SPECIFICATION FOR WATER TREATMENT - CHEMICALS AND SERVICE

SCOPE OF CONTRACT

This specification calls for Water Treatment – Chemicals and Service at R.K. Khan Hospital for a contract period of 2 year (24 month).

2. DETAILED SPECIFICATION

2.1. BOILERS CHEMICALS

- **2.1.1.** Chemicals are required for prevention of scale and corrosion in the boilers. This must be sufficient to also protect the boiler on standby.
- **2.1.2.** The boiler chemical must be organic-based alkali compound no mineral chemicals which add to the dissolved solids of the feed water should be allowed.

EQUIPMENT

2.1.3. The water softener and chemical dosing plant must be serviced and maintained at no extra cost. Ion exchange resin for the water softening plant is to be supplied when necessary at no extra cost.

2.2. AIR CONDITIONING COOLING SYSTEMS

CHEMICALS

- **2.2.1.** Chemicals are required for control of scale, corrosion and biological fouling at Cooling Towers (x2) and chilled water plant system.
- 2.2.2. The scale and corrosion control chemical should be zinc-based.
- **2.2.3.** The biocide program shall use alternating biocides to prevent proliferation of resistant strains, and one of the biocides must specifically target Legionionella Pneumophilla. Water testing targeting these effects must be undertaken on a quarterly basis accompanied by reports.
- **2.2.4.** Allowances must be made for monitoring of corrosion via corrosion coupons and bacteria growth via dip slides every three months.

EQUIPMENT

2.2.5. All existing equipment is to be adjusted, serviced and maintained, as required, at no extra cost.

2.3. AUTOCLAVES

CHEMICALS

- **2.3.1.** Chemicals are required for prevention of scale and corrosion in the boilers. This must be sufficient to also protect the boiler on standby.
- **2.3.2.** The boiler chemical must be organic-based no mineral chemicals which add to the dissolved solids of the feed water should be allowed.

EQUIPMENT

2.3.3. The water softener and chemical dosing plant must be serviced and maintained at no extra cost. Ion exchange resin for the water softening plant is to be supplied when necessary at no extra cost.

2.4.2. SCHEDULE OF WORK:

Inspect water tanks and Monitor water quality on a monthly basis. Water testing must be undertaken on a quarterly basis accompanied by reports.

2.5. SERVICE

- **2.5.1.** Monthly service visits are required with a comprehensive on-site analysis of all treated water with written reports.
- 2.5.2. Contractors to complete the attached checklists as recommended.
- **2.5.3.** Biocides must be hand dosed on a monthly basis, to each cooling tower, after samples are drawn for analysis and suspended solids flushed via the cooling tower drain valves.
- **2.5.4.** Cooling tower tubes are to be checked monthly, where possible, to monitor any scale and corrosion. Evidence to be provided with completed checklists.

- **2.5.5.** Filter cartridges for boiler softening plant, and all cooling towers are to be monitored on a monthly basis, and replaced, with stock to be kept by the hospital, when necessary.
- **2.5.6.** There is to be **no handling of chemicals by hospital staff**, all chemical handling will be carried out by the supplier on a monthly service visit.
- **2.5.7.** It is envisaged a minimum of three hour per visit will be required to perform this service, and the suppliers representative must report to the Maintenance Supervisor before commencing work and present written reports on completion.

WARRANTY

- 3.1. Any scaling of any system as a result of the suppliers failure to supply and apply his chemicals correctly, and to maintain dosing and control equipment, must be removed by the supplier at his expense.
- CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT
- **3.1.** Contractors are advised to visit the site prior to submitting of quotes.
- 3.2. All waste materials are to be removed from site as it accumulates.
- 3.3. All necessary safety precautions are to be observed.
- **3.4.** Storage of all materials and tools will be at contractor's risk.
- 3.5. The duration of the job is to be 2 weeks from the date of the official order.
- **3.6.** All material used is to be SABS approved.
- 3.7. All works carried out is to be to the entire satisfaction of the Hospital Manager or his appointed representative.
- **3.8.** Contractors are advised to provide professional tradesmen.
- 3.9. Only Contractors registered on the Department of Health KZN database will be considered.
- **3.10.** Only contractors from within the borough of Durban will be considered.
- **3.11.** The service provider representative and employees are required to report to the Maintenance Manager, upon arrival and prior to departure from the Institution.
- **3.12.** Quotations are to be deposited at the Main Entrance, Security.

