8. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SURVICES.

8.1. The contractor shall when responsed to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

9. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SUB-6.1
