1. AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

1.1. Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS

2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- 3.2. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.3. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote:
 - (i) that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
- 3.4. The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfilment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfilment of this contract.
- 3.5. This quotation will be evaluated based on the 80/20 points system, specification & correctness of information. All required documentation must be completed in full and submitted.
- 3.6. Offers must comply strictly with the specification.
- 3.7. Only offers that meet or are greater than the specification will be considered.
- 3.8. Late quotes will not be considered.
- 3.9. Expired product/s will not be accepted. All products supplied must be valid for a minimum period of six months.
- 3.10. A bidder not registered on the Central Suppliers Database or verification has failed will not be considered.
- 3.11. All delivery costs must be included in the quote price, for delivery at the prescribed destination.
- 3.12. Only firm prices will be accepted. Such prices must remain firm for the contract period. Non-firm prices (including rates of exchange variations) will not be considered.
- 3.13. In cases where different delivery points influence the pricing, a separate pricing schedule must be submitted for each delivery point.
- 3.14. In the event of a bidder having multiple quotes, only the cheapest according to specification will be considered. Furthermore a verification will be done to identify if bidders have multiple companies and are quoting (cover-quoting) for this bid. In such instances only the cheapest bid according to specification will be considered.

4. SAMPLES

- 4.1. In the case of the quote document stipulating that samples are required, the supplier will be informed in due course when samples should be provided to the institution. (This decreases the time of safety and storage risk that may be incurred by the respective institution). The bidders sample will be retained if such bidder wins the contract.
- (i) If a company/s who has not won the quote requires their samples, they must advise the institution in writing of such.
- (ii) If samples are not collected within three months of close of quote the institution reserves the right to dispose of them at their discretion.
- 4.2. Samples must be made available when requested in writing or if stipulated on the document.

6. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

6.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

7. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

7.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

8. TAX COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 8.1. In the event that the tax compliance status has failed on CSD, it is the suppliers' responsibility to provide a SARS pin in order for the institution to validate the tax compliance status of the supplier.
- 8.2. In the event that the institution cannot validate the suppliers' tax clearance on SARS as well as the Central Suppliers Database, the quote will not be considered and passed over as non-compliant according to National Treasury Instruction Note 4 (a) 2016/17.

9. TAX INVOICE

- 9.1. A tax invoice shall be in the currency of the Republic of South Africa and shall contain the following particulars:
- (i) the name, address and registration number of the supplier;
- (ii) the name and address of the recipient;
- (iii) an individual serialized number and the date upon which the tax invoice is issued;
- (iv) a description and quantity or volume of the goods or services supplied;
- (v) the official department order number issued to the supplier;
- (vi) the value of the supply, the amount of tax charged;
- (vii) the words tax invoice in a prominent place.

10. PATENT RIGHTS

10.1. The supplier shall indemnify the KZN Department of Health (hear after known as the purchaser) against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the goods or any part thereof by the purchaser.

11. PENALTIES

11.1. if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated on the delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day of the delay until actual delivery or performance. The purchaser may also consider termination of the contract.

12. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

- 12.1. The purchaser, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, may terminate this contract in whole or in part:
- (i) if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods within the period(s) specified in the contract,
- (ii) if the supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract; or
- (iii) if the supplier, in the judgment of the purchaser, has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract.
- 12.2. In the event the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate, goods, works or services similar to those undelivered, and the supplier shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs for such similar goods, works or services.
- 12.3. Where the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may decide to impose a restriction penalty on the supplier by prohibiting such supplier from doing business with the public sector for a period not exceeding 10 years.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

Clause T1

The units being tendered on are intended for small-scale (300mls - 750mls), simplified, semi-automatic, self-contained pasteurisation of human milk at human milk banks located in various healthcare facilities in KwaZulu-Natal. The process of pasteurisation must be the High Temperature, Short Time (HTST) thermal method.

BIDDER'S COMMENT

Clause T2

The unit is to be modular with the following components:

- a. Pasteurisation control unit with user interface
- Temperature probe
- c. Heat source / Induction Stove
- d. Pasteurisation pot
- e. Cooling water basin
- Pasteurisation frame f.
- Printer a.
- h. Pasteurisation containers/bottles

Clause T3 Pasteurization System

Clause T3.1 Pasteurization Dimensions

The entire pasteurisation unit should be mobile and require a workspace area of not more than 1000 mm x 600 mm, so it can be placed in a milk kitchen or CSSD as is appropriate to the end user. It must be constructed of durable and robust material that can hygienically maintained.

