8. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

8.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 13.2. - 5.3 All analysis reports must be issued from a laboratory which is accredited by South African National Accreditation System (SANAS) or International Laboratory Accreditation Cooperation (ILAC) or International Accreditation Forum (IAF) and should meet the pre-requisite of ISO/IEC 17025.
- 5.4 Cost of complying with all the above-mentioned requirements shall be at the bidder's own account.

6. Nutritional Analysis

- 6.1 Bidders are required to submit nutritional analysis report which as stipulated in the item specification under the list of compulsory tests for each item offered. The nutritional analysis report must include the analysed amount of each of the nutrients as stipulated in the specifications.
- 6.2 It is the responsibility of the bidder to ensure that the nutritional analyses submitted complies to the units of measure as stipulated in the specification i.e. per 100ml
- 6.3 In cases where bidders receive the nutritional analyses in units that deviate from the specification, it is the responsibility of the bidder to provide the conversions to the required units as reflected on the specification.
- 6.4 The bidder is required to submit all necessary calculations or conversion factors used to derive the given values in an excel spreadsheet. The Department will not be liable for any incorrect conversions or calculations submitted by the bidder. Any incorrect conversions or calculations may disqualify the item under consideration.

7. Microbial Analysis Report

Where applicable, a microbial analysis report as stipulated in the detailed technical specification under the list of compulsory must be submitted for each item offered.

8. Stability/Shelf-life Report

- 8.1 Stability studies report to be submitted confirming shelf life and the following:
 - i) Micronutrient stability:
 - ii) Absence of microbiological growth: at the beginning and the end of the study
 - iii) Organoleptic stability: taste, odour, product consistency and behaviour (absence of phase separation)
 - iv) Integrity of the packing materials (absence of leakage)
 - v) Integrity of markings
 - vi) The parameters used for the stability study
- 8.2 The results preferably presented in the form of a summary table, with the specifications (acceptance criteria) for at least all parameters listed above. Numerical values of results must be stated, the word "complies" or "conforms" will not be acceptable in place of numerical values;
- 8.3 The details on the laboratory(ies) used and it (their) accreditation, and the test methods shall appear.
- 8.4 The conclusion (or temporary conclusion) based on the obtained results, including the justification for the shelf life and recommended storage conditions.

9. Samples submitted for visual screening

9.1 Bidders must submit samples for the purpose of visual screening evaluation for items offered to verify compliance to specification during the evaluation phase. Noncompliance with this requirement will invalidate the bid for the item which samples is not submitted.

10. Packaging

The ready to use infant formula must have a screw cap or pull tab for sterility and ease of pouring and resalable or closure after initial opening.

The following information must be clearly and indelible printed on the product and outer packaging: -

Name of the product

A product code as relevant

The trade name or trademark of the manufacturer

Size of the product

Quantity of the contents

Name of the manufacturer

Date of manufacture

Name and address of importer/distributor

Best before date

Batch/Lot number. Products must have the same batch/Lot number on the outer box as on the inner box

Labels and inserts

The following information must be clearly and indelibly printed on all packaging.

Brand name

Nett Mass of Container

Best before date

Batch number

The conditions under which the product must be stored.

The labels accompanying leaflets and or other labelling of the products should provide sufficient information on the nature and purpose of the feed as well as detailed instructions and precautions for their use.

The declaration of nutrient content shall be numerical.

A statement that the product is not to be used for parental administration should be clearly visible.

The labelling should align with the Foodstuffs, cosmetics and Disinfectants Act (54/1972): regulations relating to foodstuffs for infants and young children as described in Regulation 2 & 3 thereof.

11. Shelf life

Upon delivery, the product must have at least 6 months before the date of best before date.

Suppliers may make written applications to the purchasing institution to deliver goods with a shorter shelf life, provided such applications are accompanied by an undertaking that unused short-dated stock shall be unconditionally replaced before or after expiry date/best before date.

Any delivery of short dated supplies without prior written approval must be collected by the respective supplier at their own cost.
