8. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

8.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

9. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

9.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 13.2. In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.

1. Skips

- a) The service provider shall provide the following
- b) Provide 2x6 cubic meters skips on site for general waste storage; skips to permanently kept on site at waste area
- c) Provide 1x4 cubic meters skip for glass, empty paint containers and chemicals empty tins/drums skip to be collected when full or as and when required

2. Collection and disposal

- a) Waste to be collected for disposal every Monday to Saturday in the mornings
- b) Ensure that all waste is transported correctly and disposed of correctly asper waste management policies and prescripts/acts
- c) Provide a disposal certificate after waste disposal
- d) Ensure that the work area (waste bay) is cleaned after and during all collections of waste skips

3. Recycling Project

- a) Implement a Waste Recycling Project within the hospital that will reduce the amount of waste disposed
