## 1. AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties.

# CHANGE OF ADDRESS

Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et 2.1. executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

# GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

The Department is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.

- The Department reserves the right to communicate in writing with vendors in cases where information is incomplete or where there are 3.1. obscurities regarding technical aspects of the offer, to obtain confirmation of prices or preference claims in cases where it is evident that 3.2. a typing, written, transfer or unit error has been made, to investigate the vendor's standing and ability to complete the supply/service
- ALL DECISIONS TAKEN BY THE DEPARTMENT ARE FINAL, INCLUDING THE AWARD OR CANCELLATION OF THIS 3.3. QUOTATION.

The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). 3.4.

Should a bidder become a VAT vendor after award or during the implementation of a contract, they may not request the VAT percentage from the Department as the service provider made an offer during the period they were not registered as a VAT vendor. #### 8. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the 8.1. Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

## 9. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all 9.1. relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

#### 10. TAX COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

#### 11. PATENT RIGHTS

The supplier shall indemnify the KZN Department of Health (hereafter known as the purchaser) against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the goods or any part thereof by the purchaser.

#### 12. PENALTIES

- 12.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract. In the event that the contract is terminated the institution may claim damages from the service provider in the form of a penalty. The service provider's performance should be captured on the service provider database in order to determine whether or not the service provider should be awarded any contracts in the future.
- If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated on the delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day of the delay until actual delivery or performance.

## 13. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

## 12 MONTHS PEST CONTROL CONTRACT

#### 1. GENERAL

1.1. The specification calls not received provider to provide an annual pest control service to all wards and departments at UMzimkhulu Hospital.

1.2. The discussions at the compulsory site inspection meeting will guide the Bidder in submitting a competitive and accurate Bid.

#### 2. REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1. The Bidder is required to submit a quotation, which is fair and competitive.
- 2.2. The Bidder is not allowed to deviate from the specification.
- 2.3. It is compulsory to attend the site meeting.

#### 3, GENERAL SPECIFICATIÓN

- 3.1(a) Bradication and control of pests, bees and vermin, including installation and monthly servicing of Compact Bait Stations for rats and mice where available at UMzimkhulu Hospital in the areas referred to in Annexure A.
- 3.1(b)All sewage and storm water manholes or drains within the institution complex shall be opened and the interior shall be treated with Crackdown or similar gel every three (3) months period.
- NOTE: Service provider is to be possession of his or her own manhole opening tools or devices to be used.
- 3.2. All staff working on site must be attired with the appropriate safety wear (not Compulsory)
- 3.3. Service Periods:
- 3.3.1. A full treatment of all areas specified in Annexure A shall be carried out every four (4) weeks.
- 3.3.2. If, between the monthly services, infestation of any type (rats, cockroaches, termites, birdlike (provision of 150m² on a call when required), moth larvae and fish moths or any other pests) becomes apparent, the contractor shall provide the necessary corrective treatment to the entire satisfaction of and at no additional cost, to the Administration.
- 3.3.3. All servicing to be carried out during normal working hours and with the least inconvenience, to the ward or department, as possible.
- 3.3.4. No servicing is to be carried out until the successful Bidder has reported to the officer-in-charge of the Maintenance Division and received from him a detailed schedule of the wards/departments to be serviced (See Annexure A).
- 3.3.5. A competent person in the ward/department must sign this schedule after servicing has been satisfactorily completed. On completion of the monthly service, the schedule must be returned to the officer-in-charge. Failure to comply with the above may result in payment being withheld.
- 3.4. Contract period:
- 3.4.1. The contract resulting from the acceptance of the successful Bid by the Quotation Award Committee shall be for a period of twelve (12) calendar months.
- 3.4.2. This contract or any renewal may, however, be terminated by either party, provided thirty (30) days' notice is given in writing and such notice is to expire on the last day of any month.
- 3.4.3. The successful Bidder shall not assign this contract or sub-let any portion thereof to any other company, firm or person.
- 3.4.4. Payments shall be made after each service on receipt of that months invoice.
- 3.4.5. This agreement shall not be construed as a contract of insurance.
- 3.4.6. All application, storage and handling to be in accordance with S.A.B.S. codes of practice.
