GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

GCC

NOTES

The purpose of this document is to:

- (I) Draw special attention to certain general conditions applicable to government blds, contracts and orders; and
- (II) To ensure that clients be familiar with regard to the rights and obligations of all parties involved in doing business with government.

In this document words in the singular also mean in the plural and vice versa and words in the meaculine also mean in the feminine and neuter.

- The General Conditions of Contract will form part of all bid/quotation documents and may not be amended.
- Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) relevant to a specific bip, should be compiled separately for every bid (if applicable) and will supplement the General Conditions of Contract. Whenever there is a conflict, the previsions in the SCC shall prevail.

1 Definitions

1.1.

The following terms shall be interpreted as indicated:

- "Closing time" means the date and hour specified in the bidding documents for the receipt of bids,
- 1.2. "Contract" means the written agreement entered into between the successer and the supplier, as recorded in the contract form signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.
- 1.3. "Contract price" means the price payable to the supplier under the contract for the felt and proper performance of his contractual obligations.
- "Corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of any thing of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution.
- 1,5, "Countervalling duties" are imposed in cases where an enterprise abroad is subsidized by its government and encouraged to market its products internationally,
- 1.6. "Country of origin" means the place where the goods were mined, grown or produced or from which the services are supplied, Goods are produced when, through manufacturing, processing or substantial and major assembly of components, a commercially recognized new product results that is substantially different in basic characteristics or in purpose or utility from its components.
- 1.7. "Day" means calendar day.
- 1.8. "Delivery" means delivery in compliance of the conditions of the contract or order.
- 1.9. "Qelivery ex stock" means immediate delivery directly from stock actually on hand.
- 1.10. "Delivery into consignees store or to his site" means delivered and unloaded in the specified store or depat or on the specified site in compliance with the conditions of the contract or order, the supplier bearing all risks and charges involved until the supplies are so delivered and a valid receipt is obtained.
- 1.11. "Qumpling" occurs when a private enterprise abroad market its goods on own Initiative in the RSA at lower prices than that of the country of origin and which have the potential to form the local industries in the RSA.
- 1.12. "Force majeure" means an event beyond the control of the supplier and not involving the supplier's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include, but is not restricted to, acts of the purchaser in its soversign capacity, were or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes.
- 1.13. "Fraudulent practice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract to the detriment of any bidder, and includes collusive practice among bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive the bidder of the benefits of free and open competition.
- 1.14. "GCC" means the General Conditions of Contract.
- 1,16. "Goods" means all of the equipment, machinery, and/or other materials that the sumplier is required to supply to the purchaser under the contract.
- 1.16. "Imported content" means that portion of the bidding price represented by the cost of components, parts or materials which have been or are attill to be imported (whether by the supplier or his subcontractors) and which costs are inclusive of the costs attract, plus freight and other direct importation costs such as landing costs, dock dues, imaged duly, sales duly or other similar tax or duly at the South African place of entry as well as transportation and handling charges to the factory in the Republic where the supplies covered by the bid will be manufactured.
- 1.17. "Local content" means that portion of the bidding price which is not included in the imported content provided that local manufacture does take place,
- 1.18. "Manufacture" means the production of products in a factory using labour, materials, components and machinery and includes other related value-adding activities.

"Services" means those functional services enclibery to the supply of the goods, such as transportation and any other incidental services, such as installation, commissioning, provision of technical assistance, training, estering, gardening, security, maintenance and other such obligations of the supplier covered under the contract.
- 1.25. "Written" or "in writing" means handwritten in ink or any form of electronic or mechanical writing.

2 Application

- These general conditions are applicable to all bids, contracts and orders including bids for functional and professional services, sales, hiring, letting and the granting or acquiring of rights, but excluding immovable property, unless atherwise indicated in the bidding documents.
- 2.2. Where applicable, special conditions of contract are also laid down to coyar specific supplies, services or works.
- 2.3. Where such special conditions of contract are in conflict with these general conditions, the special conditions shall apply.

3 Ganeral

- 3.1. Unless otherwise indicated in the bidding documents, the purchaser shall not be liable for any expense incurred in the preparation and submission of a bid. Where applicable a non-refundable foe for documents may be charged.

4 Standards

4.1. The goods supplied shall conform to the standards mentioned in the bidding documents and specifications.

Use of contract documents and information; inspection.

- 5.1. The supplier shall not, without the purchaser's prior written consent, disclose the contract, or any provision thereof, or any specification, plan, drawing, pattern, sample, or information furnished by or on behalf of the purchaser in connection therewith, to any person other than a person employed by the supplier in the performance of the contract. Disclosure to any such employed person shall be made in confidence and shall extend only so far as may be necessary for purposes of such performance.
- 5.2. The supplier shall not, without the purchaser's prior written consent, make use of any decument or information mentioned in GCC clause 5,1 except for purposes of performing the contract.
- Any document, other than the contract itself mentioned in GCC clause 5.1 shall remain the property of the purchaser and shall be returned (all copies) to the purchaser on completion of the supplier's performance under the contract it so required by the purchaser.
- The supplier shall permit the purchaser to inspect the supplier's records relating to the performance of the supplier and to have them audited by auditors appointed by the purchaser, if so required by the purchaser,

8 Patent rights

The supplier shall indemnify the purchaser against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights edaing from use of the goods or any part thereof by the purchaser.

