SCOPE OF CONTRACT

The contract calls for the supply and installation of an awning structure over the Gateway clinic waiting area and concreting of waiting area verge.


2. DETAILED SPECIFICATION

Concrete Waiting Area Floor"


- 2.1. The area to be concreted is approximately 87m².
- 2.1.1. Concrete shall be a minimum of 200mm in thickness at 25mpa concrete strength.
- 2.1.2. Remove vegetation and grass and top soil off site and allow for soil poisoning (certificate to be provided)
- 2.1.3. Allow to compact soil prior to laying welded mesh steel.
- 2.1.4. Supply and install Ref 193 steel welded mesh to concrete slab spaced approximately 50% above excavated ground.
- 2.1.5. The concrete slab shall be laid in 4 equal sections with expansion joints.
- 2.1.6. Allow to vibrate and render concrete to slab to a smooth trowel finish and to falls to prevent water pooling.

Awning Installation:

- 2.2. Area 1 Gateway Clinic = approximately 174 m².
- 2.2.1. The awning structure consists of 2 sections which over lap at different heights
- 2.2.2. The existing corroded awning structure shall be stripped and discarded off site by the contractor.
- 2.2.3. The new roof sheeting shall be Zinc-aluminium sheeting industrial 0.58mm 'Klip Lock 700 or Craftlock (green in colour-colour facing upwards).
- 2.2.4. All roof supporting cross-members shall be galvanized steel lip channelled a minimum of 150mm (height) x 50mm (width) x 2mm (thickness),.
- 2.2.5. All upright post supports shall be minimum galvanized 100mm round or square posts.
- 2.2.6. All posts must be fixed in minimum 300mm (w) x 300mm(l) x 500mm (depth) concrete.
- 2.2.7. Gutters shall be extruded aluminium epoxy coated type with 110mm PVC down pipes discharging into the existing storm water drains.
- 2.2.8. The gutters are to be fixed to the galvanized cross members and not to the roof sheeting
- 2.2.9. All sheeting sections, where fixed against building walls, must be properly waterproofed to prevent any leaks.
- 2.2.10. Method of fixing shall be galvanized rubber cupped screws and galvanized bolts and nuts.
- 2.2.11. Additional cladding sheets to existing awning= 30m2 (12.25 metre-width x 2.4 metre-height)
- **2.2.12.** Sheeting specifications- Corrugated Polycarbonate sheets with 99.9% UV resistant, 90% light transmission and self-extinguishing.
- 2.3. Area 2- Thusong Clinic = $40m^2$ (8 metres x 5 metres)
- 2.3.1. Technical Specifications as per point 2.2.
- 2.3.2. Additional cladding sheets to existing awning= 22m² (14.6 metre-width x 1.5 metre-height)
- **2.3.2.1.** Sheeting specifications- Corrugated Polycarbonate sheets with 99.9% UV resistant, 90% light transmission and self-extinguishing.
- **2.3.2.2.** The sheeting shall be fixed with galvanized cup screws to 40mm galvanized square tubing cross members. Galvanized cross members must be supplied and fitted by the contractor.






Gateway Clinic Part two

AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties. 1.1.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS

Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote. 3.1.

The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all 3.2. quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.

The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote: 3.3.

8. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

8.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

9. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

9.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

10. TAX COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 10.1. In the event that the tax compliance status has failed on CSD, it is the suppliers' responsibility to provide a SARS pin in order for the institution to validate the tax compliance status of the supplier.

12. PATENT RIGHTS

The supplier shall indemnify the KZN Department of Health (hear after known as the purchaser) against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the goods or any part thereof by the purchaser.

13. PENALTIES

- 13.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 13.2. In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- 13.3. Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract. In the event that the contract is terminated the institution may claim damages from the service provider in the form of a penalty. The service provider's performance should be captured on the service provider database in order to determine whether or not the service provider should be awarded any contracts in the future.
- 13.4. If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated on the delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day of the delay until actual delivery or performance.

14. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

- 14.1. The purchaser, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, may terminate this contract in whole or in part:
- (i) if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods within the period(s) specified in the contract,
- (ii) if the supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract; or
- (iii) if the supplier, in the judgment of the purchaser, has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract.
- 14.2. In the event the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate, goods, works or services similar to those undelivered, and the supplier shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs for such similar goods, works or services.
- 14.3. Where the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may decide to impose a restriction penalty on the supplier by prohibiting such supplier from doing business with the public sector for a period not exceeding 10 years.
