MOTES

The gurpose of this document is to:

- Oraw special attention to contain general conditions applicable to government bids, contracts and orders; and
- (ii) To ensure that chercs be familiar with regard to the rights and obligations of all parties involved to doing business with government.

In this document words in the singular also mean in the plural and wee versa and words in the masculine also mean in the feminine and neuter.

- The Gersstal Conditions of Contract will form part of all bioliquotation documents and may not be amended.
- Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) relevant to a specific bid, should be complete separately for every bid (if applicable) and will supplement the
 General Conditions of Confract. Whenever there is a conflict, the provisions in the SCC shall provail.

1 Definitions

The following terms shall be interpreted as insteales:

- 1.1. "Closing time" means the data and hour specified in the tarting documents for the receipt of bids.
- 1.2. "Contract" means the written agreement entered into between the purchaser and the supplier, as recorded in the contract form signed by the parties, including all altractments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.

- 1.8. "Delivery" means delivery in compliance of the conditions of the contract or order.

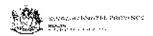

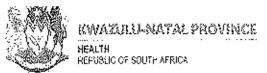
