SCOPE OF WORK

The work to be carried out under this contract includes a ten months period contract for the collection and removal of general waste and to supply a waste skip from Monday to Friday (including public holidays). Service provider must leave the area in a suitable condition to the satisfaction of the secretary for the department. The area should be left neat and tidy.

General waste is the non-hazardous waste from health facilities that includes same waste as domestic waste. It is generated during the administrative and housekeeping functions of public health care establishments as well as from patients and visitors, and it includes the following types of waste:

- Office waste: includes packing materials, cardboard boxes and plastic bags
- · Kitchen waste: packing material.

1.1. The work comprises of

- 1.1.1 4X 4m³ / 16m³ skips with lid / tarpaulin to be supplied and placed in the designated waste skip area.
- 1.1.2 Waste should be collected daily including public holidays or as agreed with the institution/health facility.
- 1.1.3 Driver of the waste removal truck must report to Maintenance Department/ waste Management officer to sign the Waste Management Book (the waste collection document must consist of three copies, one copy to be left in the institution, one copy to be taken by the driver.
- 1.1.4. A third copy to be serving as disposal certificate produced together with the monthly invoices.
- 1.1.5. Skip bins to be washed by service provider every three months.
- 1.1.6 The service provider must keep records of all work done in terms of time, cost, quantity and these must be submitted on monthly basis with the invoice to the relevant health facilities.
- 1.1.7 All vehicles, equipment, human resources and other applicable tools of trade to be supplied by service provider

1.1.8 All material used to clean waste skips must be in accordance with the relevant SABS standards as applicable

The minimum standards for skip bins are as follows:

- I. The specifications of the skip container must be in compliance with the SANS standards
- II. Rigid and durable
- III. Corrosion resistant and easily cleanable

2. TRANSPORTATION:

- 2.1 The service provider must provide adequate transportation of this waste stream for proper disposal. Such transportation must be licensed, registered and compliant with all relevant legislations governing transportation of general waste.
- Any service provider who transports waste, needs to adhere to the stipulations within the National Road Traffic Act No. 93 of 1996 and any other appropriate road transport legislation currently in place. This Act pertains to the fact that all vehicles should be in a fully roadworthy condition and should have an up-to-date license registration. In addition, the driver of the vehicle must be fully licensed and permitted as a minimum standard. An added benefit would be advanced training in driving techniques.
- 2.3. The Service provider must be on data base with a registered land fill site.
- Vehicles transporting waste must be appropriate for the type of waste transported and should be of adequate size and construction for the waste type.
- 2.5 Vehicles should not be overloaded and should only be loaded to an acceptable height.
- 2.6 The service provider's name and telephone number shall be printed or painted in legible letters on the vehicle
- 2.7 All vehicles and equipment shall be maintained at all times in a manner to prevent unnecessary noise, oil leakages, etc. during its operation
- Waste collection vehicles shall be fitted with safety devices, including, but not limited to, the following:
 - (a) Flashing warning lights and chevrons, and shall have headlights switched on during waste collection operations;
 - (b) Easily accessible first aid equipment and fire extinguisher; and
 - (c) Audible reverse warning device.
- 2.9 Waste transported must be covered with adequate covers such as tarpaulins or netting, or sealed to prevent the waste from falling off or blowing off vehicles whilst in transit. If nets are to be used, the aperture size must be smaller than the waste particle size to prevent the waste

escaping through the net, and shall be no greater than 150mm x 150mm. The net or cover must be properly fastened to the vehicle or waste container.

- 2.10 Precautions shall be taken to prevent spillage or leakage during transportation from all vehicles used to collect and/or transport municipal solid wastes that produce leachate.
- 2.11 Any waste spillage that occurs during the collection and transport of waste must be cleaned up immediately. No transportation may continue should waste be observed to be falling out of the transportation vehicle, but driver must stop and secure waste to prevent waste spillage.
- 2.12 Vehicles used for collection and transportation of waste shall be cleaned frequently to prevent nuisances arising such as odour or insect breeding.
- 2.13 All waste collectors and transporters must be registered with their local authority.

6. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

6.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

7. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1