Clause T3.2 Pasteurization Control Unit

The pasteurization cycle must be semi-automatic with two phases (heating and cooling) lasting approximately 20 minutes in total (dependant on baseline temperature of water supply).

Clause T3.2.1 Heating phase

The control unit must

- a. Heat the control container contents to at least 72°C using an external heat source;
- b. Have a visual and auditory alarm that alerts the user when the minimum required temperature is achieved;
- c. Hold the temperature for between 15 20 seconds;
- d. Have an alarm and prompt for the user to move to the cooling phase.

Clause T3.2.2 Cooling phase

The control unit must

- a. Prompt the user to initiate the cooling phase;
- b. Monitor the temperature of the control container contents;
- c. Have an audio-visual alarm that sounds when the temperature reaches 25°C.

Clause T3.2.3 Quality control

The control unit must have the capability to

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 a. Record the milk temperature in a control container (bottle) using a probe. (Note: Recording of bath temperature only, is not acceptable);

b. Allow the user to access the temperature curve after each pasteurization cycle;

c. Include process verification by means of a Temperature Logger function for the temperature probe (-10°C to +85°C) and / or software for downloading to a PC;

d. Save the temperature curve of each pasteurisation cycle sequentially for an indefinite period;

e. Generate a data file that is compatible with common data processing software such as Microsoft Excel.

Clause T3.3 User Interface

Clause T3.3.1

The unit must

 Have a data entry interface to allow the user to input alpha-numeric data including donor identification and dates;

b. Enable the user to interact with the unit and control the pasteurisation process;

c. Provide prompts to the user for timeous actions to facilitate the pasteurisation process;

d. Ensure that data entry precedes the programmed pasteurisation cycle.

Clause T3.3.2

There must be a LCD display and touch screen that has a minimum size of 3.5" (8.9cm) to allow easy viewing.

Clause T3.4 Pasteurization System Capacity

The pasteuriser must have a capacity to pasteurise between 300mls and 750mls of human milk in multiple containers as well as the contents of a control container.

Clause T3.5 Temperature Probe

The temperature probe must

a. Be made from durable heat stable material;

- b. Measure within a range from -10°C to +85°C with an accuracy of ±0.5°C;
- c. Be calibrated according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Clause T 3.6 Heat Source / Induction Stove

The external heat source must

- a. Be portable;
- b. Be in the nature of a heat plate (an immersion heater is not acceptable);
- c. Fit within the overall footprint of the unit;
- d. Have a rated Voltage: AC 220V,50 Hz;
- e. Have a maximum Power: 2000W.

Clause T3.7 Pasteurization Pot

The unit must include a pasteurisation pot / receptacle for heating that is made of a heat stable material and is compatible with the induction stove. It must have the minimum dimensions to accommodate the pasteurisation frame and human milk containers (including the control container and temperature probe).

Clause T3.8 Cooling Basin

Clause T3.8.1

A cooling basin made from stainless steel with the minimum dimensions that can accommodate the pasteurisation frame, human milk containers, water and ice packs, (or alternative suitable cooling mechanism.)

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Clause T3.8.2

If the mechanism used is ice packs – the size of these is to be recorded below. If a mechanism other than ice packs is used, this must be described in detail below.

Clause T3.9 Pasteurization Frame

The unit must include a water and heat resistant Pasteurisation frame that

- a. Allows the pasteurisation containers (bottles) to be held in suspension during pasteurisation;
- b. Has a heat resistant handle that allows for movement between heat and cooling pots / basins.

Clause T3.10 Label and pasteurization log Printer

Clause T3.10.1

The pasteurisation unit must include a printer linked to the control unit via Bluetooth or cable that is capable of printing both container labels and temperature curves

Clause T3.10.2

The printer labels must have the following features

- a. The appropriate size to fit on the pasteurization containers
- b. Water/moisture safe and resistant to degradation in cold storage and high temperatures.

Clause T3.10.3

The unit must come supplied with a pack of 100 labels and the cost of future packs must be included in the schedule of consumables at the end of the specification.

Clause T3.11 Pasteurization Containers / Bottles

Clause T3.11.1

The unit must make use of containers or bottles suitable for holding human milk. The containers are to be glass or BPA-free plastic containers with seals (lids) to seal the container to limit risk of water contamination.

Clause T3.11.2

The unit must be supplied with a minimum of 50 containers (bottles) and seals (lids). The cost of future purchases of the containers and seals must be included in the schedule of accessories at the end of the specification.

Clause T4

Any other item not included above, but required to make the unit function to its full capacity must be included and the details described.

The unit being quoted on must operate off 220 Volt \pm 10%, 50hz single phase a.c. supply and the unit must be fused in both the LIVE and NEUTRAL.
