### 1. AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties.

### 2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

### 3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- The Department is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote. 3.1.
- The Department reserves the right to communicate in writing with vendors in cases where information is incomplete or where there are 3.2. obscurities regarding technical aspects of the offer, to obtain confirmation of prices or preference claims in cases where it is evident that a typing, written, transfer or unit error has been made, to investigate the vendor's standing and ability to complete the supply/service satisfactorily.
- ALL DECISIONS TAKEN BY THE DEPARTMENT ARE FINAL, INCLUDING THE AWARD OF THIS QUOTATION. 3.3.
- The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the Department reserves the right to evaluate all 3.4. quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.5. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of the quotation:
  - that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
  - it is the responsibility of the bidder to confirm receipt of their quotation and to keep proof thereof.
- The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfilment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this 3.6. agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfilment of this contract.
- This quotation will be evaluated based on the 80/20 points system, specification, correctness of information and/or functionality criteria. 3.7. All required documentation must be completed in full and submitted.
- 3.8. Offers must comply strictly with the specification.
- 3.9. Only offers that meet or are greater than the specification will be considered.
- 3.10. Late offers will not be considered.
- 3.11. Expired product/s will not be accepted. All products supplied must be valid for a minimum period of six months.
- 3.12. Used/ second-hand products will not be accepted.
- 3.13. A bidder not registered on the Central Suppliers Database or whose verification has failed will not be considered.
- 3.14. All delivery costs must be included in the quoted price for delivery at the prescribed destination.
- 3.15. Only firm prices will be accepted. Such prices must remain firm for the contract period. Non-firm prices (including rates of exchange variations) will not be considered.
- In cases where different delivery points influence the pricing, a separate pricing schedule must be submitted for each delivery point.
- 3.17. In the event of a bidder having multiple quotes, only the cheapest according to specification will be considered.
- 3.18. Verification will be conducted to identify if bidders have multiple companies and are cover-quoting for this bid.
- 3.19. In such instances, the Department reserves the right to immediately disqualify such bidders as cover-quoting is an offence that represents both corruption and acquisition fraud.

# 4. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS AND NOTICES TO BIDDERS REGARDING THE COMPLETION OF THIS QUOTATION.

- Unless inconsistent with or expressly indicated otherwise by the context, the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and with words importing the masculine gender shall include the feminine and the neuter.
- Under no circumstances whatsoever may the quotation/bid forms be retyped or redrafted. Photocopies of the original bid documentation 4.2. may be used, but an original signature must appear on such photocopies.
- The bidder is advised to check the number of pages and to satisfy himself that none are missing or duplicated. 4.3.
- Quotations submitted must be complete in all respects. However, where it is identified that information in a bidder's response is incomplete in any respect, the said supplier meets all specification requirements and is lowest to quote, the Department reserves the right to request the bidder to complete/submit such information. 4.5.
- Any alteration made by the bidder must be initialled; failure to do so may render the response invalid.
- 4.6. Use of correcting fluid is prohibited and may render the response invalid.
- 4.7. Quotations will be opened in public as soon as practicable after the closing time of quotation.
- 4.8. Where practical, prices are made public at the time of opening quotations.
- If it is desired to make more than one offer against any individual item, such offers should be given on a photocopy of the page in 4.9. question. Clear indication thereof must be stated on the schedules attached.
- The Department is under no obligation to pay suppliers in part for work done if the supplier can no longer for fulfil their obligation.

# 5. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING HAND DELIVERED QUOTATIONS

- Quotation shall be lodged at the address indicated not later than the closing time specified for their receipt, and in accordance with the 5.1. directives in the quotation documents.
- Each quotation shall be addressed in accordance with the directives in the quotation documents and shall be lodged in a separate 5.2. sealed envelope, with the name and address of the bidder, the quotation number and closing date indicated on the envelope. The envelope shall not contain documents relating to any quotation other than that shown on the envelope. If this provision is not complied with, such quotations/bids may be rejected as being invalid. 5.3.
- All quotations received in sealed envelopes with the relevant quotation numbers on the envelopes are kept unopened in safe custody until the closing time of the quotation/bids. Where, however, a quotation is received open, it shall be sealed. If it is received without a quotation/bid number on the envelope, it shall be opened, the quotation number ascertained, the envelope sealed and the quotation number written on the envelope.
- A specific box is provided for the receipt of quotations, and no quotation found in any other box or elsewhere subsequent to the closing date and time of quotation will be considered.
- No quotation/bid sent through the post will be considered if it is received after the closing date and time stipulated in the quotation 5.5. documentation, and proof of posting will not be accepted as proof of delivery. 5.6.
- Quotation documents must not be included in packages containing samples. Such quotations may be rejected as being invalid.

