1. AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

- 1.1. Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties.

2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

- 2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (*domicilium citandi et executandi*) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The Department is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
 3.2. The Department reserves the right to communicate in writing with vendors in cases where information is incomplete or where there are obscurities regarding technical aspects of the offer, to obtain confirmation of prices or preference claims in cases where it is evident that a typing, written, transfer or unit error has been made, to investigate the vendor's standing and ability to complete the supply/service satisfactorily.
 3.3. **ALL DECISIONS TAKEN BY THE DEPARTMENT ARE FINAL, INCLUDING THE AWARD OR CANCELLATION OF THIS QUOTATION.**

- 3.4. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor).
 3.5. Should a bidder become a VAT vendor after award or during the implementation of a contract, they may not request the VAT percentage from the Department as the service provider made an offer during the period they were not registered as a VAT vendor. The Department is only liable for any VAT from registered VAT vendors as originally stated on the quotation document.
 3.6. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of the quotation:
 (i) that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
 (ii) it is the responsibility of the bidder to confirm receipt of their quotation and to keep proof thereof.

- 3.7. The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfillment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfillment of this contract.
 3.8. This quotation will be evaluated based on the 80/20 points system, specification, correctness of information and/or functionally criteria. All required documentation must be completed in full and submitted.
 3.9. Offers must comply strictly with the specification.
 3.10. Only offers that meet or are greater than the specification will be considered.
 3.11. Late offers will not be considered.
 3.12. Expired products will not be accepted. All products supplied must be valid for a minimum period of six months.

- 3.13. Used/ second-hand products will not be accepted.
 3.14. A bidder not registered on the Central Suppliers Database or whose verification has failed will not be considered.
 3.15. All delivery costs must be included in the quote price for delivery at the prescribed destination.
 3.16. Only firm prices will be accepted. Such prices must remain firm for the contract period. Non-firm prices (including rates of exchange variations) will not be considered.
 3.17. In cases where different delivery points influence the pricing, a separate pricing schedule must be submitted for each delivery point.
 3.18. In the event of a bidder having multiple quotes, only the cheapest according to specification will be considered.
 3.19. Verification will be conducted to identify if bidders have multiple companies and are cover-quoting for this bid.
 3.20. In such instances, the Department reserves the right to immediately disqualify such bidders as cover-quoting is an offence that represents both corruption and acquisition fraud.

4. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS AND NOTICES TO BIDDERS REGARDING THE COMPLETION OF THIS QUOTATION.

- 4.1. Unless inconsistent with or expressly indicated otherwise by the context, the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and with words importing the masculine gender shall include the feminine and the neuter.
 4.2. Under no circumstances whatsoever may the quotation/bid forms be retyped or retransmitted. Photocopies of the original bid documentation may be used, but an original signature must appear on such photocopies.
 4.3. The bidder is advised to check the number of pages and to satisfy himself that none are missing or duplicated.
 4.4. Quotations submitted must be complete in all respects. However, where it is identified that information in a bidder's response, which does not affect the preference points or price, is incomplete in any respect, the said supplier meets all specification requirements and scores the highest points in terms of preference points and price, the Department reserves the right to request the bidder to complete/submit such information.
 4.5. Any alteration made by the bidder must be initialed; failure to do so may render the response invalid.
 4.6. Use of correcting fluid is prohibited and may render the response invalid.
 4.7. Quotations will be opened in public as practicable after the closing time of quotation.
 4.8. Where practical, prices are made public at the time of opening quotations.
 4.9. If it is desired to make more than one offer against any individual item, such offers should be given on a photocopy of the page in question. Clear indication thereof must be stated on the schedules attached.

11. TAX INVOICE
- 11.1. A tax invoice shall be in the currency of the Republic of South Africa and shall contain the following particulars:
- (i) the name, address and registration number of the supplier;
 - (ii) a description and quantity or volume of the goods or services supplied;
 - (iii) the name and address of the recipient;
 - (iv) an individual serialized number and the date upon which the tax invoice is issued;
 - (v) the value of the supply, the amount of tax charged;
 - (vi) the official department order number issued to the supplier;
 - (vii) the words tax invoice in a prominent place.
12. PATENT RIGHTS
- The supplier shall indemnify the **KZN Department of Health** (hereafter known as the purchaser) against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the goods or any part thereof by the purchaser.
13. PENALTIES
- 13.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
 - 13.2. In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
 - 13.3. Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract. In the event that the contract is terminated the institution may claim damages from the service provider in the form of a penalty. The service provider's performance should be captured on the service provider database in order to determine whether or not the service provider should be awarded any contracts in the future.
 - 13.4. If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated on the delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day of the delay until actual delivery or performance.
14. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT
- 14.1. The purchaser, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, may terminate this contract in whole or in part:
 - (i) if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods within the period(s) specified in the contract;
 - (ii) if the supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract; or
 - (iii) if the supplier, in the judgment of the purchaser, has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract.
 - 14.2. In the event the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate, goods, works or services similar to those undelivered, and the supplier shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs for such similar goods, works or services.
 - 14.3. Where the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may decide to impose a restriction penalty on the supplier by prohibiting such supplier from doing business with the public sector for a period not exceeding 10 years.
