SPECIAL CONTRACT CONDITIONS OF QUOTATIONS

1. AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

1.1. Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties.

2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (*domicilium citandi et executandi*) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The Department is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- 3.2. The Department reserves the right to communicate in writing with vendors in cases where information is incomplete or where there are obscurities regarding technical aspects of the offer, to obtain confirmation of prices or preference claims in cases where it is evident that a typing, written, transfer or unit error has been made, to investigate the vendor's standing and ability to complete the supply/service satisfactorily.
- 3.3. ALL DECISIONS TAKEN BY THE DEPARTMENT ARE FINAL, INCLUDING THE AWARD OF THIS QUOTATION.
- 3.4. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the Department reserves the right to evaluate all quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.5. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of the quotation:
 - (i) that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
 - (ii) it is the responsibility of the bidder to confirm receipt of their quotation and to keep proof thereof.
- 3.6. The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfilment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfilment of this contract.
- 3.7. This quotation will be evaluated based on the 80/20 points system, specification, correctness of information and/or functionality criteria.
 All required documentation must be completed in full and submitted.
- 3.8. Offers must comply strictly with the specification.
- 3.9. Only offers that meet or are greater than the specification will be considered.
- 3.10. Late offers will not be considered.
- 3.11. Expired product/s will not be accepted. All products supplied must be valid for a minimum period of six months.
- 3.12. Used/ second-hand products will not be accepted.
- 3.13. A bidder not registered on the Central Suppliers Database or whose verification has failed will not be considered.
- 3.14. All delivery costs must be included in the quoted price for delivery at the prescribed destination.
- 3.15. Only firm prices will be accepted. Such prices must remain firm for the contract period. Non-firm prices (including rates of exchange variations) will not be considered.

- 4.1. Unless inconsistent with or expressly indicated otherwise by the context, the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and with words importing the masculine gender shall include the feminine and the neuter.
- 4.2. Under no circumstances whatsoever may the quotation/bid forms be retyped or redrafted. Photocopies of the original bid documentation may be used, but an original signature must appear on such photocopies.
- 4.3. The bidder is advised to check the number of pages and to satisfy himself that none are missing or duplicated.
- 4.4. Quotations submitted must be complete in all respects. However, where it is identified that information in a bidder's response is incomplete in any respect, the said supplier meets all specification requirements and is lowest to quote, the Department reserves the right to request the bidder to complete/submit such information.
- 4.5. Any alteration made by the bidder must be initialled; failure to do so may render the response invalid.
- 4.6. Use of correcting fluid is prohibited and may render the response invalid.
- 4.7. Quotations will be opened in public as soon as practicable after the closing time of quotation.
- 4.8. Where practical, prices are made public at the time of opening quotations.
- 4.9. If it is desired to make more than one offer against any individual item, such offers should be given on a photocopy of the page in question. Clear indication thereof must be stated on the schedules attached.
- 4.10. The Department is under no obligation to pay suppliers in part for work done if the supplier can no longer for fulfil their obligation.

5. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING HAND DELIVERED QUOTATIONS

- 5.1. Quotation shall be lodged at the address indicated not later than the closing time specified for their receipt, and in accordance with the directives in the quotation documents.
- 5.2. Each quotation shall be addressed in accordance with the directives in the quotation documents and shall be lodged in a separate sealed envelope, with the name and address of the bidder, the quotation number and closing date indicated on the envelope. 8. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

8.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

9. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

9.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

10. TAX COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 10.1. In the event that the tax compliance status has failed on CSD, it is the suppliers' responsibility to provide a SARS pin in order for the institution to validate the tax compliance status of the supplier.

12. PATENT RIGHTS

13. PENALTIES

- 13.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 13.2. In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- 13.3. Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract. In the event that the contract is terminated the institution may claim damages from the service provider in the form of a penalty. 

PART THREE TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION FOR THE INSTALLATION OF AIRCONDITIONING UNIT

3.1 SCOPE OF CONTRACT

This specification calls for the complete supply, delivery to site installation, testing and commissioning of three air-conditioning units at Niemeyer Memorial Hospital.

The complete installation shall include all necessary refrigerant piping, support branches and any other materials or equipment necessary to complete the installation.

