Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties.

2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (dominitium citendi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.
