GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

NOTES

The purpose of this document is to:

- Draw special attention to certain general conditions applicable to government bids, contracts and orders; and
- To ensure that clients be familiar with regard to the rights and obligations of all parties involved in doing business with government.

In this document words in the singular also mean in the plural and vice versa and words in the masculine also mean in the feminine and neuter.

- The General Conditions of Contract will form part of all bld/quotation documents and may not be amended.
- Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) relevant to a specific bid, should be compiled separately for every bid (if applicable) and will supplement the General Conditions of Contract. Whenever there is a conflict, the provisions in the SCC shall prevail.
- 1 Definitions

The following terms shall be Interpreted as Indicated:

- "Closing time" means the date and hour specified in the bidding documents for the receipt of bids.
- "Contract price" means the price payable to the supplier under the contract of the full and proper performance of his contractual obligations. 1,2,

- "Corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of any thing of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement 1,4.
- process or in contract execution.

 "Countervalling dulies" are imposed in cases where an enterprise abroad is subsidized by its government and encouraged to market its producis. process or in contract execution, 1.5.
- "Country of origin" means the place where the goods were mined, grown or produced or from which the services are supplied. Goods are produced when, through manufacturing, processing or substantial and major assembly of components, a commercially recognized new product results that is substantially different in basic characteristics or in purpose or utility from its components. 1.6.
- "Day" means calendar day. 1.7.
- "Delivery" means delivery in compliance of the conditions of the contract or order. *Dollvery ex stock* means immediate delivery directly from stock actually on hand.
- Delivery into consignees store or to his site" means delivered and unloaded in the specified store or depot or on the specified site in compliance with the conditions of the contract or order, the supplier bearing all risks and charges involved until the supplies are so delivered and a valid receipt is obtained. 1.9. 1.10.
- "Dumping" occurs when a private enterprise abroad market its goods on own initiative in the RSA at lower prices than that of the country of origin and which have the potential to harm the local industries in the RSA 1.11.
- "Force majeure" means an event beyond the control of the supplier and not involving the supplier's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. - "Goods" means all of the equipment, machinery, and/or other materials that the supplier is required to supply to the purchaser under the contract. 1.15.




