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#### 8. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

8.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

#### SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

9.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

#### 10 TAX COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 10.1. In the event that the tax compliance status has failed on CSD, it is the suppliers' responsibility to provide a SARS pin in order for the institution to validate the tax compliance status of the supplier.
- 10.2. In the event that the institution cannot validate the suppliers' tax clearance on SARS as well as the Central Suppliers Database, the quote will not be considered and passed over as non-compliant according to National Treasury Instruction Note 4 (a) 2016/17.

#### 11 TAX INVOICE

- 11.1. A tax invoice shall be in the currency of the Republic of South Africa and shall contain the following particulars:
  - (i) the name, address and registration number of the supplier;
  - (ii) the name and address of the recipient;
  - (iii) an individual serialized number and the date upon which the tax invoice
  - (iv) a description and quantity or volume of the goods or services supplied;
  - (v) the official department order number issued to the supplier;
  - (vi) the value of the supply, the amount of tax charged;
  - (vii) the words tax invoice in a prominent place.

#### 12 PATENT RIGHTS

12.1. The supplier shall indemnify the KZN Department of Health (hereafter known as the purchaser) against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the goods or any part thereof by the purchaser.

#### 13. PENALTIES

- 13.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 13.2. In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract. In the event that the contract is terminated the institution may claim damages from the service provider in the form of a penalty. The service provider's performance should be captured on the service provider database in order to determine whether or not the service provider should be awarded any contracts in the future.
- 13.4. If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated on the delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day of the delay until actual delivery or performance.

### 1.3.2 CONTRACT GUARANTEE:

The successful Tenderer will be required to submit a contract guarantee.

# 1.3.3 GUARANTEE PERIOD

The guarantee period for the Service must be minimum of **06** (SIX) months from the date of final delivery.

## 1.3.4 PENALTY FOR NON-COMPLETION

Penalties at the rate of **R50.00 (Fifty Rand)** per day shall apply.

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### 1.3.5 DEFAULT BY CONTRACTOR

Penalties at the rate of R50-00 (Fifty Rand) per day shall apply.

#### **GENERAL**

This TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION shall be read in conjunction withal other sections of the SPECIFICATION and cognisance shall be taken of clauses relevant to this particular installation, whether any specific clauses are referred to or not.

### SCOPE OF WORK.

# P5 WALKWAY SHELTER STRUCTURE 01

- 1.1 Prepare all high strength concrete work for the securing of upright structure poles
- 1.2 Adjoin to the existing walkway structure and 500mm from it, supply and install 100mm x100mm x2,6m x 2 HDG upright square tubing poles.
- 1.4 2M apart from the square tubing poles to the clear view fencing, supply and install 8 x 100mm x 100mm X 2,6m HDG square tubing poles.
- On either side of the walkway, (LHS from the gate supply and mount on fabricated brackets using M10 s/s Bolts, 100mm x 100mm x 8,8m square tubing support on the poles. Apply the same on the RHS at 12m length.
- Across each upright pole, install 100mm x 100 x 3,2m cross bar to stabilize for the roofing.
- 1.7 For the securing of the roof sheeting, install lip channel, 3,2m x 8 across.
- 1.8 Lay out and secure roof sheeting (The sheeting to be supplied by the institution)
- 1.9 Where the existing shelter joins with the new shelter, fabricate and install 240mm x 180mm galvanized box gutter.
- 1.11 Supply and install 100mm diameter PVC down pipe to be linked to the existing concrete drain.
- 1.12 Install barge boards to match the existing.

#### PHASE B

- 1.1 At the main entrance gate, alter clear view gate height to 3,1m height
- 1.2 Cut and adjust gate height at 3,1m, fabricate brackets and mount solid the upper part to the 2 poles.
- 1.3 On the passage exit wall, supply and mount to the wall using fabricated brackets and 2,6m X 100mm x 100mm HDG square tubing to support the structure.
- 1.4 Between the wall and the gate, supply and fit 2 x 2,6m x 100mm x100mm square tubing poles
- 1.5 At the gate, supply and install 2 x 3.1 x 100mm x100mm HDG square tubing poles
- 1.6 From the square tubing secured on the wall, to the gate poles, supply and install 2 x 3050mm x 100mm x 100mm HDG square to stabilize the structure on each upper side.
- 1.7 Supply and install PVC box gutter across and beneath the end structure at the gate.
- 1.8 Provide and connect a PVC downpipe to be linked to the existing concrete drain.
- 1.9 Supply and install 1 x lights to match the existing. (C.O.C is required)
- 1.10 Allow for Safety File.

### NB: ALL WORK WILL BE CARRIED OUT DURING OPERATIONAL HOURS AREA TO BE LEFT NEAT AND TIDY A 12 TWELVE MONTH GUARANTEE IS REQUIRED ON ALL WORKMANSHIP
