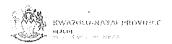

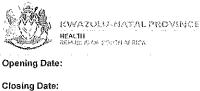

SPECIAL CONTRACT CONDITIONS OF QUOTATIONS

1. AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

1.1. Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties.

2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- 3.2. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.3. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote:
 - (i) that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
- 3.4. The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfilment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfilment of this contract.
- 3.5. This quotation will be evaluated based on the 80/20 points system, specification & correctness of information. All required documentation must be completed in full and submitted.
- 3.6. Offers must comply strictly with the specification.
- 3.7. Only offers that meet or are greater than the specification will be considered.
- 3.8. Late quotes will not be considered.
- 3.9. Expired product/s will not be accepted. All products supplied must be valid for a minimum period of six months.
- 3.10. A bidder not registered on the Central Suppliers Database or verification has failed will not be considered.
- 3.11. All delivery costs must be included in the quote price, for delivery at the prescribed destination.
- 3.12. Only firm prices will be accepted. Such prices must remain firm for the contract period. Non-firm prices (including rates of exchange variations) will not be considered.
- 3.13. In cases where different delivery points influence the pricing, a separate pricing schedule must be submitted for each delivery point.
- 3.14. In the event of a bidder having multiple quotes, only the cheapest according to specification will be considered. Furthermore a verification will be done to identify if bidders have multiple companies and are quoting (cover-quoting) for this bid, in such instances only the cheapest bid according to specification will be considered.

4. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS AND NOTICES TO BIDDERS REGARDING THE COMPLETION OF THIS QUOTATION.

- 4.1. Unless inconsistent with or expressly indicated otherwise by the context, the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and with words importing the masculine gender shall include the feminine and the neuter.
- 4.2. Under no circumstances whatsoever may the quotation/bid forms be retyped or redrafted. Photocopies of the original bid documentation may be used, but an original signature must appear on such photocopies.
- 4.3. The bidder is advised to check the number of pages and to satisfy himself that none are missing or duplicated.
- 4.4. Quotation submitted must be complete in all respects.
- 4.5. Any alteration made by the bidder must be initialled.
- 4.6. Use of correcting fluid is prohibited
- 4.7. Quotation will be opened in public as soon as practicable after the closing time of quotation.
- 4.8. Where practical, prices are made public at the time of opening quotations.
- 4.9. If it is desired to make more than one offer against any individual item, such offers should be given on a photocopy of the page in question. Clear indication thereof must be stated on the schedules attached.

5. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING HAND DELIVERED QUOTATIONS

- 5.1. Quotation shall be lodged at the address indicated not later than the closing time specified for their receipt, and in accordance with the directives in the quotation documents.
- 5.2. Each quotation shall be addressed in accordance with the directives in the quotation documents and shall be lodged in a separate sealed envelope, with the name and address of the bidder, the quotation number and closing date indicated on the envelope. The envelope shall not contain documents relating to any quotation other than that shown on the envelope. If this provision is not complied with, such quotations/bids may be rejected as being invalid.
- 5.3. All quotations received in sealed envelopes with the relevant quotation numbers on the envelopes are kept unopened in safe custody until the closing time of the quotation/bids. Where, however, a quotation is received open, it shall be sealed. If it is received without a quotation/bid number on the envelope, it shall be opened, the quotation number ascertained, the envelope sealed and the quotation number written on the envelope.
- 5.4. A specific box is provided for the receipt of quotations, and no quotation found in any other box or elsewhere subsequent to the closing date and time of quotation will be considered.

- 5.5. No quotation/bid sent through the post will be considered if it is received after the closing date and time stipulated in the quotation documentation, and proof of posting will not be accepted as proof of delivery.
- 5.6. Quotation documents must not be included in packages containing samples. Such quotations may be rejected as being invalid.

6. SAMPLES

- 6.1. In the case of the quote document stipulating that samples are required, the supplier will be informed in due course when samples should be provided to the institution. (This decreases the time of safety and storage risk that may be incurred by the respective institution). The bidders sample will be retained if such bidder wins the contract.
- (i) If a company/s who has not won the quote requires their samples, they must advise the institution in writing of such.
- (ii) If samples are not collected within three months of close of quote the institution reserves the right to dispose of them at their discretion.
- 6.2. Samples must be made available when requested in writing or if stipulated on the document.

8. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

8.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

9. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

9.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

10. TAX COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 10.1. In the event that the tax compliance status has failed on CSD, it is the suppliers' responsibility to provide a SARS pin in order for the institution to validate the tax compliance status of the supplier.
- 10.2. In the event that the institution cannot validate the suppliers' tax clearance on SARS as well as the Central Suppliers Database, the quote will not be considered and passed over as non-compliant according to National Treasury Instruction Note 4 (a) 2016/17.

11. TAX INVOICE

- 11.1. A tax invoice shall be in the currency of the Republic of South Africa and shall contain the following particulars:
- (i) the name, address and registration number of the supplier;
- (ii) the name and address of the recipient;
- (iii) an individual serialized number and the date upon which the tax invoice is issued;
- (iv) a description and quantity or volume of the goods or services supplied;
- (v) the official department order number issued to the supplier;
- (vi) the value of the supply, the amount of tax charged;
- (vii) the words tax invoice in a prominent place.

12. PATENT RIGHTS

The supplier shall indemnify the KZN Department of Health (hear after known as the purchaser) against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the goods or any part thereof by the purchaser.