7 Performance security

- 7.1. Within thirty (30) days of receipt of the nollification of contract award, the successful bidder shall furnish to the purchaser the performance security of the amount specified in SCC.

If It is a bid condition that supplies to be produced or services to be rendered should at any stage during production or execution or on completion be subject to inspection, the premises of the bidder or contractor shall be open, at all reasonable hours, for inspection by a representative of the Department or an organization esting on behalf of the Department.
- 8.3. If there are no inspection requirements indicated in the bidding documents and no mention is made in the contract, but during the contract period it is decided that inspections shall be carried out, the purchaser shall test make the necessary errangements, including payment arrangements with the testing authority concerned.
- 8.4. If the Inspections, tests and analyses referred to in clauses 8,3 and 8.4 show the supplies to be in accordance with the centract requirements, the cost of the inspections, tests and analyses shall be defrayed by the purchaser.
- Where the supplies or services referred to in clauses 8.2 and 8.3 do not comply with the contract requirements, irrespective of whether such supplies or services are accepted or not, the cost in connection with these inespections, tests or analyses shall be defrayed by the supplier.
- 8.6. Supplies and services which are referred to in clauses 8.2 and 8.3 and which do not comply with the contract requirements may be rejected,
- 6.7. Any contract supplies may on or after delivery be inspected, tested or analyzed and may be rejected if found not to comply with the requirements of the contract. Such rejected supplies shall be held at the cost and risk of the supplier who shall, when called upon, remove them immediately at his own cost and forthwith substitute them with supplies which do comply with the regulremonts of the contract. Palling such removal the rejected supplies shall be returned at the suppliers cost and risk. Should the supplier full to grovide the supplies forthwith, the purchaser may, without giving the supplier further opportunity to substitute the rejected supplies, purchase such supplies as may be necessary at the expense of the supplier.
- 8.8. The provisions of clauses 8,4 to 9.7 shall not prejudice the right of the purchaser to cancel the contract on account of a breach of the conditions thereof, or to act in terms of Clause 23 of GCC.

9 Packing

- 9.1. The supplier shall provide such packing of the goods as is required to prevent their damage or deterloration during transit to their final destination, as indicated in the contract. The packing shall be sufficient to withstand, without limitation, rough headling during transit and exposure to extreme temperatures, salt and precipitation during transit, and open storage. Backing, case size and weights shall take into consideration, where appropriate, the remoteness of the goods' final destination and the absence of heavy handling facilities at all points in transit.
- 9.2. 15 Warranty

- 15.1. The supplier warrants that the goods supplied under the contract are new, unused, of the most recent or current models, and that they incorporate all recent improvements in design and materials unless provided otherwise in the contract. The supplier further warrants that all goods supplied under this contract shall have no defect, erising from design, materials, or workmanghip (except when the design and/or material is required by the purchaser's specifications) or from any sol or omission of the supplier, that may develop under normal use of the supplied goods in the conditions provailing in the country of final destination.
- 16.2. This warranty shall remain valid for twelve (12) months after the goods, or any portion thereof as the case may be, have been delivered to and accepted at the final destination indicated in the contrast, or for eighteen (16) months after the date of shipment from the port or place of leading in the course country, whichever period concludes earlier, unless specified otherwise in SCC.
- 16.3. The purchaser shall promptly notify the supplier in writing of any claims adding under this warranty.
- 15.4. Upon receipt of such notice, the supplier shall, within the period appointed in SCC and with all reasonable speed, repair or replace the detective goods or parts thereof, without costs to the purchaser.
- 16.5. If the supplier, having been notified, talls to remedy the defect(s) within the period specified in SCC, the purchaser may proceed to take auch remedial action as may be necessary, at the supplier disk and expanse and without prejudice to any other rights which the purchaser may have against the supplier under the contract.

16 Payment



As soon as practicable after receipt of the supplier's notice, the purchaser shall evaluate the situation and may at the descretion extend the supplier's time for performance, with or without the imposition of penalties, in which sees the extension shall be ratified by the parties by amendment of contract,
- 21.3. No provision in a contract shall be deemed to prohibit the obtaining of supplies or services from a national department, provincial department, or a local authority.
- 21.4. The right is reserved to procure outside of the contract small quantities or to have niner essential services executed if an emergency arises, the supplier's point of supply is not situated at or near the place where the suppliers are required, or the supplier's services are not readily available.





