People who attended the event were entertained with music, dance, poetry by African and Indian artists.

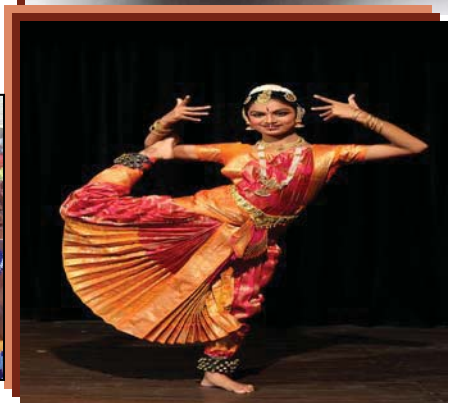
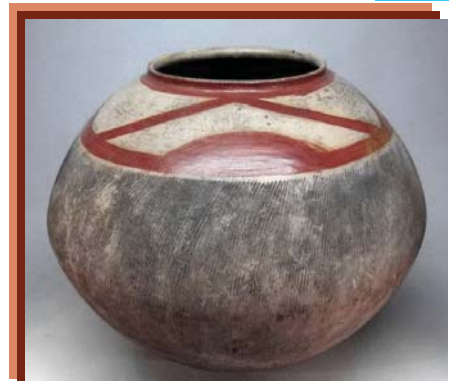
Cultural artifacts were placed outside the hall with information for people interested in learning about another culture.

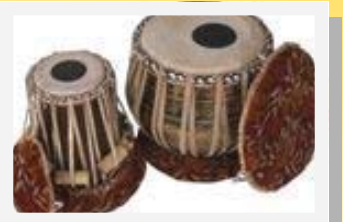