13. PENALTIES

- 13.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 13.2. In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- 13.3. Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract. In the event that the contract is terminated the institution may claim damages from the service provider in the form of a penalty. The service provider's performance should be captured on the service provider database in order to determine whether or not the service provider should be awarded any contracts in the future.
- 13.4. If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated on the delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day of the delay until actual delivery or performance.

14. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

- 14.1. The purchaser, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, may terminate this contract in whole or in part:
- if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods within the period(s) specified in the contract,
- (ii) If the supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract; or
- (iii) if the supplier, in the judgment of the purchaser, has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract.
- 14.2. In the event the purchaser terminates the contract in whote or in part, the purchaser may procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate, goods, works or services similar to those undelivered, and the supplier shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs for such similar goods, works or services.
- 14.3. Where the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may decide to impose a restriction penalty on the supplier by prohibiting such supplier from doing business with the public sector for a period not exceeding 10 years.

SPECIFICATION FOR PEST CONTROL SERVICES - UMZIMKHULU HOSPITAL

1. INSTITUTION / AREA

The Pest control service contract is for the eradication and control of pest vermin (rats, mice and cockroaches) in the institution as whole includes wards, offices, nurses home, store rooms, laundry, main kitchen and main stores, Manzini Village Residence and replace the bait station that are existing in the hospital.

2. SERVICE PERIOD

A full treatment of all institutional sections / Departments shall be carried out as indicated on the service schedules.

3. RE - INFESTATION

If, in – between the services re – infestation if any type of pest becomes apparent, the contractor shall provide for a re – service in the specified infested araes at no cost to the administration and the complete satisfaction of the administration.

4. SERVICE HOURS

All services must be carried out during normal institution working hours and with the least possible inconvenience to the institutional staff and care users.

5. SERVICE PROCEDURE

Contractors to report to the infection control practitioner / maintenance section of Umzimkulu Hospital for a appointment.

Such service date appointment will be made at least 7 working days prior to the actual proposed service date.

It is advisable that the schedule of service dates be complied by the service contractor and handed to Infection Control Practitioner for proper arrangement within the institutional sections.

On arrival at the institution on the date of service, the contractor must first report to the Infection control practitioner to sign in the register.

On completion of the service the contractor must sign out from the register.

After all the specified servicing has been completed and the schedule has been signed by Infection control of the institution, the contractors to sign and affix the company stamp to original tax invoice which must be addressed to UMzimkhulu Hospital, Private Bag X 514, UMZIMKULU, 3297 Failure to comply with the institution pertaining to the schedule could result in payment being withheld.

6. CONTRACTED PERIOD

The contract resulting from the acceptance of the successful contractor's document by the institution shall be valid for the period of (12) Twelf months, calculated from the date of official site hand over and acceptante.

7. REQUIREMENTS

- A certificate for Pest Control fumigation
- At least one year proof experience in one of the companies or institution that you worked with.

8. CONTRACTORS CANCELLATION

The administration reserve the right to cancel the contract by means of (1) one calender month written notice should the contractor not carry out the service properlyor comply fully with the conditions of the contract to complete service in the satisfactory of infection control and hospital.

9. ASSIGN CONTRACT

The successful contract shal not assign this contract or this sub – let any portion of the contract to any other company, firm or person without the written authority of UMZIMKULU HOSPITAL DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH KZN.

This contract shall also be automatically cancellled should the successful contractor undergo any change in ownership.

10. CONTRACT INSURANCE

This contract agreement shall not be contrued as a contract of insurance.

11. CHEMICAL TO BE USED AND HANDLING

- (a) Super Crackdown
- (b) Max force
- (c) Any other proven gel

These are the chemicals to be used, super crackdown to be used in main holes and drains max force to be used in cockroached and the proven gel to be used in electrical distribution board, switches and plugs.

Application, storage and handling of pest contol chemicals and or gel shall be carried out in accordance to SABS code of practice.

12. PAYMENTS

Payement shal be made after each service has been successfully completed and the relevant documents have been submitted.

13. GENERAL SERVICE PROCEDURES

- 13.1. Every room, ward, department in the institution is to be treated with one of the approved chemical and gel.
- 13.2. All storage rooms which contain stores of foodstuff shall be treated with redent bait.
- 13.3. All built in cupboard will be treated internally and externally.

- 13.4. All basement areas including plant rooms and storage rooms will also be treated with rodent bait station.
- 13.5. All sewerage and storm water manholes within the institution complex to be opened and the interior of the manholes treated with crackdown or similar gel every (3) three months period :

NOTE: The contractor is to be possession of his own manhole opening tools or devices.

- 13.6. All out building will be treated as per specification.
- 13.7. Should the contractor experience any problems withthe staff or patients in the wards, departments while rendering the service, the matter is to be reported to the officer in charge immediately so that the necessary actions be taken to rectify the problems.
- 13.8. Request by [atients or staf within the institution not to carry out the service in any specific area or room within the complex is to be communicated with the infection controller practitioner of UMZIMKULU HOSPITAL.

Any extra work carried without authority from the infection controller practitioner of Umzimkulu Hospital will be to the account of the contractor.

NB: shouls the contractor discover any illegal animal on the site which could direct cause The infestation of pest or vermin then the matter must be immediately reported to the infection controller practitioner of umzimkulu Hospital this report shall not include household pest such As dogs, cages birds.

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