SPECIAL CONTRACT CONDITIONS OF QUOTATIONS

1. AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

1.1. Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS

2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- 3.2. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.3. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote:
 - (i) that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
- 3.4. The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfilment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfilment of this contract.
- This quotation will be evaluated based on the 80/20 points system, specification & correctness of information. All required documentation must be completed in full and submitted.
- 3.6. Offers must comply strictly with the specification.
- 3.7. Only offers that meet or are greater than the specification will be considered.
- 3.8. Late quotes will not be considered.
- 3.9. Expired product/s will not be accepted. All products supplied must be valid for a minimum period of six months.
- 3.10. A bidder not registered on the Central Suppliers Database or verification has failed will not be considered.
- 3.11. All delivery costs must be included in the quote price, for delivery at the prescribed destination.
- 3.12. Only firm prices will be accepted. Such prices must remain firm for the contract period. Non-firm prices (including rates of exchange variations) will not be considered.
- 3.13. In cases where different delivery points influence the pricing, a separate pricing schedule must be submitted for each delivery point.
- 3.14. In the event of a bidder having multiple quotes, only the cheapest according to specification will be considered. Furthermore a verification will be done to identify if bidders have multiple companies and are quoting (cover-quoting) for this bid. In such instances only the cheapest bid according to specification will be considered.

4. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS AND NOTICES TO BIDDERS REGARDING THE COMPLETION OF THIS QUOTATION.

- 4.1. Unless inconsistent with or expressly indicated otherwise by the context, the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and with words importing the masculine gender shall include the feminine and the neuter.
- 4.2. Under no circumstances whatsoever may the quotation/bid forms be retyped or redrafted. Photocopies of the original bid documentation may be used, but an original signature must appear on such photocopies.
- 4.3. The bidder is advised to check the number of pages and to satisfy himself that none are missing or duplicated.
- 4.4. Quotation submitted must be complete in all respects.
- 4.5. Any alteration made by the bidder must be initialled.
- 4.6. Use of correcting fluid is prohibited
- 4.7. Quotation will be opened in public as soon as practicable after the closing time of quotation.
- 4.8. Where practical, prices are made public at the time of opening quotations.
- 4.9. If it is desired to make more than one offer against any individual item, such offers should be given on a photocopy of the page in question. Clear indication thereof must be stated on the schedules attached.

5. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING HAND DELIVERED QUOTATIONS

- 5.1. Quotation shall be lodged at the address indicated not later than the closing time specified for their receipt, and in accordance with the directives in the guotation documents.
- 5.2. Each quotation shall be addressed in accordance with the directives in the quotation documents and shall be lodged in a separate sealed envelope, with the name and address of the bidder, the quotation number and closing date indicated on the envelope. The envelope shall not contain documents relating to any quotation other than that shown on the envelope. If this provision is not complied with, such quotations/bids may be rejected as being invalid.
- 5.3. All quotations received in sealed envelopes with the relevant quotation numbers on the envelopes are kept unopened in safe custody until the closing time of the quotation/bids. Where, however, a quotation is received open, it shall be sealed. If it is received without a quotation/bid number on the envelope, it shall be opened, the quotation number ascertained, the envelope sealed and the quotation number written on the envelope.
- 5.4. A specific box is provided for the receipt of quotations, and no quotation found in any other box or elsewhere subsequent to the closing date and time of quotation will be considered.

13. PENALTIES

- 13.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 13.2. In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- 13.3. Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract. In the event that the contract is terminated the institution may claim damages from the service provider in the form of a penalty. The service provider's performance should be captured on the service provider database in order to determine whether or not the service provider should be awarded any contracts in the future.
- 13.4. If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated on the delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day of the delay until actual delivery or performance.

14. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

- 14.1. The purchaser, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, may terminate this contract in whole or in part:
- (i) if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods within the period(s) specified in the contract,
- (ii) if the supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract; or
- (iii) if the supplier, in the judgment of the purchaser, has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract.
- 14.2. In the event the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate, goods, works or services similar to those undelivered, and the supplier shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs for such similar goods, works or services.
- 14.3. Where the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may decide to impose a restriction penalty on the supplier by prohibiting such supplier from doing business with the public sector for a period not exceeding 10 years.
- 15. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ABOVE WILL RESULT IN YOUR QUOTE BEING PASSED OVER.
