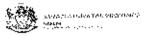

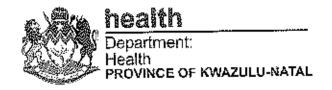

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## NOTES

The purpose of this document is to:

- Draw special ettention to certain general conditions applicable to government bids, configure and orders; and
- To ensure Bear clients be familiar with regard to the rights and obligations of all parties involved in doing business with government. fin

In this document words in the singular also mean in the plural and vice years and words in the masculine also mean is the forninne and nautor.

- The General Conditions of Contract will form part of all biddy extation documents and may not be amended.
- Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) relevant to a specific bid, should be compiled segarately for every and (it applicable) and will supplement the General Conditions of Contract. Whenever there is a conflict, the provisions in the SCC shall prevail.

#### Definitions 1

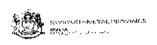
The following terms shall be interproted as indicated:

- "Closing time" means the date and hour specified in the tridding documents for the receipt of hids. 1.1.
- "Contract" means the written agreement entered into between the purchasor and the supplier, as recorded in the contract from signed by the parties, 1.2. including all attachments and appendices thereto and all cocuments incorporated by reference therein.
- "Contract price" messes the price payable to the supplier under the contract for the full and proper performance of his contractual obligations. 1.3.
- "Corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or solidking of any thing of value to extuence the ection of a public official in the procurement 1.4. process; or in contract execution.
- "Countervailing duties" are imposed in eases where an enlergise abroad is subsidized by its government and encouraged to market its products 1.5.
- "Country of origin" means the place where the goods were mined, grown or produced or from which the services are supplied. Goods are produced 1.6. whon, through menufacturing, processing or substantial and major assembly of components, a commercially recognized now product results that is substantially different in basic characteristics or in purpose or stillty from its components.
- "Day" means calendar day. 1.7.
- "Delivery" means delivery in compliance of the conditions of the costract or order. 1.8.
- "Delivery ox slood" means immediate delivery directly from stock actually on hand. 1.9.

## Standards

The goods supplied shall conform to the standards mertioned in the bidding occurrents and specificallons.

### Use of contract documents and information; inspection. 5

- The supplier shall not, without the purchaser's prior written consent, disclose the contract, or any provision thereof, or any specification, plan, drawing, 5.1. pattern, sample, or information furnished by or on behalf of the purchaser in connection therewith, to any person other than a person employed by the supplier in the performance of the contract. Disclosure to any such employed person shall be made in confidence and shall extend only so far as may be necessary for purposes of such pesturmance.
- The supplier shall not, without the purchasor's poor written consent, make use of any document or information mentioned in GCC clause 5.1 except for 5.2. purposes of performing the contract.
- Any occurrent, other than the control itself mentioned in SCC clause 5.1 shall remain the property of the purchasor and shall be returned (all copies) to the purchaser on completion of the supplier's performance under the contract if so required by the purchaser.
- The supplier shall pormit the purchaser to inspect the supplier's records relating to the performance of the supplier and to know strom audited by auditors 5.4 appointed by the purchaser, if an required by the purchaser.

## Patent rights

The supplier shall indemnify the purchaser against all third-party deims of infringement of patent, trademork, or industrial design rights arising from use 5,1. of the goods or any part thereof by the purchaser.

## Performance security

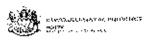

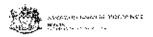

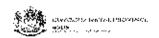
