#### 2. WORK SCHEDULE

The contractor shall submit a comprehensive work schedule on the pest control and fumigation service for the contact period for each building to Hospital approval within ten (10 days of the letter of award.

#### 3. SERVICE REPORTS

A monthly detailed report comprising of the works carried out, any abnormal events, corrective actions and preventive actions embarked should be submitted to **HOSPITAL** together with the monthly invoice for payment.

A monthly trends report, analysing the areas where pests are sighted and captured and comparing with the previous month's data is to be submitted. The Contractor must indicate in the report what actions they intend to carry out to remedy any

A monthly trend of catches in all the bait stations should also be submitted. The Contractor should provide analysis of the trends and offer professional advice should any abnormalities be detected, to rectify the situation immediately. Unacceptable trends.

## 4. IMMEDIATE ATTENDANCE TO URGENT REQUESTS

Other than the normal services the Contractor must attend and treat any pest sightings by **HOSPITAL** staff immediately at no additional charge. Such activations should be attended to not more than one hour after notification. A thorough investigation is also to be carried out to find the root cause of the sighting. Such activities are to be reported verbally to HOSPITAL personnel upon completion as well as in the monthly service reports.

### 5. SERVICE PROCEDURE

No servicing is to be carried out before the contractor has made prior arrangements for a service date with the officer in charge of the institutional maintenance division. Such service date arrangement shall be made at least **seven** (7) days prior to the actual proposed service date.

On arrival at the institution on the date of service, the contractor will be required to report to the office of the maintenance manager to sign into the contracts register before any servicing takes place. On completion of the service procedure, the contractor will once again be required to report to the maintenance manager's office to sign out of the contractors register.

When the contractor arrives on site to carry out servicing, he must be in possession of copies of the servicing schedule "annexure a". This schedule must be signed by the officer in charge of each ward and department where servicing has been completed in terms of the



specifications. The signature of the officer in charge will verify that the service has been carried out to the satisfaction of the officer in charge.

The properly completed and signed "annexure a" must then be filled in by the service technician complete with the date and the company stamp and attached to the contractor's invoice which must be forwarded for payment to:-

Failure to comply with the instructions pertaining to the service schedule could result in payment for the service being withheld.

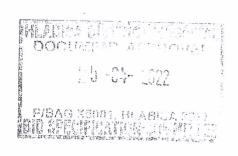

4.10. The Department is under no obligation to pay suppliers in part for work done if the supplier can no longer for fulfil their obligation.

## SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING HAND DELIVERED QUOTATIONS

- Quotation shall be lodged at the address indicated not later than the closing time specified for their receipt, and in accordance with the 5.1. directives in the quotation documents.
- Each quotation shall be addressed in accordance with the directives in the quotation documents and shall be lodged in a separate sealed envelope, with the name and address of the bidder, the quotation number and closing date indicated on the envelope. The 5.2. envelope shall not contain documents relating to any quotation other than that shown on the envelope. If this provision is not complied with, such quotations/bids may be rejected as being invalid.
- All quotations received in sealed envelopes with the relevant quotation numbers on the envelopes are kept unopened in safe custody until the closing time of the quotation/bids. Where, however, a quotation is received open, it shall be sealed. ### STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the 8.1. required particulars.

### 9. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

### 10. TAX COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

#### 11. PATENT RIGHTS

The supplier shall indemnify the KZN Department of Health (hereafter known as the purchaser) against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the goods or any part thereof by the purchaser.

#### 12. PENALTIES

- 12.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 12.2. In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- 12.3. Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract. In the event that the contract is terminated the institution may claim damages from the service provider in the form of a penalty. The service provider's performance should be captured on the service provider database in order to determine whether or not the service provider should be awarded any contracts in the future.
- If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated on the delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day of the delay until actual delivery or performance.

### 13. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

- 13.1. The purchaser, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, may terminate this contract in whole or in part:
- if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods within the period(s) specified in the contract,
- if the supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract; or
- if the supplier, in the judgment of the purchaser, has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract.
- In the event the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may procure, upon such terms and in such manner 13.2. as it deems appropriate, goods, works or services similar to those undelivered, and the supplier shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs for such similar goods, works or services.
- 13.3. Where the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may decide to impose a restriction penalty on the supplier by prohibiting such supplier from doing business with the public sector for a period not exceeding 10 years.
