

5. SERVICE HOURS

• The service provider is require to have their full complement of staff during week days from 06H00 to 18H00 (day shift), week days from 18H00 to 06H00 (night shift), weekends 06H00 to 18H00 (day shift), weekends 18H00 to 06H00 (night shift), public holidays 06H00 to 18H00 (day shift), public holiday 18H00 to 06H00 (night shift).

6. CONTRACT SERVICE PROCEDURE

- Clean all the Department offices, Examination rooms, Sluice rooms, toilets, Equipment and other cleaning within the Department.
- Collect and bundle linen and throw it in the schutes.
- · Decontaminate frequently used surfaces.
- The cleaners will be expected to decontaminate the areas affected by Covid 19 pandemic.
- Sweep all floors, mop and wash staff security guard house and public toilets. Wiping of walls, basins, taps and windows.
- Cleaning of sluice room, stock rooms, and kitchen, shining of furniture, cleaning of fridges and cupboards and washing of dressing trolleys.
- Clean the drains and courtyards.
- · Segregate and dump waste generated by the Department wards and officers.
- · The company must have own register
- To transport soiled linen and collect clean linen from our Laundry Department as and when required.
- To lift / move hospital equipment from various locations with the Institution should the need arise.
- · Clean the passages and corridors.

7. RK KHAN HOSPITAL CONTRACT TERM AND CONDITION

The service provider will be required to:

- Allocate staff at RK Khan Hospital and Clairwood Hospital.
- Cleaning service shall be provided (7) seven days per week inclusive of weekends and public holidays (as per the year 2022 calendar)
- Lunch / tea breaks to be negotiated with the Systems Manager. Hours of attendance may be subject to changes.
- Total number of personal required is 14 staff plus 1 team leader which totals 15 staff. It is compulsory
 for the service provider to ensure that the total number of staff is on duty during the stipulated
 working hours. Non availability of staff will be considered a breach of contract.
- Contractor to ensure that the supervisor / team leader is available at all times.
- The Deputy Director Systems or Assistance director shall determine the porter / messenger needs and will provide the supervisor / team leader onsite with a list for such placements and duties.
- The supervisor / team leader shall also provide the Systems Manager with a signed copy of their allocated staff and attendance register.
- The service provider must provide all their staff with uniform with company logo.
- The service provider should give their staff member's safety shoes and name badges.
- The service provider staff must maintain patient confidentiality at all times.
- The service provider must arrange for replacement staff at their own cost should the need arise.
- Staff will be required to perform cleaning duties at Clairwood Hospital.
- · Cleaning tools and material will be provided.
- The service provider is required to employ staff within the RK Khan Hospital area, thus ensuring service delivery is maintained at all times without any delays.
- During the Supply Chain process a request will be made for the service provider to submit their list of staff with ID copy and residential address details.
- This contract will be providing an equal opportunity for all under privileged South Africans.
- The staff must consist of eight (8) males and seven (7) females.

8. CONDUCT

- No staff should participate in any sort of strike action.
- Should the staff participate on strike action the Hospital will temporally employ staff on the expense of the service provider and immediately cancel the contract.
- At all times be courteous and polite to staff, patients and visitors.
- Assist Medical and Nursing staff in case of emergencies.

AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties. 1.1.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS

Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all 3.2. quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.3. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote:
 - that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & (i) calculations will be at the bidder's risk
- The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfilment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this 3.4. agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfilment of this contract.
- This quotation will be evaluated based on the 80/20 points system, specification & correctness of information. All required 3.5. documentation must be completed in full and submitted.
- 3.6. Offers must comply strictly with the specification.
- Only offers that meet or are greater than the specification will be considered. 3.7.
- 3.8. Late quotes will not be considered.
- Expired product/s will not be accepted. All products supplied must be valid for a minimum period of six months.
- A bidder not registered on the Central Suppliers Database or verification has failed will not be considered.
- All delivery costs must be included in the quote price, for delivery at the prescribed destination.
- Only firm prices will be accepted. Such prices must remain firm for the contract period. Non-firm prices (including rates of exchange variations) will not be considered,
- In cases where different delivery points influence the pricing, a separate pricing schedule must be submitted for each delivery point. 3.13,
- In the event of a bidder having multiple quotes, only the cheapest according to specification will be considered. Furthermore a verification will be done to identify if bidders have multiple companies and are quoting (cover-quoting) for this bid. In such instances only the cheapest bid according to specification will be considered.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS AND NOTICES TO BIDDERS REGARDING THE COMPLETION OF THIS QUOTATION.

- Unless inconsistent with or expressly indicated otherwise by the context, the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and with 4.1. words importing the masculine gender shall include the feminine and the neuter.
- Under no circumstances whatsoever may the quotation/bid forms be retyped or redrafted. Photocopies of the original bid documentation 4.2. may be used, but an original signature must appear on such photocopies. 4.3.
- The bidder is advised to check the number of pages and to satisfy himself that none are missing or duplicated.
- 4.4. Quotation submitted must be complete in all respects.
- 4.5. Any alteration made by the bidder must be initialled.
- Use of correcting fluid is prohibited 4.6.
- Quotation will be opened in public as soon as practicable after the closing time of quotation. 4.7.
- Where practical, prices are made public at the time of opening quotations. 4.8.
- If it is desired to make more than one offer against any individual item, such offers should be given on a photocopy of the page in 4.9. question. Clear indication thereof must be stated on the schedules attached.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING HAND DELIVERED QUOTATIONS 5.

- Quotation shall be lodged at the address indicated not later than the closing time specified for their receipt, and in accordance with the 5.1. directives in the quotation documents.
- Each quotation shall be addressed in accordance with the directives in the quotation documents and shall be lodged in a separate 5.2. sealed envelope, with the name and address of the bidder, the quotation number and closing date indicated on the envelope. The envelope shall not contain documents relating to any quotation other than that shown on the envelope. If this provision is not complied with, such quotations/bids may be rejected as being invalid.
- All quotations received in sealed envelopes with the relevant quotation numbers on the envelopes are kept unopened in safe custody 5.3. until the closing time of the quotation/bids. Where, however, a quotation is received open, it shall be sealed. If it is received without a quotation/bid number on the envelope, it shall be opened, the quotation number ascertained, the envelope sealed and the quotation number written on the envelope.
- A specific box is provided for the receipt of quotations, and no quotation found in any other box or elsewhere subsequent to the closing 5.4. date and time of quotation will be considered.

13. PENALTIES

- 13.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 13.2. In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- 13.3. Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract. In the event that the contract is terminated the institution may claim damages from the service provider in the form of a penalty. The service provider's performance should be captured on the service provider database in order to determine whether or not the service provider should be awarded any contracts in the future.
- 13.4. If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated on the delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day of the delay until actual delivery or performance.

14. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

- 14.1. The purchaser, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, may terminate this contract in whole or in part:
- (i) if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods within the period(s) specified in the contract,
- (ii) if the supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract; or
- (iii) if the supplier, in the judgment of the purchaser, has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract.
- 14.2. In the event the purchaser terminates the contract in whote or in part, the purchaser may procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate, goods, works or services similar to those undelivered, and the supplier shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs for such similar goods, works or services.
