SCOPE OF CONTRACT

The specification calls for the supply and installation of Electronic Access Controlled Doors at the Operating Theatres

2. DETAILED SPECIFICATION

- **2.1.** The doors and electronic mechanism to be supplied and installed shall be heavy duty, high traffic and **SABS** approved.
- **2.2.** The door shall be heavy duty white alluminium in construction with cladding 5mm in thickness(solid alluminium sheeting), 1400mm above floor level.
- 2.3. The width of the openings where doors shall be installed is approximately 1520mm(W) and the height 2100mm(H).
- 2.4. For sliding doors: The door shall open to the maximum width with the door sliding to 1 side.
- 2.5. For swing doors: Doors shall be duel equal leaves opening inwards.
- 2.6. All doors to form an airtight seal.
- 2.7. The door shall be glazed in 6 mm in thickness Laminated Safety frosted Glass.
- 2.8. A new access control system shall be installed with programmable scan tags.
- 2.9. Access tags must be programmed and supplied with the installation.
- 2.10. Proximity sensors shall be installed on one side of the door openings to prevent closing when obstructed.
- 2.11. 1 x "Break glass" emergency door release shall be installed for each door opening.
- 2.12. 1 x "No Touch" wave to open point shall be installed on the inside of each theatre.
- 2.13. 1 x electronic buzzer for each floor shall be installed with 4 call points.
- 2.14. Signage to be installed indicating "Ring for attention", "Caution Electronic doors"
- 2.15. The doors are to include a rechargeable battery pack power supply unit for emergency operation conditions.
- 2.16. In case of unit failure, the doors shall incorporate an option to be mechanically by-passed.
- 2.17. The existing doors shall be carefully removed and returned to the Maintenance Department.
- 2.18. The existing floor springs shall be removed and the void in the floor cemented.
- 2.19. Strip and remove concrete coving to areas to allow for sliding doors.
- 2.20. The existing vinyl section, 400mm(W) x 1500 mm(L) shall be removed and replaced. All joints in the vinyl patch shall

be welded at the seams. Vinyl shall match the existing colour and 2mm in thickness.

- 2.21. All processes in the preparation of the installation shall be undertaken by the contractor.
- 2.22. All tampered surfaces inclusive of vinyl flooring and painted areas are to be restored to an acceptable standard.

Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 13.2. In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- 13.3. Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract. - Failure on the part of a bidder to submit proof of B-BBEE Status level of contributor together with the quote, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for B-BBEE status level of contribution are not claimed.
- 1.6 The purchaser reserves the right to require of a bidder, either before a quote is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the purchaser.

DEFINITIONS

- (a) "B-BBEE" means broad-based black economic empowerment as defined in section 1 of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (b) "B-BBEE status level of contributor" means the B-BBEE status of an entity in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (c) "bid" means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the provision of goods or services, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;
- (d) "Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act" means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (e) "EME" means an Exempted Micro Enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (f) "functionality" means the ability of a tenderer to provide goods or services in accordance with specifications as set out in the tender
- (g) "prices" includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (h) "proof of B-BBEE status level of contributor" means:
 - B-BBEE Status level certificate issued by an authorized body or person;
 - 2) A sworn affidavit as prescribed by the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice;
 - Any other requirement prescribed in terms of the B-BBEE Act;
- (i) "QSE" means a qualifying small business enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (j) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;

3. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE
