patients life.

The facility is always striving for an excellence to achieve high quality service, to always prioritize the patient's needs as part of community consultation.
