6. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

6.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

7. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

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1 DESCRIPTION OF TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

The technical specification makes provision for the renovations, and repair of entrance gates to Richards Bay Forensic Mortuary.

a) Official contractual permission to a Contractor to proceed with construction of a plant or installation of equipment in a section of the plant constructed by other.

2 SCOPE OF WORK

There are three main gates at Richards Bay Forensic Mortuary namely:

- a) North East (NE) Main Entrance Gate. Sliding type.
- b) North West (NW) Gate. Swinging type.
- c) South East (SE) Gate. Sliding type.

The scope of work entails the following:

- a) The NE gate wheels and racks are to be replaced to ensure gate slides freely. New vertical guides are to be installed to ensure the gate does not pivot and come off the track. New locking mechanism to be installed to ensure the gate can be locked. Make two sections of the gate to be a see-through, see figure below. Paint the gate with appropriate sea grey colour to prevent rust.
- b) The NW gate hinges and ancillaries shall be adjusted to ensure the gate swings freely on the hinges and does not touch the ground. Install a locking mechanism to ensure the gate can be locked. Apply corrosion protection on the gate where applicable.
- c) The SE gate wheels and rack are to be replaced to ensure the gate slides freely. New vertical guides are to be installed to ensure the gate does not pivot and come of the track. New locking mechanism to be installed to ensure the gate can be locked. Apply corrosion protection on the gate where applicable.




Figure 1: Proposed changes on the NE Gate

3 CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

3.1 Notice to Bidders

- a) The institutions will remain open and operational at all times therefore the Contractor shall make the necessary arrangements with the Institutional Management and maintenance staff for any power outages that are required. This may necessitate weekend work.
- b) The Administration reserves the right to negotiate prices in the Schedule of Prices.
- c) All redundant material and rubble shall be removed from the institution's property immediately.
- d) All equipment and materials used in this contract shall be that which is specified or other approved prior to submission and closure of the bid.
- e) The Contractor is advised to examine all the drawings (if any) and to visit the site prior to tendering to acquaint him/herself with the nature of the work to be done and access to the siting of the existing buildings etc., as no claim will be allowed on the grounds of ignorance of the conditions under which the work will be executed.
- f) Any discrepancies or omissions shall be brought to the attention of the Project Leader immediately.
- g) The Contractor must be registered with CIDB and must have minimum grading of 1 ME.
- h) The Contractor must be competent with proven experience in working in a building industry with traceable references.

3.2 Execution Period

Two (2) weeks is the specified completion period for the construction stage from the date of award.

4 PARTICULAR SPECIFICATION

4.1 General Requirements

Tenderers are to make special note of the following:

- a) The whole works shall be in accordance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act 85/1993 and all regulations framed therein shall be carried out to the satisfaction of the Department of Health.
- b) Competent workmen skilled in their trade shall carry out all work.
- c) Quality shall be of the best standard practice and all workmanship will be subject to the approval of the Department of Health.
- d) The work shall at all times, for the duration of the contract, be carried out under the supervision of a skilled and competent representative of the Contractor, who will be able and authorized to receive and carry out instructions on behalf of the Contractor. A sufficient number of workmen shall be employed at all times to ensure satisfactory progress of the work.
- e) All apparatus, component parts, fittings and materials employed in the execution of the Contract shall be new and unused and shall be the latest type or pattern of the particular manufacture employed. S.A.B.S. mark bearing items shall be used wherever possible.
- f) The complete installation must be guaranteed against defective parts and workmanship for a period of twelve months (12) after the date of issue of the Completion Certificate.
- Tenderers are advised to visit the site and acquaint themselves fully with the site conditions and nature and full extent of work involved prior to submitting their tender. Claims on the grounds of insufficient information in such respects or otherwise will not be entertained by the Administration.
- h) The Department of Health reserves the right to make emergency repairs to keep the equipment in operation without voiding the Contractor's Guarantee, nor relieving the Contractor of his responsibility during the guarantee period when, after proper notice, the Contractor fails to attend to such emergency repairs. All costs incurred by the Administration under these circumstances will be for the account of the Contractor.
- i) NOTE: All electrical equipment shall comply with NER Regulation of voltage.

4.2 Safety and Risk Management

 The Contractor shall observe all safety precautions during the project services as required by the OHS Act 85 of 1993 and manufacturer's recommendations.

4.3 Quality Assurance

- a) All works shall be conducted by fully trained and certificated artisans/apprentice.
- b) Certificates of artisans/apprentice performing the works to be supplied.
- c) The client representative shall conduct inspections of the works on completion.
- The manufacturer's recommendations and test procedures shall be strictly adhered to.
- e) In line with the above requirement the contractor shall have documented quality assurance system to assure the quality of work at all stages.
- f) The contractor shall have qualified inspectors responsible for assuring quality assurance and quality surveillance at their works, their suppliers and at site.

5 THE SITE

The site is at Richards Bay Medico Legal Mortuary, KwaZulu-Natal. Tenderers are encouraged to visit the site to ensure successful installation of the work required. Arrangements in this regard can be made with the facility manager or project leader. Electrical Supply:

- 220V ± 10%, Single Phase, 50 Hz
- 400V ± 10%, Three phase, 50 Hz

6 PROGRAM OF WORKS

- It is imperative that the work be achieved with minimum interruption to the existing facility.
- The Contractor shall notify the institution seven (7) days prior to carrying out any site work.
- As the institution is to remain in full operation for the duration of the works, the works are to be planned and executed so as to cause minimum inconvenience to staff and visitors.
- A program shall be submitted within 7 days prior to the commencement of any work for the approval by the Project Leader. No work will commence without the program of works having been approved by the Project Leader. The lists of documents that ARE returnable with the Quotation Documentation are:

8 SCHEDULE OF PRICES

PREAMBLE TO THE SCHEDULE OF PRICES

- a) All prices shall be quoted in the currency of the Republic of South Africa and will be fixed. Only where exchange rates have been stated in the quotation document, as at two weeks (14 days) prior to closing date of this quotation, will such exchange rate fluctuation be taken into account in the variation of the cost of the imported items/equipment.
- b) The Tenderer shall enter a price against each item in the schedule of prices. If the Tenderer fails to enter a price against any item in the schedule of prices the relevant cost of such item shall be regarded as being covered by other prices in the schedule of prices.
- c) The prices quoted against each item of these schedules shall cover the full inclusive cost of everything required for the execution of the work under the item plus an apportionment of any cost involved in meeting the obligations and liabilities imposed by the conditions of contract and in complying with the specifications.
- d) The prices quoted for the supply of plant and equipment shall include for all handling, loading, transporting and offloading required for the delivery of the plant and equipment to the site, including in the case of off-site storage for double handling at the store.
- e) The prices quoted for erection and installation shall include for all handling, loading, transporting and off-loading, to take plant and equipment to place on site where required, erection, installation, painting, commissioning, operating, testing, adjusting, handling over in proper working order and guarantee for a period of 12 months, all as specified.