3.2 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

3.2.1 Tenderers are to make special note of the following:-

- All builders work within this contract will be the responsibility of the contractor.
- Contractors are advised to visit the site to acquint themselves fully with the nature and the full extent of the work involved. Claims on the ground of insufficient information will not be
- c) All visible inter-connecting refridgerant piping, condensate drain piping and electrical cables within the building shall be connected in PVC or sheet metal trunking.
- d) Competent workmen skilled in their trades shall carry out all work. Quality shall be of the best standard and all workmenship will be subject to the approval of the Hospital Maintanance manager
- e) All apparatus, component parts, fittings and material employed in the execution of the contract shall be new and unused and shall be of the latest type or pattern of the particular manufacture specified. SABS mark bearing items shall be used wherever possible.
- During the process of the work the contractor shall carefully clean up all debris and leave the premises and portion of the building in which his men have been working clean and free

3.3 OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE MANUALS

The contractor shall provide two sets of operating maintenance manuals for the air-conditioning unit installed. The manuals shall include manufacturer literature, maintenance procedure and operating instructions.

3.4 PRINCIPAL ITEMS OF WORK INCLUDE

- a) TWO underceiling split unit (single phase) with inter-connecting refrigerant piping , cables and remote controls, supports brackets etc.
- b) PVC cndensate drain piping , brackets etc
- c) All necessary electrical work as specified hereinafter.
- d) Commissioning and testing of the complete installation .e) Any item specifically mentioned hereinafter.





3.5 AIR-CONDITIONING SPLIT UNIT

3.5.1 TYPE AND CAPACITY

A) Supply and install TWO cooling only under-ceiling (2) split type air-conditioning(single phase) at MOBILE CLINIC, CCTV CAMERA room at Niemeyer hospital. The exact position of the unit will be discussed with Maintenance Manage. The condensing unit shall be mounted on the external wall of the building which is five metres distance from the position of the air handling units

COOLING:

18000 BTU and 9000BTU SPLIT UNIT

3.5.2 HEATING: 18000BTU and 9000 BTU SPLIT UNIT

Where specified, heating shall be by means of reverse cycle (heat pump)only.

3.5.3 CONTROLS

The under celling split type air-conditioner units (single phase) shall have their control fitted into attractive, remote surface mounted control boxes

3.5.4 SUPPORT BRACKET

The split unit condensing unit support brackets shall be hot dipped galvanized after manufacturer

3.6 REFRIGERANT PIPING

The inter-connecting refrigerant piping between the condensing units and the air handling units shall be of the best quality refrigerant class copper tubing, suitably size for unit installed. All fittings shall be copper or brass. Refrigerant quality fittings, welded to the copper tubing using good quality SILFOS or SILVER SOLDER welding rod.

The suction and liquid lines shall be completely insulated against ambient temperatures to prevent condensation drip.

The piping shall be neatly saddled through out the entire pipe run, and saddles shall be spaced at interval of not more than one (1) metre.

Pipe runs shall be neat and the quality workmenship shall be employed.

All visible refrigerant piping within the building shall be run in suitably sized PVC or sheet-metal trunking . This trunking shall be supplied and fixed by contractor. If the sheet-metal trunking is used then the trunking shall be painted to match the color of the wall on which it is mounted.

3.7 CONDENSATE

The condensate from the air-conditioning unit shall be piped away in PVC tubing. The condensate piping shall be neatly saddled through out the entire run, spaced at interval as per the manufacturer recommendation.







3.8 ELECTRICAL WORK

The contractor will supply all the electrics to air-handling units and the external condenser unit inclusive of the supply, installation, fitting of the suitably size isolator mounted adjacent to the air-handling unit.

The supply feeding the new under-ceiling units must be 2.5m single phase supply run in 20mm galvanized Bosal tubing and to be run from the nearest D/B.

A single phase 20amps 5Ka curve (2) circuit breaker to be installed in D/B for the new airconditioner units.

A single phase isolator (2) in York box to be mounted next to the air-handling unit

Should it prove to be necessary new points must be tubed and wired from D/B in the adjacent foyer. Suitably size circuit breakers must be supplied and installed by contractor.

Contractor is to allow for the testing and issuing of COC(Certificate of compliance) for the electrical work.