### 6. SAMPLES

- In the case of the quote document stipulating that samples are required, the supplier will be informed in due course when samples 6.1. should be provided to the institution. (This decreases the time of safety and storage risk that may be incurred by the respective institution). The bidders sample will be retained if such bidder wins the contract.
- If a company/s who has not won the quote requires their samples, they must advise the institution in writing of such. (ii)
- If samples are not collected within three months of close of quote the institution reserves the right to dispose of them at their discretion.

### 8. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the 8.1, Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

## 9. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

### 10. TAX COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 10.1. In the event that the tax compliance status has failed on CSD, it is the suppliers' responsibility to provide a SARS pin in order for the institution to validate the tax compliance status of the supplier.
- In the event that the institution cannot validate the suppliers' tax clearance on SARS as well as the Central Suppliers Database, the quote will not be considered and passed over as non-compliant according to National Treasury Instruction Note 4 (a) 2016/17.

### 11. TAX INVOICE

- 11.1. A tax invoice shall be in the currency of the Republic of South Africa and shall contain the following particulars:
- (i) the name, address and registration number of the supplier;
- (ii) the name and address of the recipient;
- (iii) an individual serialized number and the date upon which the tax invoice is issued:
- (iv) a description and quantity or volume of the goods or services
- (v) the official department order number issued to the supplier;
- (vi) the value of the supply, the amount of tax charged;
- (vii) the words tax invoice in a prominent place.

### 12. PATENT RIGHTS

The supplier shall indemnify the KZN Department of Health (hear after known as the purchaser) against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the goods or any part thereof by the purchaser.

### 13. PENALTIES

- 13.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract. In the event that the contract is terminated the institution may claim damages from the service provider in the form of a penalty. The service provider's performance should be captured on the service provider database in order to determine whether or not the service provider should be awarded any contracts in the future.
- 13.4. If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated on the delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day of the delay until actual delivery or performance.

### 14. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

- 14.1. The purchaser, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, may terminate this contract in whole or in part:
- if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods within the period(s) specified in the contract,
- if the supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract; or
- if the supplier, in the judgment of the purchaser, has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the (iii) contract.
- In the event the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may procure, upon such terms and in such manner 14.2. as it deems appropriate, goods, works or services similar to those undelivered, and the supplier shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs for such similar goods, works or services.
- Where the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may decide to impose a restriction penalty on the supplier by prohibiting such supplier from doing business with the public sector for a period not exceeding 10 years.

### 3. DIESEL FILLING AND INVOICE PROCESS

- 3.1 Supplier to arrange with the Maintenance Manager to be on site for the overseeing of the first diesel offloading to ensure orientation of the supplier and staff on the filling process and particulars of the generator
- 3.3 For the second filling onwards, the Operational Manager of the facility or a nominated official to be in attendance during the diesel filling process. A Fuel Drop Off register will be completed and signed by both the Operational Manager (or delegate) and the contractor at the offloading site. The Register will be retained by the Operational Manager on behalf of the Clinic.

The contractor will also sign the Security Register on entry and departure from the clinic. A security officer will be present when this off load occurs.

- 3.4 Tanks are to be filled to full capacity. If there is residual diesel in the contractor's delivery tank, then the amount should be noted in the Fuel Drop Off register
- 3.5 Invoices can be created at each drop off point and will be stamped by the clinic and signed by the Operational Manager on the day of fuel delivery. It will then be submitted to the Maintenance Office for checking and further signature. The invoice will be forwarded from Maintenance Section to Stores.
- 3.6 Individual invoices to be submitted for each clinic.
- 3.7. If there is any residual diesel, then it will be delivered to the Hospital Generator tank. The same Fuel Collection Register in 3.1 will be completed and signed by both Maintenance Manager and the contractor at the delivery site at the hospital.

The contractor will also sign the Security Register on entry and departure from the hospital. A security officer will be present when this off load occurs.

### 4. BID EVALUATION
