1.3.3 GUARANTEE PERIOD

1.3.4 PENALTY FOR NON-COMPLETION

1.3.5 <u>DEFAULT BY CONTRACTOR</u>

IN THE PHARMACY

- 1. Expose and seal all cracks on the walls with polley filler
- 2. Send down all filled surface with fine sand paper
- 3. Wash all walls using sugar soap
- 4. Apply one coat of undercoat (white) on all walls
- 5. Apply 2 x coats of paint matching the existing on all walls

NB: Area to be left neat and tidy.

NB: ALL WORK WILL BE CARRIED OUT DURING OPERATIONAL HOURS

SERVICE PROVIDER WILL BE RQUIRED TO PRODUCE A SAFETY FILE ONCE AWARDED

A 5 YEAR GUARANTEE IS REQUIRED ON ALL WORKMANSHIP
