1. AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

1.1. Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties.

2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- 3.2. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.3. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote:
 - (i) that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
- 3.4. The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfilment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfilment of this contract.

6. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

6.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

7. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

7.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. - 1.1 The institutions will remain open and operational at all times therefore the Contractor shall make the necessary arrangements with the Institutional Management and maintenance staff for any power outages that are required. This may necessitate weekend work
- All items to be priced fully inclusive of all charges e.g. labour, transport, scaffolding, materials, profit, etc., but excluding Value Added Tax.
- 1.3 The Administration reserves the right to negotiate prices in the Schedule of Prices.
- All redundant material and rubble shall to be removed from the institution's property immediately.
- All equipment and materials used in this project shall be that which is specified or other approved prior to submission and closure of the bid.
- 1.6 The Contractor is advised to examine all the drawings (if any) and to visit the site prior to tendering to acquaint him/herself with the nature of the work to be done and access to the siting of the existing buildings etc., as no claim will be allowed on the grounds of ignorance of the conditions.
- 1.7 All items in the Schedule of Prices are **PROVISIONAL** and subject to re-measure after installation.
- 1.8 The Schedule of Prices shall be read in conjunction with the Scope of Work Any discrepancies or omissions shall be brought to the attention of the Project Leader immediately.
- 1.9 Preference will be given to Bidders who have registered offices / workshops within the borders of the Province of KwaZulu-Natal. This is in an effort to reduce response times to call outs for breakdowns in the more remote areas of the Province.

1.10 SCOPE OF CONTRACT

- Isolate, disconnect and remove the existing faulty hydroboil.
- Supply, deliver, install and commission new 5 x 5 litre white epoxy hydroboil (Instant boiling water).

Details of this hydroboil are:

- Instant boiling water for tea, coffee, and cooking
- Designed to operate within 3C of boiling point with thermal temperature control
- New energy conserving "Cool Touch" tap provides fingertip control, reduces heat loss and saves energy
- Two-way tap control for precision filling of cups, locks on for filling pots
- Fully automatic
- Steam free
- White Epoxy finish
- Able to deliver 25 30 cups of boiling water at one time
- · Peak demand-loading is reduced considerably in comparison to traditional kettles and urns
- Concealed plumbing and electrical connections
- SABS Approved

1.11 PERIOD OF CONTRACT

Two weeks is allowed duration for this Contract from the date of site handover/Order number issued.

1.12 SITE AND MODE OF PROCEDURE

The work contained in this contract will be carried out at Pietermaritzburg MLM (2), Howick MLM (1), Richmond MLM (1) and New Hanover MLM (1).

Bidders to note that any damages done or occurring to any of the buildings will be repaired at the expense of the contractor/ Bidder. The work undertaken shall be to the satisfaction of the KwaZulu-Natal Department of Health.

1.13 <u>SATISFACTORY INSTALLATION</u>

All work shall be carried out in according to the Department of Health's Standard Preambles to all Trades, the OHS Act, National Building Code of Practices and Regulations, the KZN DOH Policy Document for the Design of Electrical Installations and the SANS 10142-1 or latest Wiring Code.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

2. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

2.1 GENERAL

This Technical Specification shall be read in conjunction with all other sections of the Specification and cognisance shall be taken of the clauses relevant to this particular installation, whether any specific clauses are referred to or not.

The Distribution Boards and Kiosks shall be manufactured and installed as per SANS specification.

All cables shall be terminated using approved cable glands and waterproof shrouds.

The cable glands shall be bolted to a galvanised mild steel plate, which shall be built horizontally into the Distribution Boards and Kiosks. All Distribution Boards shall allow for minimum of 30 % spare capacity for any future expansion.

All Distribution Boards shall allow for cascading discrimination of MCCB's and MCB's and shall be labelled in accordance with the SANS 10142-1:2012 or latest Wiring Code.

Infrastructure Development representative or his/her designee shall approve the details of the proposed construction and all equipment of switchboards and kiosks prior to the manufacture of such switchboards and kiosks.

SCHEDULE OF PRICES

3.1 Items and Pricing

3.2 Tax and Duties

Prices, tendered and paid, must include all customs, excise and import duties, and any other tariffs or taxes levied by the government or statutory body having jurisdiction on the goods provided under this contract, including Value Added Tax (applicable to the current rate).

3.3 Rates

Except where provision is made in the Schedule of Rates, the rates and prices inserted shall be the full rates and prices for the service delivered described under the respective items and shall cover all labour, transport, overhead charges and profit, etc. as well as the general liabilities, obligations and risks arising out of the Conditions of Contract, the overhead charges and profit being spread proportionately over the rates of the relative items in the Schedule of Rates.
