6. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

6.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

7. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

SPECIFICATION FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF WASTE PAPER GENERATED BY ALL PROVINCIAL HEALTH FACILITIES WITHIN THE UMGUNDLOVU HEALTH DISTRCT.

1. BACKGROUND

This specification is calling for bidders to provide a service to remove all waste paper, plastic, cardboard boxes and confidential files approved for disposal from the District Office and the Institutions.

Currently waste paper collection from the Department is not contracted to any service provider.

KZN Treasury has urged all Provincial Districts Offices to increase the collection of revenue and given the amount of money expended on the purchased of this item; this has been identified as one such area.

The lack of appointment of a bona fide service provider has also exposed the Department to risk of abuse with regards to the disposal of records and collection of monies accruing from it.

In addition, there has to be a mechanism to preserve the confidentiality of and to maintain control in terms of weight and revenue derived from this area of business.

2. PURPOSE

2.1. To appoint a service provider to collect, shred, and dispose of waste paper from the District Offices as well as Institutions on a three year contract on request as records are approved for disposal for:

Region 1: UMgungundlovu Health District

3. COLLECTION

3.1. The bidders must show capacity to be able to collect the waste according to a schedule agreed upon with the respective District Office and Health Facilities as part of the Service Level Agreement.

On arrival at the Institution the contractor must report to the Security Office to sign the attendance register.

- 3.2. The Waste Management Officer or Registry Official will accompany the contractor during the weighing of the waste paper.
 - (i) Contractors will be required to flatten all cardboard boxes.
 - (ii) The contractor must be made aware that any breach in confidentiality will result in the relevant steps as per contract remedy.
 - (iii) The contractor is required to issue an official weigh note to the Revenue or Finance Section of the Institution for reconciliation and record keeping purposes after each load uplifted.
 - (iv) Information required on the weigh note is: Name and contact details of a contractor, Date of pickup. Total weight taken, Signature of contractor/ employee.

- (v) On departure from the Institution the contractor will sign out in the same register as when they did on arrival.
- (vi) Contractor is required to make payment within thirty days of pick up to the Institution in cash or via EFT.
- (vii) For EFT payments, the Institution must first request a reference number from the Banking and Reporting Section at Natalia and provide the same to the contractor.
- (viii) The Contractor must be able to weigh waste paper on collection and the weighing outcome must be signed off by the KZN Department of Health Official and the company's representative.
- (ix) Contractor to note that the Department of Health and the Institutions will not be responsible for any injury on duty sustained while on the Institutions premises.
- (x) The collection points of waste paper will be indicated at the site meeting.
- (xi) BEE compliance certificate must be attached.

4. UNIFORMS

- (i) Contractor to issue their staff with proper identification.
- (ii) Contractor to provide own PPE for their staff such as safety boots, gloves masks and overalls.

STORAGE

- All records approved for disposal must be bagged and securely stored at the Institution.
- (ii) The contractor must be notified of records ready for uplifting.
- (iii) Once notified, the contractor will uplift following all protocol listed under point 3.
- (iv) The contractor will ensure that safe storage of all records uplifted and housed at their premised until destruction occurs.

6. TRANSPORTATION

(i) The bidder/s must show capacity to be able to provide adequate transportation of all waste papers to be collected from all health facilities for recycling.

7. DISPOSAL

(i) The bidder/s must show capacity and capability to be able to provide a comprehensive disposal service of waste paper.

- (ii) The Department reserves the right to have an Official presents during shredding or destroying of confidential waste paper and documents.
- (iii) A destruction certificate for confidential waste paper and destructed documents must be issued to the Institution once destruction has been concluded.
- (iv) Documents and waste paper must not be dumped whole at waste sites or any other place.
- (v) Documents and paper must be shredded before being sold.

8. PRICING:

- (i) The bidder/s must indicate the amount per kg they will pay the health facility.
