### 2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

### 3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- 3.2. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.3. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote:
  - (i) that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
- 3.4. The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfilment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfilment of this contract.

### 6. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

6.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

### 7. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

### 1. BUSINESS REQUIREMENT

KZN Department of Health seeks to appoint a suitable service provider to assist with the provision of a competent WAN and LAN Specialist to assess the Department's WAN and LAN in support of the rollout of the KZN eHealth information system that is being developed in house. The WAN and LAN Specialist is required for a period of four (4) months. Within this period the KZN eHealth will be implemented and supported at atleast eighteen (18) hospitals and the WAN and LAN assessment must be done for these hospitals.

### 2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

KZN Department of Health is currently implementing a health information system that is being developed in-house at selected health facilities based in the province in line with the ICT Strategic Plan. The implementation of the project requires the availability of a close to 100% reliable WAN and LAN infrastructure. ### 5. EXPECTED DELIVERABLES