- 21.6. Except as provided under GCG Clause 25, a delay by the supplier in the performance of its delivery obligations shall render the supplier liable to the imposition of penalties, pursuant to GCC Clause 22, unless an extension of time is agreed upon pursuant to GCC Clause 21.2 without the application of penalties.
- 21.6. Upon any delay beyond the delivery period in the case of a supplies contract, the purchaser shall, without canceling the contract, be entitled to purchase supplies of a similar quality and up to the same quantity in substitution of the goods not supplied in conformity with the contract and to return any goods delivered later at the supplier's expense and rick, or to sangel the contract and buy such goods as may be required to complete the contract and without prejudice to his other rights, be entitled to claim damages from the supplier.

22 Penalties

22.1. Subject to GCC Clause 25, if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods as to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated on the delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day of the delay until actual delivery or performance. The purchaser may also consider termination of the contract pursuant to GCC Clause 23.

23 Termination for default

- 23.1. The purchaser, without projudice to any other remody for breach of contract, by written notice of default cent to the supplier, may terminate this contract in whole or in part:
 - (a) If the supplier falls to deliver any or all of the goods within the parted(a) specified in the contract, or within any extension thereof granted by the purchaser pursuant to GCO Clause 24.2;
 -) If the Supplier falls to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract; or
- (o) if the supplier, in the judgment of the purchaser, has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract.

 23.2. In the event the purchaser terminates the contract in whele or in part, the purchaser may precure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate, goods, works or services similar to those undelivered, and the supplier shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs for such similar goods, works or services, However, the supplier shall continue performance of the contract to the extent not terminated.
- 23.3. Where the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may decide to impose a restriction penalty on the supplier by prohibiting such supplier from doing business with the public sector for a period not exceeding 10 years.
- 23.4. If a purchaser intends imposing a restriction on a supplier or any person associated with the supplier, the supplier will be allowed a time period of not more than fourteen (14) days to provide reasons why the envisaged restriction should not be imposed. Should the supplier fall to respond within the allowed fourteen (14) days the purchaser may regard the intended penalty as not objected against and may impose it on the supplier.
- 23.5. Any restriction imposed on any person by the Accounting Officer / Authority will, at the discretion of the Accounting Officer / Authority, also be applicable to any other enterprise or any partner, manager, director or other person who wholly or partly exercises or exercised or may exercise control over the enterprise of the first-mentioned person, and with which enterprise or parson the first-mentioned person, and with which enterprise or parson the first-mentioned person, is or was in the opinion of the Accounting Officer / Authority actively associated.
- 29.6. If a restriction is imposed, the purchaser must, within five (5) weeking days of such imposition, furnish the National Treasury, with the following information:
 - (I) the name and address of the supplier and / or parson restricted by the purchaser;
 - (ii) the date of commencement of the restriction
 - (III) the period of restriction; and
 - (iv) the reasons for the restriction.
- These details will be loaded in the National Treasury's central detabase of suppliers or persons prohibited from doing business with the public sector, if a court of law convicts a person of an offence as contemplated in sections 12 or 13 of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act, No. 12 of 2004, the court may also rule that such person's name be endorsed on the Register for Tander Defaulters. When a person's name has been endorsed on the Register, the person will be prohibited from doing business will the public sector for a period not less than five years and not more than 10 years. The National Treasury is empowered to determine the period of restriction and each case will be dealt with on its own merits. According to section 32 of the Act the Register must be open to the public, The Register can be parased on the National Treasury website.

24 Anti-dumping and countervalling duties and rights

24.1. When, after the date of bid, provisional payments are required, or entidumpling or equivervelling duties are imposed, or the amount of a provisional payment or anti-dumpling or counterveiling right is increased in respect of any dumped or subsidized import, the State is not liable for any amount so required or imposed, or for the amount of any such increase. When, after the said dute, such a provisional payment is no longer required or any such anti-dumpling or counterveiling right is abolished, or where the amount of such provisional payment or any such right is reduced, any such fayourable difference shall on demand be paid forthwith by the contractor to the State or the State may deduct such amounts from moneys (if any) which may otherwise be due to the contractor in regard to supplies or services which this delivered or rendered, or is to deliver or render in terms of the contract or any other amount whichmay be due to him.

25 Force Majeure


- 25.1. Notwithstanding the provisions of GCC Clauses 22 and 23, the supplier shall not be liable for forfeiture of its parformance security, damages, or termination for default if and to the extent that his delay in performance or other follure to perform his obligations under the contract is the result of an event of force maleure.
- If a force majeure situation erises, the supplier shall promptly notify the purchaser in writing of such condition and the cause thereof. 27 Settlement of Disputes

- 27.3. Should it not be possible to settle a dispute by means of modicition, it may be settled in a South African court of law.
- 27.4. Mediation proceedings shall be conducted in accordance with the rules of procedure specified in the SCC.
- 27.5. Notwithstanding any reference to mediation and/or court proceedings herein.




12 PATENT RIGHTS
