

- 1. SPECIAL CONTRACT CONDITIONS OF QUOTATIONS**
 1. The Department reserves the right to accept or reject the bidding in any quote.
 2. The Department reserves its right to communicate its bidding with vendors in cases where it is appropriate to do so or where there are observable regional technical aspects of the offer, to obtain confirmation of prices or preference claims in cases where it is evident that a typographical error or omission has been made, to investigate the vendor's standing and ability to complete the supply/service satisfactorily.
 - 3. ALL DECISIONS TAKEN BY THE DEPARTMENT ARE FINAL, INCLUDING THE AWARD OR CANCELLATION OF THIS QUOTATION.**
 4. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor).
 5. Should a bidder become a VAT vendor after award or during the implementation of a contract, they may request the VAT percentage from the Department as its service provider made an effort during the period they were not registered as a VAT vendor. The Department is only liable for any VAT from registered VAT vendors as originally stated on the quotation document.
 6. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of the quotation.
 - (i) that the price(s) rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/article(s); & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
 - (ii) it is the responsibility of the bidder to confirm receipt of their quotation and to keep proof thereof.
 7. The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution / fulfillment of all obligations/conditions involving the order lines as enunciated, as per the Principal Schedule to be due fulfillment of this contract.
 8. This quotation will be evaluated based on the RMR90 points system, specification, correctness of information under functionality criteria. All required documentation must be completed in full and submitted.
 9. Offers must comply strictly with the specification.
 10. Only offers that meet or are greater than the specification will be considered.
 11. Late offers will not be considered.
 12. Expired products will not be accepted. All products supplied must be valid for a minimum period of six months.
 13. Used/second-hand products will not be accepted.
 14. A bidder not registered on the Central Suppliers Database or whose verification has failed will not be considered.
 15. All delivery costs must be included in the quoted price for delivery at the prescribed destination.
 16. Only firm prices will be accepted. Such prices must remain firm for the contract period. Non-firm prices (including rates of exchange variations) will not be considered.
 17. In cases where different delivery points influence the pricing, a separate pricing schedule must be submitted at each delivery point.
 18. In the event of a bidder having multiple quotes, only the cheapest according to specification will be considered.
 19. Verification will be conducted to identify if bidders have multiple companies and/or cover-superior in line bid.
 20. In such instances, the Department reserves the right to immediately disqualify such bidders as false quoting is an offence that represents both criminal and corruption fraud.
 - 2. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS AND NOTICES TO BIDDERS REGARDING THE COMPLETION OF THIS QUOTATION**
 - 2.1. Unless inconsistent with or expressly indicated otherwise by the context, the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and with words importing the masculine, gender shall include the feminine and the neuter.
 - 2.2. Under no circumstances whatsoever may the quotation bid forms be photocopied or reproduced. Photocopies of the original bid documentation may be used, but an original signature must appear on such photocopies.
 - 2.3. The bidder is advised to check the number of pages and to satisfy himself that none are missing or duplicated.
 - 2.4. Quotations submitted must be complete in all respects. However, where it is identified that information in a bidder's response, which does not affect the preference points or price, is incomplete in any respect, the said supplier retains all specification requirements, and scores the highest points in terms of preference points and price, the Department reserves the right to request the bidder to complete/submit such information.
 - 2.5. Any alteration made by the bidder must be initialled. Failure to do so may render the response invalid.
 - 2.6. Use of correction fluid is prohibited and any tender thus response invalid.
 - 2.7. Quotations will be placed in public as soon as practicable after the closing time of quotation.
 - 2.8. Where practical, prices are made public at the time of opening quotations.
 - 2.9. If it is desired to make more than one offer against any individual item, such offers should be given on a photocopy of the page in question. Clear detailing thereof must be stated on the schedules attached.
 - 2.10. The Department is under no obligation to pay suppliers in part for work done if the supplier can no longer fulfil their obligations.
 - 3. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING HAND-DELIVERED QUOTATIONS**
 - 3.1. Quotations shall be lodged at the address indicated no later than the closing time specified for the receipt and in accordance with the directives in the quotation documents.
 - 3.2. Each quotation shall be addressed in accordance with the directives in the quotation documents and shall be lodged in a separate sealed envelope, with the name and address of the bidder, the quotation number and closing date indicated on the envelope. The envelope shall not contain documents relating to any quotation other than that shown on the envelope. If this provision is not complied with, such quotations/bids may be rejected as being invalid.
 - 3.3. All quotations received in sealed envelopes with the relevant quotation numbers on the envelopes are kept unopened in safe custody until the closing time of the quotation/bids. Where, however, a quotation is received open, it shall be sealed. If it is received without a quotation bid number on the envelope, it shall be opened, the quotation number ascertained, the envelope sealed and the quotation number written on the envelope.
 - 3.4. A specific box will be provided for the receipt of quotations, and no quotation found in any other box or elsewhere subsequent to the closing date and time of quotation will be considered.
 - 3.5. No quotation bid sent through the post will be considered if it is received after the closing date and time stipulated in the quotation documents and period of posting will not be accepted as proof of delivery.
 - 3.6. Quotation documents must not be included in packages containing samples. Such quotations may be rejected as being invalid.

- 3.2. I understand that the accompanying bid will be disqualified if this disclosure is found not to be true and complete in every respect;
- 3.3. The bidder has arrived at the accompanying bid independently from, and without consultation, communication, agreement or arrangement with any competitor. However, communication between partners in a joint venture or consortium² will not be construed as collusive bidding.
- 3.4. In addition, there have been no consultations, communications, agreements or arrangements with any competitor regarding the quality, quantity, specifications, prices, including methods, factors or formulas used to calculate prices, market allocation, the intention or decision to submit or not to submit the bid, bidding with the intention not to win the bid and conditions or delivery particulars of the products or services to which this bid invitation relates.
- 3.5. The terms of the accompanying bid have not been, and will not be, disclosed by the bidder, directly or indirectly, to any competitor, prior to the date and time of the official bid opening or of the awarding of the contract.
- 3.6. There have been no consultations, communications, agreements or arrangements made by the bidder with any official of the procuring institution in relation to this procurement process prior to and during the bidding process except to provide clarification on the bid submitted where so required by the institution; and the bidder was not involved in the drafting of the specifications or terms of reference for this bid.
- 3.7. I am aware that, in addition and without prejudice to any other remedy provided to combat any restrictive practices related to bids and contracts, bids that are suspicious will be reported to the Competition Commission for investigation and possible imposition of administrative penalties in terms of section 59 of the Competition Act No 89 of 1998 and/or may be reported to the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) for criminal investigation and/or may be restricted from conducting business with the public sector for a period not exceeding ten (10) years in terms of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act No 12 of 2004 or any other applicable legislation.
