GCC

NOTES

The purpose of this document is to:

- Draw special attention to certain general conditions applicable to government olds, contracts and orders; and
- (i) To ensure that clients be familiar with regard to the rights and obligations of all parties involved in doing business with government. (ii)

In this document words in the singular also mean in the plural and vice versa and words in the mascutine also mean in the feminine and neuter.

- The General Conditions of Contract will form part of all bid/quotation documents and may not be amended.
- Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) relevant to a specific bid, should be compiled separately for every bid (if applicable) and will supplement the General Conditions of Contract, Whenever there is a conflict, the provisions in the SCC shall prevail.

Definitions 1

The following terms shall be interpreted as indicated:

- "Closing time" means the date and hour specified in the bidding documents for the receipt of bids. 1.1.
- Contract means the viniter agreement emerculing benzeen the purchaser and the supplier, as recorded in the conficer form arging by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.
- "Contract price" means fire price payable to the supplier under the contract for the full and proper performance of his contractual obligations.
- Corrupt practice means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of any thing of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution.
- "Countervailing duties" are imposed in cases where an enterprise abroad is subsidized by its government and encouraged to market its products 1,5. internationally.

- "Delivery" means delivery in compliance of the conditions of the contract or order. 1.8.
- "Delivery ex stock" means immediate delivery directly from stock actually on hand, 1.9.
- "Delivery into consignees store or to his site" means delivered and unloaded in the specified store or depot or on the specified site in compliance with the conditions of the contract or order, the supplier bearing all risks and charges involved until the supplies are so delivered and a valid receipt is obtained. 1.10.
